## THIS WEEK'S OVC HIGHLIGHTS/STORYLINES

This year marks the 75th anniversary of the OVC, which was founded in 1948, making it the eighth-oldest Division I Conference ... The OVC is made up of seven football-playing schools in 2022, including Lindenwood which joined the league this season ... The League schedule is based around five Conference games this season (new member Lindenwood will play only four) ... Conference play began this past week with Eastern Illinois and UT Martin winning games to start 1-0 ... There are two more OVC games this week (and Eastern Illinois has a bye) ... Southeast Missouri topped Central Arkansas to improve to 3-0 against FCS teams this season ... UTM running back Zak Wallace scored a 97-yard rushing touchdown against Lindenwood, tied for the longest rush by a Division I (FBS or FCS) player this season ... UT Martin is ranked No. 15/17 in the polls after its win over Lindenwood, while Southeast Missouri debuted at No. 24 in the Stats Perform Poll after its 3-1 start; it marks the first time the Redhawks have been ranked since they were No. 16 on March 1, 2021 (2020-21 season) ... Every current OVC team (except newly Division I Lindenwood) has been ranked in the Top 25 polls for at least one week over the past six years (2016-21) ... OVC teams have 13 playoff victories since 2013, including five Quarterfinal and one National Championship game appearance ... Since 2013, six different teams that have represented the OVC have won a playoff games; the only other conferences to accomplish that are the CAA, MVFC and Southern Conference ... SEMO's Geno Hess begins the season on the Walter Payton Watch List while UT Martin's John H. Ford II is on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List ... In seven of the past 12 years (2010-21), an OVC team has defeated a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent ... Last academic year (2021-22), 103 football student-athletes were named to the OVC Commissioner's Honor Roll for achieving a 3.25 GPA or better ... This season the OVC and Southland Conference begin a two-year (2022, 2023) non-conference scheduling alliance which filled open schedule dates with a focus toward competitive balance and reasonable travel; OVC teams are 3-0 against Southland Conference teams so far this season ... The OVC and Big South have created an alliance which begins next season (2023), and combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences.

## OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### OFFENSIVE

#### **Zak Wallace, RB • 6-0, 220, R-So. • Benton, Ark. • UT Martin**

Wallace was dominant in his first OVC contest of the season, rushing for 204 yards on just 11 carries (the eighth-most yards by a FCS player this season). He averaged 18.5 yards per carry and tallied two rushing touchdowns in a 56-26 win over Lindenwood. His first touchdown came in the first half to give the Skyhawks an eight-point advantage heading into halftime. Then in the third quarter he set a new program single-game record and posted the longest rush by a Division I (FBS or FCS) player this season with a 97-yard touchdown pinned against his end zone. Wallace also caught two passes for 16 yards. His 200-yard performance was the first by a Skyhawk since the 2014 season and ranked as the 12th-best game in program history. His two touchdowns also moved him into a tie for third place on the program's all-time rushing touchdown leaderboard with 22 in parts of three seasons. Wallace ranks first nationally in rushing touchdowns (6), total rushing yards (430), second in rushing yards/game (107.5) and fifth in both all-purpose yards (124.0/game) and rushing yards/carry (7.17).

### DEFENSIVE

#### **Elijawah Tolbert, LB • 6-1, 230, So. • Country Club Hills, Ill. • Eastern Illinois**

Tolbert was disruptive on defense for the Panthers and was a big part of their success in forcing five turnovers in a 35-21 win over Murray State. Tolbert had two interceptions in the win as he now leads EIU with three picks for the season. Tolbert's second interception of the game came with 3:09 remaining and EIU leading 27-21; he returned the pick 20 yards and the Panthers scored a touchdown two plays later. Tolbert's first interception of the game ended the Racers drive just before halftime. The sophomore linebacker added six tackles (3 solo) to go and three pass break-ups.

