RIVALRY MATCHES HIGHLIGHTS WOMEN'S BASKETBALL MATCHUPS

• Rivalry play begins this week, featuring home-and-home clashes between No. 8 OREGON and No. 22 OREGON STATE, as well as WASHINGTON and WASHINGTON STATE. All four matchups will be televised on Pac-12 Networks.

• The Ducks are the only team undefeated in league play, also boasting an undefeated home record this season. OSU has lost just one game on its home court this season and has not lost to its rival in 13-straight meetings. The Huskies also have a significant streak over the Cougs, winning the last five matchups.

• Five Pac-12 teams are ranked in the *Associated Press* poll this week, the Ducks receiving a No. 7 ranking, the best in program history. UCLA moved one spot up to No. 13, OSU is back in the top 20 at No. 18, CALIFORNIA also moved up, coming in at No. 21 and ARIZONA STATE ranks 22nd. STANFORD is receiving votes.

• Behind Oregon, Stanford is second in the standings following a four-way tie for third. Cal and Stanford travel to UCLA and USC for the regular-season re-matches on Pac-12 Networks.

• CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe is the Pac-12 Player of the Week after averaging 28.0 points and 13.5 rebounds per game, including a 30-point, 17-rebound outing. UCLA's Michaela Onyenwere was tabbed the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week, averaging a double-double in two wins.

• Four Pac-12 teams have assist-to-turnover ratios in the top 25 in the nation, ASU leading the way at No. 6 (1.51). Four league teams also boast shooting percentages in the top 25 as OSU and UO rank third and fourth in the category.

• Leading the nation in statistical categories are ASU's Reili Richardson who boasts the best assist-to-turnover ratio in the nation at 4.63, and Oregon's Sabrina Ionescu, who boasts four triple-doubles this season.

• UCLA's Jordin Canada became just the third player in Pac-12 history to record 700 career assists last week, also becoming the first to record 1,800 points and 700 assists in league history. Threatening the career assists mark that has stood since 1990-91, she needs just 57 more to match the record. Teammate Monique Billings is looking to become just the 21st player in Conference history with 1,000 rebounds.

• Colorado's Ceal Barry and USC's Tina Thompson are among the 10 finalists for the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame class of 2018. Barry was the head coach of the Buffs for 22 seasons and Thompson was an All-American and the first player drafted into the WNBA.

2018 PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT KEYARENA, SEATTLE, WASH. • THURSDAY-SUNDAY, MARCH 1-4



After drawing a record attendances the last two seasons, the 17th-annual Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament remains in Seattle in partnership with Force 10 Sports Marketing, LLC, the Seattle Sports Commission and Seattle Center. The tournament will be held at KeyArena from March 1-4, 2018 and will receive unprecedented national television coverage once again with each game of the tournament scheduled to be televised either on the Pac-12 Networks or ESPN2.

The City of Seattle has embraced women's basketball and women's athletics. The WNBA's Seattle Storm loyal fan base has increased over the last several years. The majestic city provides convenient travel for teams and fans, with non-stop flights available from every Pac-12 city. In the three years the Pac-12 Tournament has been in the Emerald City, the four-day event has seen its biggest successes, recording three of the top four attendances in the 14-year history. The 2017 tournament set a record for total attendance and had the event's first sold-out session.

The Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament made its debut in 2002 and was held on the University of Oregon campus in Eugene, Ore. The Conference's premier women's sporting event then moved to HP Pavilion at San Jose for a six-year run (2003-08). It spent four years (2008-2012) in Los Angeles, with Galen Center playing host. The final two-year run of the event saw it combined with the men's tournament and the semifinal and championship games were played at the STAPLES Center.

The winner of the 12-team tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeding and Conference Champion are determined by the 18-game regular-season Pac-12 schedule.

CONFERENCE NOTEBOOK

BARRY, THOMPSON NAMED HALL OF FAME FINALISTS

Legendary Colorado head coach and current associate athletic director Ceal Barry and former USC standout Tina Thompson were named one of five finalists for the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame class of 2018. Barry coached the Buffs for 22 seasons from 1983-2005 and led the team to 12 of the 13 NCAA Tournament appearances in program history. Thompson was an All-American while at USC from 1994-97. The Conference's 1994 Freshman of the Year, she was first team all-league her last three seasons. She was also a three-time All-WNBA first team selection and a three-time Olympic gold medalist with Team USA from 2000-08. The class will be announced on Feb. 12. Twelve members of the hall of fame are affiliated with the Pac-12.

