HOME SWEET HOME: The Pac-12 owns two of the nation's top 10 longest home-court win streaks. OREGON is tied for the nation's fifth-best streak at 23 straight games after the Ducks ended ARIZONA's national-best 49-game streak on Jan. 28.

CALIFORNIA is tied for the ninth-best home streak in the country at 17 consecutive victories.

#PAC12HOOPS SUBS

CONTEXT TO STANDOUT YEAR: Since the NCAA adjusted the RPI formula to account for game location in 2004-05, the league's best Conference RPI entering Selection Sunday came in 2013-14 at .5695. The Pac-12 currently boasts a Conference RPI of .5860, second-best in the country, according to CBSSports.com's Jerry Palm. That .5860 rating would tie for the second-highest since 2004-05 (Big 12 in 2009-10), trailing only the Big 12's current .5960 rating this season.

The only other league to have at least 11 teams in the RPI Top 100 entering Selection Sunday during this time frame was the old Big East (13 - 2006, 2010; 11 - 2009, 2011-13).

TOP 100 CHARTS: Through Feb. 22, the Pac-12 has 109 wins against NCAA RPI Top 100 teams, led by ARIZONA (13-5), CALIFORNIA (11-7), OREGON (16-5), USC (10-8) and UTAH (14-7).

The Pac-12 has 50 total wins versus the RPI Top 50, paced by OREGON (9-3), OREGON STATE (6-6) and UTAH (7-6).

OREGON (4-1), OREGON STATE (3-4), UTAH (3-4) and STANFORD (3-6) combine for 13 of the Pac-12's 20 RPI Top 25 wins.

PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK

JAKOB POELTL, UTAH Sophomore, 7-0, F/C, Vienna, Austria

UTAH's national player of the year candidate Jakob Poeltl recorded the 11th and 12th double-doubles of his sophomore campaign to earn his fourth Pac-12 Conference men's basketball Player of the Week award of the season.

In victories at UCLA and USC, the Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy candidate and Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year finalist averaged 22.0 points on 64 percent shooting (18-28), 12.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists, 2.5 steals and 1.5 blocks as UTAH (21-7, 10-5) became the first Pac-12 team this season to complete two road sweeps in conference play.

The 7-0 forward/center from Vienna, Austria went for 15 points and 11 rebounds as UTAH secured its first win at UCLA since 1961 on Thursday, then matched a career-high versus a Pac-12 opponent with 29 points along with 13 boards and a career-best four steals as the Utes ended USC's 16-game home win streak on Sunday.

Poeltl's four Player of the Week selections this season tie the second-most in one season in conference history (Eddie House in 1999-00, Ed O'Bannon in 1994-95, Gary Payton in 1989-90), trailing only Quincy Pondexter's five awards in 2009-10. His four career selections are tied for the 14th-most in league annals. He is the Pac-12's leader in field goal percentage (.668) and is second in scoring (18.1 ppg), third in rebounding (9.0 rpg) and seventh in blocked shots (1.4 bpg).

PAC-12 CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION



#100Pac12: The Pac-12 Conference is set to celebrate 100 years of excellence. The yearlong celebration of the Conference centennial, including marking the date of the official formation 100 years ago on December 2, will kick off with the start of the football season and continue throughout the 2015-16 academic year.

The Conference's storied history dates back 100 years to Dec. 2, 1915 when four schools - the University of California, Oregon Agricultural College (now Oregon State University), the University of Oregon and the University of Washington - gathered at the historic Imperial Hotel in Portland, Ore., to form the Pacific Coast Conference.

Since that day, the Conference has been known for its widespread excellence - on the field, in the classroom, and with the contributions its graduates make in the world. No other Conference can match the collective achievements and distinctions accomplished over the last century.

The Conference has been home to some of sports' legendary athletes and coaches. Dubbed the "Conference of Champions," Pac-12 schools have won 478 NCAA titles, by far more than any other conference, as well as over 2,000 individual national championships.

PAC-12 TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE-SEEDING & TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

Seeding: The seedings and pairings shall be determined upon completion of regular season play on Saturday, March 5. The won-lost percentage record of the teams in regular season Conference play will determine tournament seedings. The team with the best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #1, the next best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #2, and so forth through all the seeds.

Tie-Breakers: Tie breaking procedures for determining all tournament seeding will be:

1. Two-team tie

- Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
- Each team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

2. Multiple-team tie

- Results (won-lost percentage) of collective head-to-head competition during the regular season among the tied teams.
- If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage. When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.
