- 8** The Pac-12's eight teams in the NCAA RPI Top 50 and 11 teams in the RPI Top 75 as of Jan. 19 are tied for the most in the nation with the ACC. (Additional rankings on Pg. 4 of notes)

## PAC-12 QUICK HITS

**TOP 100 CHARTS:** Through Jan. 18, the Pac-12 has 57 wins against NCAA RPI Top 100 teams, led by ARIZONA (5-3), CALIFORNIA (5-5), COLORADO (6-4), OREGON (7-3), USC (6-3) and UTAH (8-5). The Pac-12 has 32 total wins versus the RPI Top 50, paced by OREGON (6-2), CALIFORNIA (4-4), USC (4-2) and UTAH (4-4).

**CONFERENCE OF REBOUNDS:** Through games of Jan. 18, Pac-12 programs have a combined average rebound total of 39.6, the highest of any conference.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** ARIZONA owns NCAA Division I's longest active home win streak at 49 consecutive games. OREGON has won 18 in a row at home, the 11th longest streak in the nation, while USC and CALIFORNIA have both won 12 straight at home.

**FIRST TO 90 WINS?:** There have been 11 instances of a Pac-12 team reaching the 90-point plateau through the 30 total league games of Jan. 18. During the entire 2014-15 Pac-12 season, teams reached the 90-point mark a total of 12 times. The Pac-12 is second nationally in scoring at 78.1 ppg.

## #PAC12HOOPS SUBS

**BRACKETOLOGY:** Prognosticators continue to predict a record haul of NCAA Tournament bids for the Pac-12 with ESPN.com's Joe Lunardi including a national-best eight schools and CBSSports.com's Jerry Palm picking seven with another two in his First Four Out.

**SIGN OF THINGS TO COME?:** In four of the past nine seasons, the Pac-12 has sent six teams into the NCAA Tournament. In each of those four instances, the league won more than 75 percent of its non-conference games. In 2015-16, the Pac-12 posted a .780 non-league win percentage.

**TOPPLING THE TOP 25:** Pac-12 teams posted a combined seven wins against Top 25 teams in non-conference play, tied for the second-most in the nation behind the ACC. Five of those upsets came in a span of 20 days (11/30-12/19). In total, Pac-12 teams have combined for 13 Top 25 wins with road sweeps of ARIZONA, UCLA and UTAH in the opening two weeks of league play.

## PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK

### JOSH SCOTT, COLORADO Senior, 6-10, F/C, Monument, Colo.

Senior Josh Scott recorded a double-double in both of COLORADO's victories this week to earn his first career Pac-12 Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week award.

Scott averaged 21.0 points on 61 percent shooting (14-23) and 11.5 rebounds along with 2.5 blocks and 2.0 assists as COLORADO (14-4, 3-2) moved into a four-way tie for third place in the Pac-12 with home victories over OREGON STATE and OREGON.

The 6-10 forward/center opened the week with a season-high 25 points on 8-of-11 shooting from both the field and foul line, 12 rebounds and three blocks as the Buffaloes eased by the Beavers. Scott posted his fourth consecutive double-double and 10th of the season with 17 points and 11 boards in a 91-87 victory over the Ducks.

The third Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year nominee to earn a Pac-12 Player of the Week award this season (Poeltl - UTAH, Hawkinson - WSU), Scott is currently the only player ranked in the top 5 in the league in scoring (2nd, 17.8 ppg), rebounding (4th, 9.8 rpg), field goal percentage (5th, 57.5%) and blocks (T-5th, 1.8 bpg). **ALSO NOMINATED:** Kaleb Tarczewski, ARIZ; Dillon Brooks, ORE; Gary Payton II, OSU; Rosco Allen, STAN; Jordan McLaughlin, USC; Andrew Andrews, WASH.

### Larry Krystkowiak, Utah

"I talked to some folks from out east - [ESPN's] Jeff Goodman and some guys that are involved with college basketball - and they all thought from top-to-bottom it was as strong a league as there was in the country."

"I think the Pac-12 has shown that it's one of, if not the, premier conference out there. When you look at the upsets, the consistency of play in the conference, it's going to be an incredible conference. It hasn't been like this in a long time where game-in-game-out, night-in-night-out the games are going to be extremely competitive."

"As a result [of several marquee wins], the Pac-12 on a national scale has gotten a lot of recognition. Our depth is very strong right now, our strength of schedule as a conference has been great in the non-conference, we've had some notable wins, and I think that lends itself to show that there is not just depth, but quality depth in the conference this year."

### Sean Miller, Arizona

"From top to bottom, the depth and quality of teams - so many of them having improved from a year or two ago - it's the deepest conference we have competed in as a coaching staff. I think we have a strong top, an equally strong middle, and whoever finishes at the bottom will be among the better bottom teams in the Pac-12 in recent seasons."

## PAC-12 CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION



**#100Pac12:** The Pac-12 Conference is set to celebrate 100 years of excellence. The yearlong celebration of the Conference centennial, including marking the date of the official formation 100 years ago on December 2, will kick off with the start of the football season and continue throughout the 2015-16 academic year.

The Conference's storied history dates back 100 years to Dec. 2, 1915 when four schools - the University of California, Oregon Agricultural College (now Oregon State University), the University of Oregon and the University of Washington - gathered at the historic Imperial Hotel in Portland, Ore., to form the Pacific Coast Conference.

Since that day, the Conference has been known for its widespread excellence - on the field, in the classroom, and with the contributions its graduates make in the world. No other Conference can match the collective achievements and distinctions accomplished over the last century.

The Conference has been home to some of sports' legendary athletes and coaches. Dubbed the "Conference of Champions," Pac-12 schools have won 478 NCAA titles, by far more than any other conference, as well as over 2,000 individual national championships.