### SPECIALIST

#### **Dalyn McDonald, RS • 5-11, 174, So. • Gautier, Miss. • Southeast Missouri**

McDonald became the first player in the OVC to return a kickoff for a touchdown this season in the Redhawks 35-27 win over Central Arkansas. After Central Arkansas scored to cut Southeast Missouri's lead to 21-17 with 1:29 left in the second quarter, McDonald ran back the ensuing kickoff 97 yards for a touchdown (the first by a SEMO player in four years). His 97-yard return tied the second-longest kickoff return for a touchdown in program history, and the fifth-longest by a FCS player this season. McDonald finished the day with five kick returns for 182 yards and also added four punt return and six receiving yards to tally 192 all-purpose yards on the day. His 343 combined kick return yards on the season is third nationally.

### CO-NEWCOMER

#### **Paxton DeLaurent, QB • 6-5, 215, So. • Camdenton, Mo. • Southeast Missouri**

DeLaurent earned the award for the third-straight week after accounting for 312 yards of total offense and three touchdowns in a 35-27 win over Central Arkansas. The transfer from Central Methodist completed 17-of-31 passes for 252 yards and two touchdowns through the air and ran for 60 yards and another score. He ran for 11 yards to score SEMO's final touchdown of the game after UCA made it a one-possession affair at the 10:57 mark in the fourth quarter. DeLaurent's passing touchdowns came on strikes of 62 and 14 yards in the second quarter. DeLaurent ranks seventh nationally in total offense (317.2 yards/game), eighth in passing yards (1,115) and 11th in points responsible for/game (18.0).

### CO-NEWCOMER

#### **Sam Franklin, RB • 5-10, 195, R-Fr. • Little Rock, Ark. • UT Martin**

Franklin became the eighth player in UT Martin history to tally three rushing touchdowns in a game, scoring two touchdowns in the third quarter and another in the fourth in the Skyhawks win over Lindenwood. Franklin was highly efficient by averaging 9.3 yards per carry while scoring touchdowns on runs of three, 16 and 21 yards, respectively. He is the 15th FCS player this season to rush for three or more touchdowns in a single game.

## NOTES FROM AROUND THE GRIDIRON

**Quick Hitters:** UT Martin's **Zak Wallace** ran for 204 yards in the Skyhawks win over Lindenwood on September 26, making him one of two OVC players with a 200-yard rushing game this season (TSU's **Devon Starling** is the other); the only other conferences to have two different players with 200 or more rushing yards in a game this year are the CAA and SWAC ... Wallace had a 97-yard touchdown run against Lindenwood (Sept. 26), which is tied for the longest by a Division I (FBS or FCS) player this season ... September 17, SEMO RB **Geno Hess** rushed for one and caught a pair of touchdown passes in a win over Nicholls; he is the first OVC running back to catch multiple touchdown passes in a game since UTM's Peyton Logan against Samford on September 11, 2021 ... SEMO linebacker **Bryce Norman** tallied 17 tackles against Nicholls, the most by an OVC player since Murray State's Anthony Koclanakis had 18 on November 2, 2021, and the fifth-most by a FCS player this season ... Tennessee Tech leads the OVC and ranks 12th nationally in fewest penalties (12) and fewest penalty yards (118) ... Eastern Illinois is fourth nationally in net punting (41.18 yards/punt) and third in passes intercepted (7) ... UT Martin has only allowed one sack this season to lead the FCS (0.25/game allowed) while SEMO ranks seventh in the category (0.75/game allowed) ... EIU's **Elijahaw Tolbert** has three interceptions this season, which ranks him fifth nationally (0.8/game); he had two interceptions against Murray State, making him one of three OVC players with multiple interceptions in a game this season ... SEMO's **Paxton DeLaurent** is seventh nationally in total offense (317.2 yards/game) and eighth in total passing yards (1,115) ... UT Martin's **Colton Dowell** has 2,131 career receiving yards, the third-most in school history (363 yards away from the record) ... SEMO WR **Johnny King** had 14 receptions at No. 17 Southern Illinois on September 10; it is the second-most by a FCS player this season (15 is the top mark) and he ranks sixth nationally in receptions/game (7.5) ... SEMO kicker **DC Pippin** nailed a 50-yard field goal at Southern Illinois, making it one of eight field goals of 50 yards or longer this season at the FCS level.

