## THIS WEEK'S OVC HIGHLIGHTS/STORYLINES

This year marks the 75th anniversary of the OVC, which was founded in 1948, making it the eighth-oldest Division I Conference ... The OVC is made up of seven football-playing schools in 2022, including Lindenwood which joined the league this season ... The league schedule is based around five Conference games this season (new member Lindenwood will play only four) ... In Week 3 Lindenwood improved to 2-0 on the season while Southeast Missouri is now 2-0 against FCS teams after a win over Nicholls ... The first OVC games of the season are this week as UT Martin hosts Lindenwood and Murray State hosts Eastern Illinois ... SEMO has a non-conference games while Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech have open dates ... UT Martin is ranked No. 18/19 in the major polls this week, while Southeast Missouri is receiving votes in both and Lindenwood picked up votes in the Coaches Poll ... Every current OVC team (except newly Division I Lindenwood) has been ranked in the Top 25 polls for at least one week over the past six years (2016-21) ... OVC teams have 13 playoff victories since 2013, including five Quarterfinal and one National Championship game appearance ... Since 2013, six different teams that have represented the OVC have won a playoff games; the only other conferences to accomplish that are the CAA, MVFC and Southern Conference ... SEMO's Geno Hess begins the season on the Walter Payton Watch List while UT Martin's John H. Ford II is on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List ... In seven of the past 12 years (2010-21), an OVC team has defeated a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent ... Last academic year (2021-22), 103 football student-athletes were named to the OVC Commissioner's Honor Roll for achieving a 3.25 GPA or better ... This season the OVC and Southland Conference begin a two-year (2022, 2023) non-conference scheduling alliance which filled open schedule dates with a focus toward competitive balance and reasonable travel; OVC teams are 3-0 against Southland Conference teams so far this season ... The OVC and Big South have created an alliance which begins next season (2023), and combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences.

## OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### OFFENSIVE

#### **Cade Brister, QB • 6-0, 222, Sr. • O'Fallon, Mo. • Lindenwood**

Brister accounted for 400 yards of total offense and three touchdowns as Lindenwood topped Keiser 37-3 in its home opener. The senior completed 18-of-32 passes for 377 yards and three touchdowns and rushed five times for 23 yards. In the process he set a new Lindenwood record for career touchdown passes (tallying his 71st in the first quarter). His passing scores went for 33, 11 and 78 yards. Brister is now just 181 passing yards away from holding the school record for passing yards in a career.

### DEFENSIVE

#### **Bryce Norman, LB • 6-0, 226, So. • Jackson, Mo. • Southeast Missouri**

Norman had 17 tackles, the fifth-most by a FCS player this season, as Southeast Missouri topped Nicholls 42-16 to stay perfect against FCS teams this season. The 17 tackles (5 of which were solo) were a career-high and the most by an OVC player this season. He helped a SEMO defense that limited the Colonels to only 50 rushing yards. Norman also added a quarterback hurry and a pass breakup.

### SPECIALIST

#### **Trey Wilhoit, P • 5-10, 170, So. • Tallahassee, Fla. • Eastern Illinois**

Wilhoit continued to be a weapon for the Eastern Illinois punt team as he had six punts in Saturday's contest at Illinois State. Wilhoit averaged 44.8 yards punt, pinning two of his six punts inside the 20-yard line. He had two punts over 50 yards in the contest with a long of 56 yards. On the season he ranks in the top 10 in the FCS in punting average at 46.1 yards per punt.

### NEWCOMER

#### **Paxton DeLaurent, QB • 6-5, 215, So. • Camdenton, Mo. • Southeast Missouri**

DeLaurent, a transfer from Central Methodist, threw for over 300 yards for the second-straight game when he completed 22-of-32 passes for 309 yards and three touchdowns in a 42-16 win over Nicholls. The sophomore completed passes to 11 different receivers, including a pair of touchdowns to running back Geno Hess and an 18-yard strike to Ryan Flournoy. It marked his second-straight game with three or more touchdown passes. DeLaurent also rushed for a nine-yard touchdown in the second quarter and finished the game with 27 rushing yards. He leads the OVC in total offense (319.0 yards/game), a mark that is ninth nationally.

