"Well the good thing about this team, particularly the last third of the season, they became mentally tougher. As we started to face teams the second time around, we played them tougher, we played them differently, and they allowed us to make adjustments. I feel like we really grew up as a team to take a team that was a Final Four program (Oregon), beat them in Pullman, and then have them on the ropes to beat them again here along with Stanford at Stanford, Cal at Cal, the Utah game, and the Colorado game, we've played some outstanding basketball coming down the stretch. We made some mistakes in this game, and we did a lot of good things in this game too. At the end of the day, we don't have a (Kenny) Wooten and Wooten made some big plays - two big blocks to win the game for them. Those were big time plays, and I don't have that guy, we have to go find that guy. I'm proud of the way this team battled and I'm really proud at the way Malachi (Flynn) battled especially in the last third of the season...'

On Defensive Effort

"It was the best defense we have played since I've been here. We've beaten teams with the zone defense; we have beaten teams with the 1-3-1 tapping defense. I'm sure it shocked them (Ore.) that we could be that good, and take a team that athletic, that big, and lock them up in man-to-man defense.