**Top 25 Polls:** After its win over Lindenwood, UT Martin is now No. 15 in the Stats Perform Poll (up three spots) and No. 17 in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll (up two spots). The Skyhawks finished last season ranked No. 12 in the Coaches Poll, its highest end-of-season finish in school history, and was ranked as high as No. 8 (matching its highest ranking). Southeast Missouri finally debuted in the Stats Perform Poll at No. 24 after its 3-1 start (the team is receiving votes in the Coaches Poll); it marks the first time the Redhawks have been ranked since March 1, 2021). Every current OVC team (except newly Division I Lindenwood) has been ranked in the Top 25 polls for at least one week over the past six years (2016-21).

**2022 Schedule:** The 2022 OVC football schedule features the seven league members playing five Conference games apiece (the exception being new member Lindenwood who will play four). There is not a full round robin this year as most teams' non-conference schedules were full (including a previously announced non-conference scheduling partnership with the Southland Conference) when Lindenwood joined the league in February 2022. Eastern Illinois and Lindenwood will play on October 15 but will not count in the OVC standings.

**NCAA Division I Playoff Information:** In 2010 the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) playoff field expanded to 20 teams, up from 16 previously, and in 2013 the field increased to 24 for the first time. The expansion in 2010 to 20 teams was the first since the field grew from 12 to 16 teams in 1997. The 24-team field is comprised of 11 automatic bids and 13 at-large berths. There are eight first round matchups (16 total teams), while eight (8) teams receive a bye into the second round. For the 14th time in 2022, the championship game will be played in Frisco, Texas at Toyota Stadium, a 20,500-seat multi-purpose stadium. The Southland Conference will serve as the host of the championship, which will be held on Saturday, January 7.

**Recent Playoff Success:** Beginning with the 2001 season the OVC went until 2013 without a FCS Playoff victory. But over the past nine seasons OVC teams have performed well in the playoffs, winning 13 total games and advancing to the FCS Quarterfinals three times in the past six seasons. In 2013 the OVC placed three teams in the field for the first-time ever (each won a game) and in 2015 the league had a team advance to the National Championship game (the first for the league since 1982). Over the past nine years six different teams that have represented the OVC have won a playoff game (Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Jacksonville State, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State and UT Martin).

**Six Different OVC Teams With Playoff Wins Since 2013:** The OVC is one of just four FCS Conferences to have six different teams win a playoff game over the past nine years (2013-2021). Over that time Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Jacksonville State, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State and UT Martin have all won at least one game while representing the OVC. The other conferences to have six different teams win over that period are the CAA, Missouri Valley and Southern Conferences.

**Walter Payton Award Watch List:** Southeast Missouri senior running back **Geno Hess** was one of 35 players nationally named to the Walter Payton Award Watch List by Stats Perform. The award is presented after the season to the national offensive player of the year in college football's Division I subdivision. More players can join the watch list during the regular season, and afterwards a national media panel will select the winner. First awarded in 1987, the Payton has been won by an OVC player twice, Tony Romo in 2002 and Jimmy Garoppolo in 2013.

**Buck Buchanan Award Watch List:** UT Martin graduate linebacker **John H. Ford II** is one of 35 players nationally named to the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List by Stats Perform. The award is presented to the national defensive player of the year in college football's Division I subdivision. More players can join the watch list during the regular season, and afterwards a national media panel will select the winner. First awarded in 1995, the Buchanan Award has twice been won by an OVC player, Jacksonville State's Darius Jackson (2017) and SEMO's Zach Hall (2018).

**Deacon Jones Trophy Watch List:** Three Tennessee State football players have been named to the Watch List for the Black College Football Player of the Year Award. The award, known as the Deacon Jones Trophy, is presented annually to the most outstanding college football player from a Historically Black College & University (HBCU). The players were quarterback **Draylen Ellis**, running back **Devon Starling** and linebacker **James Green**. Four finalists will be unveiled after the season. The winner of the Black College Football Player of the Year Award, which will be announced during halftime of the 2023 HBCU Legacy Bowl on Saturday, February 25, 2023 in New Orleans, Louisiana. TSU's Chris Rowland won the award in 2019.