## NOTES FROM AROUND THE GRIDIRON

**Quick Hitters:** On September 17, SEMO RB **Geno Hess** rushed for one and caught a pair of touchdown passes in a win over Nicholls; he is the first OVC running back to catch multiple touchdown passes in a game since UTM's Peyton Logan against Samford on September 11, 2021 ... SEMO linebacker **Bryce Norman** tallied 17 tackles against Nicholls, the most by an OVC player since Murray State's Anthony Koclanakis had 18 on November 2, 2021 ... Lindenwood played its 100th game at Hunter Stadium on September; the Lions topped Keiser University 37-3 ... After its 2-0 start, Lindenwood picked up votes in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll ... Tennessee Tech ranks ninth nationally in fumbles recovered (4) while Southeast Missouri is first in fewest fumbles lost (0) ... EIU is third nationally in net punting (43.23 yards/punt) ... Tennessee State ranks first nationally in red zone offense (100%), one of 12 teams with that mark at this point season ... UT Martin's **Colton Dowell** leads the OVC and ranks 11th nationally in receiving yards/game (104.0) ... SEMO WR **Johnny King** had 14 receptions at No. 17 Southern Illinois on September 10; it is the second-most by a FCS player this season (15 is the top mark) and he ranks fourth nationally in receptions/game (8.3) ... SEMO kicker **DC Pippin** nailed a 50-yard field goal at Southern Illinois, making him one of eight field goals of 50 yards or longer this season at the FCS level ... Tennessee State's **Devon Starling** had 207 yards in the season-opener at No. 12 Eastern Washington (Sept. 3), which is the second-most by a FCS player against a Division I team this season.

**Top 25 Polls:** After its game at Boise State, UT Martin slipped to No. 18 in the Stats Perform Poll (from 16) and to No. 19 in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll (from 18). The Skyhawks finished last season ranked No. 12 in the Coaches Poll, its highest end-of-season finish in school history, and was ranked as high as No. 8 (matching its highest ranking). Southeast Missouri is receiving votes in both polls now, moving from 40 to 93 points in the Stats Perform Poll (putting them unofficially 28th), and picking up votes in the Coaches Poll for the first time. After a 2-0 start, Lindenwood picked up votes in the AFCA Top 25 on Monday. Every current OVC team (except newly Division I Lindenwood) has been ranked in the Top 25 polls for at least one week over the past six years (2016-21).

**NCAA Division I Playoff Information:** In 2010 the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) playoff field expanded to 20 teams, up from 16 previously, and in 2013 the field increased to 24 for the first time. The expansion in 2010 to 20 teams was the first since the field grew from 12 to 16 teams in 1997. The 24-team field is comprised of 11 automatic bids and 13 at-large berths. There are eight first round matchups (16 total teams), while eight (8) teams receive a bye into the second round. For the 14th time in 2022, the championship game will be played in Frisco, Texas at Toyota Stadium, a 20,500-seat multi-purpose stadium. The Southland Conference will serve as the host of the championship, which will be held on Saturday, January 7.

**Recent Playoff Success:** Beginning with the 2001 season the OVC went until 2013 without a FCS Playoff victory. But over the past nine seasons OVC teams have performed well in the playoffs, winning 13 total games and advancing to the FCS Quarterfinals three times in the past six seasons. In 2013 the OVC placed three teams in the field for the first-time ever (each won a game) and in 2015 the league had a team advance to the National Championship game (the first for the league since 1982). Over the past nine years six different teams that have represented the OVC have won a playoff game (Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Jacksonville State, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State and UT Martin).

**Six Different OVC Teams With Playoff Wins Since 2013:** The OVC is one of just four FCS Conferences to have six different teams win a playoff game over the past nine years (2013-2021). Over that time Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Jacksonville State, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State and UT Martin have all won at least one game while representing the OVC. The other conferences to have six different teams win over that period are the CAA, Missouri Valley and Southern Conferences.

**2022 Schedule:** The 2022 OVC football schedule features the seven league members playing five Conference games apiece (the exception being new member Lindenwood who will play four). There is not a full round robin this year as most teams' non-conference schedules were full (including a previously announced non-conference scheduling partnership with the Southland Conference) when Lindenwood joined the league in February 2022. Eastern Illinois and Lindenwood will play on October 15 but will not count in the OVC standings.

**Walter Payton Award Watch List:** Southeast Missouri senior running back **Geno Hess** was one of 35 players nationally named to the Walter Payton Award Watch List by Stats Perform. The award is presented after the season to the national offensive player of the year in college football's Division I subdivision. More players can join the watch list during the regular season, and afterwards a national media panel will select the winner. First awarded in 1987, the Payton has been won by an OVC player twice, Tony Romo in 2002 and Jimmy Garoppolo in 2013.

**Buck Buchanan Award Watch List:** UT Martin graduate linebacker **John H. Ford II** is one of 35 players nationally named to the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List by Stats Perform. The award is presented to the national defensive player of the year in college football's Division I subdivision. More players can join the watch list during the regular season, and afterwards a national media panel will select the winner. First awarded in 1995, the Buchanan Award has twice been won by an OVC player, Jacksonville State's Darius Jackson (2017) and SEMO's Zach Hall (2018).

**Deacon Jones Trophy Watch List:** Three Tennessee State football players have been named to the Watch List for the Black College Football Player of the Year Award. The award, known as the Deacon Jones Trophy, is presented annually to the most outstanding college football player from a Historically Black College & University (HBCU). The players were quarterback **Draylen Ellis**, running back **Devon Starling** and linebacker **James Green**. Four finalists will be unveiled after the season. The winner of the Black College Football Player of the Year Award, which will be announced during halftime of the 2023 HBCU Legacy Bowl on Saturday, February 25, 2023 in New Orleans, Louisiana. TSU's Chris Rowland won the award in 2019.

**Hess on CFPA National Performer of the Year Watch List:** Southeast Missouri running back **Geno Hess** is one of 38 players on the initial Watch List for the College Football Performance Awards (CFPA) National Performer of the Year Award.

**Individual Awards Winners:** Since 2013, the OVC has produced one Walter Payton Award Winner, two Buck Buchanan Award Winners, an Eddie Robinson Award Winner and a Deacon Jones Trophy winner. In addition, the league has had two Doris Robinson Award Winners, as the National Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

**Three OVC Players Named to FCS Punter of the Year Watch List:** Three OVC players have been named to the 2022 FCS Punter of the Year Award Watch List by the Augusta Sports Council. The OVC picks, who were among the 22 nationally on the list, were Southeast Missouri's **Zach Haynes**, Tennessee State's **Kaleb Mosely** and Murray State's **Lewis Halton**. The FCS Punter of the Year Award winner will be voted on by the FCS Punter of the Year Award/Ray Guy Award Committee and will be announced after regular season play commences.

**Simpson Ranks Fourth in OVC Career Victories:** UT Martin head coach **Jason Simpson** currently ranks fourth in OVC history for career victories. Simpson recorded his 100th victory in the Skyhawks FCS Playoff win over Missouri

**OVC Teams Against FBS Opponents:** In seven of the past 12 seasons (2010-21), an OVC team has knocked off a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent (2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2016, 2017, 2020). OVC teams are 36-265-1 all-time against FBS opponents.

**OVC and Big South Association:** In February 2022 the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions, to begin with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season and have an initial term of at least four years. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible.

**OVC and Southland Conference Partner For Non-Conference Scheduling Alliance:** In October 2021, the OVC and Southland Conference announced a football scheduling alliance for the 2022 and 2023 seasons. The collaboration will see institutions from each conference fill available non-conference dates on schedules in 2022 and 2023 with a focus toward competitive balance and reasonable travel. The alliance provides quality Division I FCS non-conference matchups, allows increased visibility, exposure and branding for each Conference. There are eight matchups on the schedule (with a ninth involving Lindenwood who joined the OVC after the schedule was set). OVC teams are 3-0 so far against Southland schools in 2022.