**Hess on CFPA National Performer of the Year Watch List:** Southeast Missouri running back **Geno Hess** is one of 38 players on the initial Watch List for the College Football Performance Awards (CFPA) National Performer of the Year Award.

**Individual Awards Winners:** Since 2013, the OVC has produced one Walter Payton Award Winner, two Buck Buchanan Award Winners, an Eddie Robinson Award Winner and a Deacon Jones Trophy winner. In addition, the league has had two Doris Robinson Award Winners, as the National Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

**Three OVC Players Named to FCS Punter of the Year Watch List:** Three OVC players have been named to the 2022 FCS Punter of the Year Award Watch List by the Augusta Sports Council. The OVC picks, who were among the 22 nationally on the list, were Southeast Missouri's **Zach Haynes**, Tennessee State's **Kaleb Mosely** and Mur-

ray State's **Lewis Halton**. The FCS Punter of the Year Award winner will be voted on by the FCS Punter of the Year Award/Ray Guy Award Committee and will be announced after regular season play commences.

**Simpson Ranks Fourth in OVC Career Victories:** UT Martin head coach **Jason Simpson** currently ranks fourth in OVC history for career victories. Simpson recorded his 100th victory in the Skyhawks FCS Playoff win over Missouri State in 2021. Including Simpson, only 22 active FCS coaches have 100 or more career wins.

**OVC Teams Against FBS Opponents:** In seven of the past 12 seasons (2010-21), an OVC team has knocked off a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent (2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2016, 2017, 2020). OVC teams are 36-265-1 all-time against FBS opponents.

**OVC and Big South Association:** In February 2022 the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions, to begin with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season and have an initial term of at least four years. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible.

**OVC and Southland Conference Partner For Non-Conference Scheduling Alliance:** In October 2021, the OVC and Southland Conference announced a football scheduling alliance for the 2022 and 2023 seasons. The collaboration will see institutions from each conference fill available non-conference dates on schedules in 2022 and 2023 with a focus toward competitive balance and reasonable travel. The alliance provides quality Division I FCS non-conference matchups, allows increased visibility, exposure and branding for each Conference. There are eight matchups on the schedule (with a ninth involving Lindenwood who joined the OVC after the schedule was set). OVC teams are 3-0 so far against Southland schools in 2022.

**Martin Named National Special Teams Player of the Week (Sept. 12):** Lindenwood's **Andrew Martin** was named the FedEx Ground FCS National Special Teams Player of the Week by Stats Perform for his performance in the Lions' 21-20 win over Houston Baptist on September 10. Martin recovered a blocked punt in the HBU end zone with 28 seconds remaining to give Lindenwood a road victory in its first game as an FCS program. The Lions trailed 20-15 when Jalen Bethany blocked the punt. Martin entered the game without a career TD, but he had two, first scoring on a four-yard run in the third quarter to pull LU to within 20-12. He finished with 49 rushing yards and also had a special teams tackle.

**Sgt. York Trophy Presented by Delta Dental:** The Sgt. York Trophy (founded in 2007 by the Nashville Sports Council and sponsored by Delta Dental) goes to the winner of the season football series between the four OVC football-playing schools located in the state of Tennessee (originally it included four schools, but beginning in 2022 includes three schools: Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin). The award is named in honor of Alvin C. York, the most noted Soldier of World War I. As a corporal in the 2nd battalion, 328th Infantry, in the Battle of the Meuse River-Argonne (Oct. 8, 1918), York and seven other soldiers captured 132 prisoners, was promoted to sergeant and received the Distinguished Service Cross, the French Croix de Guerre, the French Legion of Honor, the Croce di Guerra of Italy and the War Medal of Montenegro. Upon his return to the United States in 1919, he was bestowed the Congressional Medal of Honor. Last season UT Martin went 3-0 to claim the title.

**Academic Success:** During the past academic year (2021-22) there were 103 OVC football student-athletes who were named to the Commissioner's Honor Roll for having a 3.25 grade point average or higher. In addition, 10 student-athletes were awarded the OVC Academic Medal of Honor for achieving perfect 4.0 GPAs.