**Martin Named National Special Teams Player of the Week (Sept. 12):** Lindenwood's **Andrew Martin** was named the FedEx Ground FCS National Special Teams Player of the Week by Stats Perform for his performance in the Lions' 21-20 win over Houston Baptist on September 10. Martin recovered a blocked punt in the HBU end zone with 28 seconds remaining to give Lindenwood a road victory in its first game as an FCS program. The Lions trailed 20-15 when Jalen Bethany blocked the punt. Martin entered the game without a career TD, but he had two, first scoring on a four-yard run in the third quarter to pull LU to within 20-12. He finished with 49 rushing yards and also had a special teams tackle.

**Sgt. York Trophy Presented by Delta Dental:** The Sgt. York Trophy (founded in 2007 by the Nashville Sports Council and sponsored by Delta Dental) goes to the winner of the season football series between the four OVC football-playing schools located in the state of Tennessee (originally it included four schools, but beginning in 2022 includes three schools: Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin). The award is named in honor of Alvin C. York, the most noted Soldier of World War I. As a corporal in the 2nd battalion, 328th Infantry, in the Battle of the Meuse River-Argonne (Oct. 8, 1918), York and seven other soldiers captured 132 prisoners, was promoted to sergeant and received the Distinguished Service Cross, the French Croix de Guerre, the French Legion of Honor, the Croce di Guerra of Italy and the War Medal of Montenegro. Upon his return to the United States in 1919, he was bestowed the Congressional Medal of Honor. Last season UT Martin went 3-0 to claim the title.

**Academic Success:** During the past academic year (2021-22) there were 103 OVC football student-athletes who were named to the Commissioner's Honor Roll for having a 3.25 grade point average or higher. In addition, 10 student-athletes were awarded the OVC Academic Medal of Honor for achieving perfect 4.0 GPAs.

**A Look at the Coaches:** Five coaches from last season return to their respective teams in 2022. Among the newcomers is first-year Eastern Illinois head coach **Chris Wilkerson**, who played for the Panthers and was later an assistant coach. Also new to the league is **Jed Stugart**, who begins his sixth year (fifth season) at Lindenwood, who joined the OVC on July 1. In addition to Wilkerson, Tennessee Tech's **Dewayne Alexander** is also coaching at his alma mater. The longest tenured coach in the league is UT Martin's **Jason Simpson** who enters his 17th season with the Skyhawks in 2022; Simpson is the fourth-winningest coach in OVC history.

**Alexander on NCAA Committee on Ethical Conduct and Sportsmanship:** Beginning this season Tennessee Tech head coach **Dewayne Alexander** is on the NCAA's Committee on Ethical Conduct and Sportsmanship. The committee's mission is to improve the condition of sportsmanship and ethical conduct in all aspects of college athletics by developing and implementing strategies that foster greater acceptance of the value of respect, fairness, civility, honesty and responsibility. Since the establishment of the committee, the group has focused on two areas: (1) provide best practices and creative tools (e.g., the RESPECT campaign) for campus and conference implementation and (2) increase the awareness and profile of the NCAA Sportsmanship Awards.

**UT Martin Tabbed Preseason OVC Favorite:** Coming off an OVC Championship and its first FCS Playoff victory, UT Martin has been picked as the preseason football favorites in the Ohio Valley Conference for the 2022 season. The Skyhawks picked up 10 of a possible 14 first-place votes in a poll of league head coaches and communications directors. It marked the first time the Skyhawks have been picked the preseason favorites since joining the league

prior to the 1992 season. UT Martin totaled 70 points to finish ahead of Southeast Missouri (59). Murray State (51) was tabbed third, just ahead of Tennessee State (46), who also picked up a first-place vote. The poll was rounded out by Tennessee Tech (29), Eastern Illinois (20) and Lindenwood (19).

**Hess and Ford Headline Preseason All-OVC Team:** Southeast Missouri senior running back **Geno Hess** and UT Martin graduate student linebacker **John H. Ford II** were named the 2022 OVC Preseason Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year in a vote of by the league's head football coaches and communications directors. Tennessee State and UT Martin led the way with eight selections apiece, while Eastern Illinois and Murray State had seven players apiece, Southeast Missouri had six selections, Tennessee Tech added three and newcomer Lindenwood had two players on the team. Returning players who were first- or second-team All-OVC selections last year were automatic selections to the preseason team this year.

**NFL Connections:** As of September 19, there were 11 former OVC players on NFL rosters (8 active, 2 practice squad and 1 IR). Overall the OVC has produced at least one NFL Draft Pick in 14 of the past 19 years (2003-21). In January 2020, Eastern Illinois alum Jimmy Garoppolo became just the eighth former FCS quarterback to start a Super Bowl, doing so with the San Francisco 49ers. For Super Bowl LV in February 2021, there were four participants with OVC connections including a player (Josh Pearson), a coach (Rick Christophel), an official (Jabir Walker) and a broadcaster (Tony Romo).

**Romo Becomes Sixth College Football Hall of Famer With OVC Connections:** In December 2021 former Eastern Illinois quarterback **Tony Romo** was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame Class. Romo is the third player that played in the OVC to be inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame joining Jim Youngblood from Tennessee Tech and George Floyd Jr., from Eastern Kentucky. Three former head coaches from the OVC have also been inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame with Roy Kidd (Eastern Kentucky), James "Boots" Donnelly (Middle Tennessee/Austin Peay) and Frank Beamer (Murray State). At EIU Romo was the winner of the 2002 Walter Payton Award as the top player in the FCS. After going undrafted in 2003, he would put together a standout NFL career with the Dallas Cowboys from 2003-16. The four-time Pro Bowl selection holds Cowboy records for career passing yards and passing touchdowns. Since retiring with the Cowboys, Romo has served as the lead color analyst for CBS' NFL telecasts, working alongside Jim Nantz.

**Let's Get It Started:** The 75th season of Ohio Valley Conference football got underway on Thursday, September 1. The OVC is made up of seven football-playing schools in 2022. Since its beginning, 15 of the 19 total schools that have played football in the league have claimed at least one championship.

**I-AA No More:** Although some people may still refer to it as I-AA football, the term that represents the level of Division I football in which the Ohio Valley Conference competes has been long retired. Beginning with the 2006 National Championship game, the term Football Championship Subdivision (or FCS) is to be used. Teams who play at the FCS level can offer a maximum of 63 scholarships (Football Bowl Subdivision teams can offer 85) and compete in a playoff at the end of the season to determine the national champion.

**FCS All-In:** Each week during the 2022 football season, "FCS All-In" will debut a new episode on ESPN+ each Friday night at 6pm CT. The program is a collaborative effort of the NCAA's 15 Division I FCS Conferences..

**ESPN+:** This season every Conference football game (and select non-conference contests) will be broadcast on ESPN+. This marks the fifth year of the OVC's deal with ESPN+, the multi-sport, direct-to-consumer video service from The Walt Disney Company's Direct-to-Consumer & International segment. Fans can subscribe to ESPN+ for \$9.99 a month (or \$99.99 per year) or as part of a bundle with Disney+ and ad-supported Hulu (\$13.99/month). ESPN+ is an integrated part of the ESPN App and (on mobile and connected devices) and ESPN.com. More information can be found at [www.OVCsports.com/ESPN](http://www.OVCsports.com/ESPN).

## SGT. YORK TROPHY

The 2022 season marks the 16th of competition for the Sergeant York Trophy, an award created by the Nashville Sports Council and the Ohio Valley Conference. The trophy is contested between the OVC football-playing schools in the state of Tennessee - Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin - and goes to the team with the best combined record versus those schools in a given year.

The award is sponsored by Delta Dental of Tennessee.

In the event of a tie, the award will be shared; however, the previous winner will retain the trophy if they are part of the tie. If the tie is between two other institutions, the trophy will go to the institution that has gone the most seasons without winning the trophy.

The award is the only traveling trophy that involves four teams in college sports; there are three others that involve three teams, including the Commander in Chief's Trophy which has been contested between Air Force, Army and Navy annually since 1972. The award is named in honor of Alvin C. York, the most noted Soldier of World War I. Upon his return to the United States in 1919, he was bestowed the Congressional Medal of Honor. Following the war York returned his home in Pall Mall, Tenn. where he dedicated his life to improving education and facilitating educational opportunities for children in the state of Tennessee.