**A Look at the Coaches:** Five coaches from last season return to their respective teams in 2022. Among the newcomers is first-year Eastern Illinois head coach **Chris Wilkerson**, who played for the Panthers and was later an assistant coach. Also new to the league is **Jed Stugart**, who begins his sixth year (fifth season) at Lindenwood, who joined the OVC on July 1. In addition to Wilkerson, Tennessee Tech's **Dewayne Alexander** is also coaching at his alma mater. The longest tenured coach in the league is UT Martin's **Jason Simpson** who enters his 17th season with the Skyhawks in 2022; Simpson is the fourth-winningest coach in OVC history.

**Alexander on NCAA Committee on Ethical Conduct and Sportsmanship:** Beginning this season Tennessee Tech head coach **Dewayne Alexander** is on the NCAA's Committee on Ethical Conduct and Sportsmanship. The committee's mission is to improve the condition of sportsmanship and ethical conduct in all aspects of college athletics by developing and implementing strategies that foster greater acceptance of the value of respect, fairness, civility, honesty and responsibility. Since the establishment of the committee, the group has focused on two areas: (1) provide best practices and creative tools (e.g., the RESPECT campaign) for campus and conference implementation and (2) increase the awareness and profile of the NCAA Sportsmanship Awards.

**UT Martin Tabbed Preseason OVC Favorite:** Coming off an OVC Championship and its first FCS Playoff victory, UT Martin has been picked as the preseason football favorites in the Ohio Valley Conference for the 2022 season. The Skyhawks picked up 10 of a possible 14 first-place votes in a poll of league head coaches and communications directors. It marked the first time the Skyhawks have been picked the preseason favorites since joining the league prior to the 1992 season. UT Martin totaled 70 points to finish ahead of Southeast Missouri (59). Murray State (51) was tabbed third, just ahead of Tennessee State (46), who also picked up a first-place vote. The poll was rounded out by Tennessee Tech (29), Eastern Illinois (20) and Lindenwood (19).

**Hess and Ford Headline Preseason All-OVC Team:** Southeast Missouri senior running back **Geno Hess** and UT Martin graduate student linebacker **John H. Ford II** were named the 2022 OVC Preseason Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year in a vote of by the league's head football coaches and communications directors. Tennessee State and UT Martin led the way with eight selections apiece, while Eastern Illinois and Murray State had seven players apiece, Southeast Missouri had six selections, Tennessee Tech added three and newcomer Lindenwood had two players on the team. Returning players who were first- or second-team All-OVC selections last year were automatic selections to the preseason team this year.

**NFL Connections:** As of September 19, there were 13 former OVC players on NFL rosters (8 active, 4 practice squad and 1 IR). Overall the OVC has produced at least one NFL Draft Pick in 14 of the past 19 years (2003-21). In January 2020, Eastern Illinois alum Jimmy Garoppolo became just the eighth former FCS quarterback to start a Super Bowl, doing so with the San Francisco 49ers. For Super Bowl LV in February 2021, there were four participants with OVC connections including a player (Josh Pearson), a coach (Rick Christophel), an official (Jabir Walker) and a broadcaster (Tony Romo).

**Romo Becomes Sixth College Football Hall of Famer With OVC Connections:** In December 2021 former Eastern Illinois quarterback **Tony Romo** was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame Class. Romo is the third player that played in the OVC to be inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame joining Jim Youngblood from Tennessee Tech and George Floyd Jr., from Eastern Kentucky. Three former head coaches from the OVC have also been inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame with Roy Kidd (Eastern Kentucky), James "Boots" Donnelly (Middle Tennessee/Austin Peay) and Frank Beamer (Murray State). At EIU Romo was the winner of the 2002 Walter Payton Award as the top player in the FCS. After going undrafted in 2003, he would put together a standout NFL career with the Dallas Cowboys from 2003-16. The four-time Pro Bowl selection holds Cowboy records for career passing yards and passing touchdowns. Since retiring with the Cowboys, Romo has served as the lead color analyst for CBS' NFL telecasts, working alongside Jim Nantz.