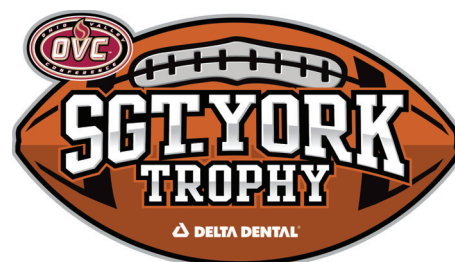

#### OVC NOTABLES

- Every current OVC team (except newly Division I Lindenwood) has been ranked in the Top 25 polls for at least one week over the past six years (2016-21).
- The OVC has placed multiple teams in the FCS Playoffs seven times in the past 12 years (2010-21).
- The OVC is one of just four FCS Conferences to have six different teams win a playoff game over the past nine years (2013-2021). Over that time Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Jacksonville State, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State and UT Martin have all won at least one game while representing the OVC. The other conferences to have six different teams win over that period are the CAA, Missouri Valley and Southern Conferences.
- OVC teams have 13 playoff wins since 2013, including five Quarterfinal appearances and one National Championship game appearance.
- Since 2013, the OVC has produced one Walter Payton Award Winner, two Buck Buchanan Award Winners, an Eddie Robinson Award Winner and a Deacon Jones Trophy winner. In addition, the league has had two Doris Robinson Award Winners, as the National Scholar-Athlete of the Year.
- In seven of the past 12 seasons (2010-21), an OVC team has knocked off a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent (2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2016, 2017, 2020).
- The OVC has produced at least one NFL Draft Pick in 14 of the last 19 years (2003-21).
- In January 2020, OVC alum Jimmy Garoppolo became just the eighth former FCS quarterback to start in a Super Bowl, doing so with the San Francisco 49ers. Last season 11 former OVC players were on active rosters at the end of the year.
- Former EIU quarterback Tony Romo was selected to the 2021 College Football Hall of Fame Class. He is the third former OVC player to be inducted (Jim Youngblood, George Floyd Jr.); in addition, there are also three former OVC coaches (Roy Kidd, Boots Donnelly, Frank Beamer) already enshrined.
- Over the previous 74 years, 15 of 18 teams that have competed have claimed at least one league championship.

### **NOTEWORTHY**

- Southeast Missouri hosts its second-straight home game when it welcomes Central Arkansas to Houck Stadium. It marks the 16th all-time meeting between the schools but the first since 1986 when UCA won 13-9.
- SEMO is receiving votes in both polls, moving closer to breaking into the Top 25. The Redhawks are unofficially No. 28 in the Stats Perform Poll.
- SEMO remained perfect against FCS opponents, following its win over nationally-ranked Southern Illinois (a team that beat Power 5 FBS foe Northwestern this past week) with a commanding victory over Nicholls, a team who has had five-straight winning seasons.
- Quarterback Paxton DeLaurent was named OVC Newcomer of the Week after passing for three touchdowns and rushing for another score against Nicholls. Through three games he has eight passing touchdowns (seventh nationally) and one rushing score. His 319.0 yards of total offense/game ranks him ninth nationally entering this week.
- All-American running back Geno Hess ran for a team-best 70 yards and a touchdown and catch two touchdowns passes last Saturday. That marked his first scores of the season.
- Linebacker Bryce Norman had a career-high 17 tackles (5 solo) and a pass breakup which earned him OVC Defensive Player of the Week honors. The 17 tackles are tied for the fifth-most nationally this season (and most by an OVC player).
- Central Arkansas picked up its first win of the season with a 31-16 road win over Idaho State. That win came after a loss to nationally-ranked FCS for Missouri State and FBS opponent Ole Miss in the first two weeks of the season.
- The Bears forced three turnovers and finished with 418 yards of total offense (389 in the first three quarters) against the Bengals. Sophomore running back Darius Hale had three touchdowns, his first scores of the young season. Hale was the ASUN Freshman of the Year in 2021.
- UCA sophomore punter Chandler Caughron punted five times for a 44.6-yard average in the win.