**Let's Get It Started:** The 75th season of Ohio Valley Conference football got underway on Thursday, September 1. The OVC is made up of seven football-playing schools in 2022. Since its beginning, 15 of the 19 total schools that have played football in the league have claimed at least one championship.

**I-AA No More:** Although some people may still refer to it as I-AA football, the term that represents the level of Division I football in which the Ohio Valley Conference competes has been long retired. Beginning with the 2006 National Championship game, the term Football Championship Subdivision (or FCS) is to be used. Teams who play at the FCS level can offer a maximum of 63 scholarships (Football Bowl Subdivision teams can offer 85) and compete in a playoff at the end of the season to determine the national champion.

**FCS All-In:** Each week during the 2022 football season, "FCS All-In" will debut a new episode on ESPN+ each Friday night at 6pm CT. The program is a collaborative effort of the NCAA's 15 Division I FCS Conferences..

**ESPN+:** This season every Conference football game (and select non-conference contests) will be broadcast on ESPN+. This marks the fifth year of the OVC's deal with ESPN+, the multi-sport, direct-to-consumer video service from The Walt Disney Company's Direct-to-Consumer & International segment. Fans can subscribe to ESPN+ for \$9.99 a month (or \$99.99 per year) or as part of a bundle with Disney+ and ad-supported Hulu (\$13.99/month). ESPN+ is an integrated part of the ESPN App and (on mobile and connected devices) and ESPN.com. More information can be found at [www.OVCsports.com/ESPN](http://www.OVCsports.com/ESPN).

## SGT. YORK TROPHY

The 2022 season marks the 16th of competition for the Sergeant York Trophy, an award created by the Nashville Sports Council and the Ohio Valley Conference. The trophy is contested between the OVC football-playing schools in the state of Tennessee - Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin - and goes to the team with the best combined record versus those schools in a given year.

The award is sponsored by Delta Dental of Tennessee.

In the event of a tie, the award will be shared; however, the previous winner will retain the trophy if they are part of the tie. If the tie is between two other institutions, the trophy will go to the institution that has gone the most seasons without winning the trophy.

The award is the only traveling trophy that involves four teams in college sports; there are three others that involve three teams, including the Commander in Chief's Trophy which has been contested between Air Force, Army and Navy annually since 1972. The award is named in honor of Alvin C. York, the most noted Soldier of World War I. Upon his return to the United States in 1919, he was bestowed the Congressional Medal of Honor. Following the war York returned his home in Pall Mall, Tenn. where he dedicated his life to improving education and facilitating educational opportunities for children in the state of Tennessee.

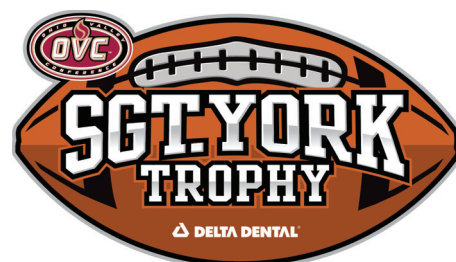

#### OVC NOTABLES

- Every current OVC team (except newly Division I Lindenwood) has been ranked in the Top 25 polls for at least one week over the past six years (2016-21).
- The OVC has placed multiple teams in the FCS Playoffs seven times in the past 12 years (2010-21).
- The OVC is one of just four FCS Conferences to have six different teams win a playoff game over the past nine years (2013-2021). Over that time Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Jacksonville State, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State and UT Martin have all won at least one game while representing the OVC. The other conferences to have six different teams win over that period are the CAA, Missouri Valley and Southern Conferences.
- OVC teams have 13 playoff wins since 2013, including five Quarterfinal appearances and one National Championship game appearance.
- Since 2013, the OVC has produced one Walter Payton Award Winner, two Buck Buchanan Award Winners, an Eddie Robinson Award Winner and a Deacon Jones Trophy winner. In addition, the league has had two Doris Robinson Award Winners, as the National Scholar-Athlete of the Year.
- In seven of the past 12 seasons (2010-21), an OVC team has knocked off a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent (2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2016, 2017, 2020).
- The OVC has produced at least one NFL Draft Pick in 14 of the last 19 years (2003-21).
- In January 2020, OVC alum Jimmy Garoppolo became just the eighth former FCS quarterback to start in a Super Bowl, doing so with the San Francisco 49ers. Last season 11 former OVC players were on active rosters at the end of the year.
- Former EIU quarterback Tony Romo was selected to the 2021 College Football Hall of Fame Class. He is the third former OVC player to be inducted (Jim Youngblood, George Floyd Jr.); in addition, there are also three former OVC coaches (Roy Kidd, Boots Donnelly, Frank Beamer) already enshrined.
- Over the previous 74 years, 15 of 18 teams that have competed have claimed at least one league championship.

#### **NOTEWORTHY**

- After an open date, Tennessee State returns to action in its first home contest of the season in hosting Lane College.
- The in-state HBCU foes have played nine previous times but not since 1996.
- The game serves as the annual John Merritt Classic, which takes place for the 23rd time in 2022 (the event was first held in 1999). The game takes place on the TSU campus at Hale Stadium, the only game at that venue this season (the Tigers other four games are at Nissan Stadium).
- TSU is 16-6 all-time in the event, having won three in a row and six of its last seven JMC games. That includes topping Kentucky State 41-7 at year ago.
- Tennessee State has played a challenging schedule, taking on two nationally-ranked FCS opponent and FBS foe Middle Tennessee, who topped nationally-ranked Miami (Fla.) last week.
- Through three games, junior running back Devon Starling ranks 20th nationally in rushing yards/game (97.3).
- TSU is 3-of-3 in the red zone this season, tied for first nationally.
- Lane, located in Jackson, Tennessee, competes in the Division II SIAC and enters this week with a two-game winning streak. The Dragons lost to FCS foe Arkansas-Pine Bluff 48-42 in the opening game of the season.
- Last week the team overcame a 7-0 halftime deficit and scored 13 points in the final quarter to top Edward Waters 20-9. Lane allowed an opening drive touchdowns
- Tarik McKinzie passed for two touchdowns and rushed for 31 yards for Lane while Michael Huntley added 95 passing and 41 rushing yards.
- Jeffrey Johnson had a team-high 12 tackles (including 3.0 for loss) and forced a fumble.

#### **NOTEWORTHY**

- In-state OVC foes Southeast Missouri and Lindenwood meet for the first time on Saturday. It marks the first home OVC game for Lindenwood, who officially joined the OVC on July 1.
- This marks the first time there have been two OVC schools in the state of Missouri.
- Southeast Missouri improved to 3-0 against FCS teams this season with a 35-27 victory over ASUN foe Central Arkansas. The Redhawks scored 21 second quarter points to grab a 28-17 advantage.
- SEMO is ranked No. 24 in the Stats Perform Poll, its first ranking since March 1, 2021. This marks the second-straight Top 25 opponent for Lindenwood.
- Right before halftime Dalyn McDonald returned a kickoff 97 yards for a touchdown to shift the momentum for the Redhawks. It was the first kick return score for SEMO in four years. The 97-yard return was tied for the second-longest in school history.
- Quarterback Paxton DeLaurent was named OVC Newcomer of the Week for the third-straight week after accounting for 312 yards of total offense and three touchdowns. He completed 17-of-31 passes for 252 yards and two touchdowns through the air and ran for 60 yards and another score. DeLaurent ranks seventh nationally in total offense (317.2 yards/game), eighth in passing yards (1,115) and 11th in points responsible for/game (18.0).
- As a team, SEMO finished with 457 total yards and limited UCA to only 16 rushing yards. The 16 yards were the fifth-fewest in a game the Redhawks held their opponent to during their FCS era.
- Linebacker Bryce Norman had eight tackles and recovered a fumble to score a touchdown in the game. He has 98 career tackles in less than two seasons.
- Lindenwood played its first OVC game at UT Martin this past week. The Lions trailed 14-13 late in the second quarter before allowing a score right before halftime. UTM would then explode for 21 third quarter points
- Wide receiver Payton Rose caught seven passes for 156 yards in the game. Through three games Rose has 17 catches for 369 yards. His 123.0 yards/game ranks first in the OVC by over 30 yards.
- Logan Seibert connected on two field goals and is now 6-for-7 on the season, including four from over 40 yards.