### **NOTEWORTHY**

- Eastern Illinois and Murray State are meeting for the 39th time on Saturday. The all-time series is deadlocked at 19 after Murray State has won five in a row and six of the last seven in the series.
- EIU's last victory in the series came in 2017, a 27-24 double overtime victory in Murray.
- The teams rank first and second in the OVC in interceptions, with MSU netting four this season and EIU netting three.
- The teams played twice last year, with Murray State winning 22-6 at home on October 2 and 20-13 on the road in the final game of the season (Nov. 20). In the November matchup, Cortez Jones ran for a 26-yard touchdown early in the third quarter to clinch the victory, as neither team scored over the final 26 minutes.
- Playing against rival Illinois State, EIU had two interceptions returned for touchdowns which turned a 14-7 deficit late in the second quarter into a 28-7 deficit early in the third frame.
- Due to four sacks, the Panthers were limited to just 40 net rushing yards on the evening.
- Punter Trey Wilhoit was named OVC Specialist of the Week after he averaged 44.8 yards punt in the contest pinning two of his six punts inside the 20-yard line. He had two punts over 50 yards in the contest with a long of 56 yards. On the season he ranks fourth in the FCS in punting average at 46.1 yards per punt.
- Murray State has played a tough schedule through the first three weeks, challenge a pair of FBS teams (Texas Tech and Ball State) and a FCS team who is moving up to FBS next year (Jacksonville State).
- At Ball State, Isaac McNamee became the third different quarterback to start a game for the Racers this season; he completed seven passes for 57 yards.
- Jamari Dailey tallied a career-high 11 tackles, while Davontae McKee and Erica Samuta followed with eight. Nick Walker recorded the first sack of the season against Ball State in the fourth quarter for a loss of nine yards, to go along with seven total stops.
- Punter Lewis Halton averaged 43.1 yards on seven punts, a season-long of 58, one touchback, two total punts that went 50-plus yards and one that was downed inside the Ball State 20-yard line. Halton is averaging 41.2 yards/punt on the season.

### **NOTEWORTHY**

- The first ever meeting between Lindenwood and UT Martin will take place on Saturday as OVC play opens for both teams. It marks the first OVC contest for the Lions who are in their inaugural year in the OVC.
- UT Martin is ranked No. 18/19 in the major polls, while Lindenwood picked up votes in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll this week after its start to the season.
- Lindenwood improved to 2-0 in its first season of Division I football with a 37-3 over NAIA foe Keiser on Saturday. It marked the 100th game at Hunter Stadium. It was the first home opening win for the team since 2017.
- Quarterback Cade Brister was named OVC Offensive Player of the Week after tallying 400 yards of total offense and three passing touchdowns. The first touchdown of the night was the 71st of his career, setting a new Lindenwood career record. He is also now just 181 passing yards away from that school record as well. Brister had 9,806 yards of total offense and 93 total touchdowns in his career.
- Brister connected with Payton Rose seven times in the game; Rose finished the contest with 180 receiving yards and a touchdown. Kob Smith added five catches for 111 yards and two touchdowns, including a 78-yard score.
- Junior defensive lineman Sterlin Williams had two sacks and six total tackles against Keiser.
- A week after playing a Top 5 ranked FCS opponent, UT Martin had another tough test with a game at FBS foe Boise State. The game was tied at 7-7 following the first quarter and the Broncos led 20-7 with eight minutes to go, before adding 10 later point.
- Linebacker Rob Hicks had 11 tackles, his third double-digit performance of the year, to go along with a fumble recovery that led to a touchdown. His 11.3 tackles/game leads the OVC.
- The UTM defense allowed only 76 total yards on 36 plays in the second half. Overall, the Skyhawks only conceded 327 total yards of offense and had nine tackles for loss with three sacks, two forced fumbles and one fumble recovery.
- The Skyhawks did allow its first sack of the season, when backup quarterback Cornelious Brown was sacked late in the fourth quarter.
- On special teams, Tyler Larco boomed nine punts for a 44.4 yard average, including a long of 57 yards.