### **NOTEWORTHY**

- For the 44th time, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin will meet on the gridiron. The game between in-state foes is part of the Sgt. York Trophy series, which is contested between the three OVC schools in the state of Tennessee.

- UT Martin has won eight-straight games at Hardy Graham Stadium. The team is ranked No. 15/17 this week; it will be the second-straight Top 25 opponent for TTU.

- UT Martin has won nine in a row in the series, including 42-3 a season ago. In that matchup, the Skyhawks outgained the Golden Eagles 462 to 247.

- Tennessee Tech is coming off a bye week. The Golden Eagles opened the season against FBS Kansas (who is 4-0), followed by two FCS opponents where the game came down to the final minutes.

- Tech topped Texas A&M-Commerce on a touchdown with two seconds left before giving up a touchdown to No. 24 Samford with 25 seconds left to fall 33-28.

- Newcomer quarterback Jeremiah Oatsvall has passed for 557 yards and five touchdowns and rushed for 154 yards and another score in three games for TTU.

- Seth Carlisle leads the team with 25 tackles (17 solo) through three games.

- UT Martin started OVC play with a 56-26 victory over Lindenwood. The Skyhawks scored 35 second half points to pull away from the Lions. UTM finished the game with 541 yards of total offense.

- Zak Wallace was named OVC Offensive Player of the Week after rushing for 204 yards and two touchdowns on just 11 carries. That included a 97-yard touchdown run, which is tied for the longest by a FCS player this season. Wallace now has 22 career rushing touchdowns in three seasons, tied for third in program history.

- Redshirt freshman Sam Franklin added three touchdown runs on just six carries. He is just the eighth player in UTM history with three rushing scores in a single game.

- UT Martin did not allow a sack for the third game this season; they have only allowed one sack (late against Boise State) all season. The UTM defense tallied four sacks and leads the OVC with 14 in 2022.

- Quarterback Dresser Winn posted the ninth multi-touchdown performance of his career after tossing two touchdowns in the win over Lindenwood.

### **NOTEWORTHY**

- Murray State will play its third road game of the season when it travels to Southeastern Louisiana on Saturday. It marks the second all-time meeting between the schools and first since 1979.

- The game is part of the non-conference scheduling alliance between the OVC and the Southland.

- Murray State had over 400 yards of total offense in its OVC opening loss to Eastern Illinois, but the team had five turnovers and was unable to force EIU into any miscues.

- Redshirt sophomore quarterback Jayden Stinson returned from injury to get the first start of his collegiate career. He finished the game 28-of-46 for 334 yards and three touchdowns, but had four interceptions.

- LaMartez Brooks, DeQuan Dallas and Taylor Shields all had touchdowns in the game with Dallas leading the receiving corps with 97 yards on nine catches.

- For the second time in as many games, Jamari Dailey led the defense with nine tackles, while Lawaun Powell and Jaylon Bolden followed with eight.

- Lewis Halton had another big day of punting, with an average of 42.3 yards on four punts with a long of 47 and one being downed inside the 20-yard line.

- After back-to-back losses to FBS foes, Southeastern topped Central Connecticut State 70-6 in week three before upsetting No. 4 ranked Incarnate Word last week.

- With the win the Lions jumped back into the Top 25 polls, coming in at No. 21 in the Stats Perform Top 25 and No. 24 in the FCS Coaches Poll.

- With the score tied and time expiring, CJ Turner ran down a 59-yard touchdown pass from Eli Sawyer to give the Lions the 41-35 victory. It marked the highest-ranked opponent SLU has defeated since a 34-21 win over No. 4 Sam Houston on Nov. 16, 2013.

- Turner finished the game with 139 receiving yards and two touchdowns on five catches.

- Donte' Daniels led SLU with 11 tackles and shares the team lead of 28 with Anthony Britton Jr.