RECORDS WATCH

With her fourth triple-double of the season and just 48 games into her career, OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu broke the NCAA's all-time triple-doubles career mark at the pace of one triple-double per six games, much faster than the rate by previous NCAA record holders Suzie McConnell of Penn State (seven for her career at a rate of just over 18 games) and Saint Mary's Louella Tomlinson (seven for a career rate of just under 18 games). Ionescu broke the Pac-12 record set by Stanford's Nicole Powell from 2001-04 when she had six.

PAC-12 IN THE RPI

Six Pac-12 teams have RPI in the top 50, including five in the top 35, as of Jan. 16. Leading the way is OREGON with a RPI of No. 6. UCLA (No. 11), ARIZONA STATE (No. 23) and CALIFORNIA (No. 24) are also in the top 25.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

Three Pac-12 teams went undefeated at home during the non-conference slate, including ARIZONA STATE (7-0), OREGON (8-0) and UTAH (7-0). League teams went 58-13 (.817) at home during non-conference.

The Ducks continue to be undefeated at home (12-0) as it faces its traditional rival OREGON STATE this week. The Sun Devils have also not been beaten on its floor this season, going 9-0. OSU, which hosts UO this week, has only lost once at home, going 10-1.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS

UCLA's Jordin Canada became the 38th player in league history to hit 1,700 points against Fordham in New York. She currently ranks 36th all-time in career points. Canada also ranks fifth all-time in Pac-12 history in career assists. Canada is one of just four players in Pac-12 history to record 1,700 points and 600 assists in a career. The others are Sydney Wiese, OSU (1,824/625), Giuliana Mendiola, UW (1,928/612) and Nikki Blue, UCLA (1,797/602). Canada is on pace to become the first player in Conference history to get to 1,700 pts and 700 assists. She also ranks fifth in Pac-12 history with 288 steals.

Teammate Monique Billings entered the top 25 in Pac-12 history in career rebounds and her 978 rebounds put her 22nd all-time. CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe entered the league's scoring lists, becoming the 64th player in Pac-12 history to score 1,500 points.

NCAA STATS LEADERS

Known for its defense, OREGON STATE is having a strong season on both sides of the ball, recording the best 3-point field goal percentage (42.5) while limiting opponents to 33.1 percent shooting from the floor, which ranks third, as of Jan. 16. Despite having to replace an All-American guard in Sydney Wiese, OSU is sixth in the country, and first in the Pac-12, in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.51) and assists per game (20.9), while also posting the eighth-best blocks average (6.6). The Beavs' rebounding margin of +12.8 is fourth in the country and +20.9 scoring margin is 10th.

OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu continues to lead the country with four triple-doubles this season, while her teammate Ruthy Hebard has the third-best shooting percentage in the nation at 68.5. OSU's Marie Gulich ranks fourth at 67.4 shooting.

ASU's Reili Richardson's 4.09 assist-to-turnover ration is fourth, leading five Pac-12 players in the top 25 in the category.

NCAA ACTIVE LEADERS

Four Pac-12 players can be found among the NCAA's active career leaders (as of Jan. 16). UCLA's Jordin Canada has proven herself to be one of the top point guards in the nation. She currently ranks second in career assists (700) among active players becoming just the third player in Conference history to dish out 700 assists. She is also fourth in the NCAA among active leaders with 295 steals and ranks fifth all-time in the Pac-12.

Bruin teammate Monique Billings' 978 career rebounds ranks sixth among the active players in the nation. CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe currently has the fourth-best career scoring average among players in the country at 20.2 points per game, while OREGON's Lexi Bando's 45.5 career three-point percentage is the best among active players.

TRIPLE DOUBLES GALORE

The NCAA's new triple-double record holder OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu and UCLA's Jordin Canada opened the 2017-18 campaign with a triple-double each and since, have combined for five, giving the Conference 34 instances all-time. Since the start of the 2015-16 campaign, there have been a total of 12 triple-doubles achieved.

Triple-doubles were a rare occurrence in the Pac-12 prior to the 2012-13 campaign. From Feb. 1996-Feb. 4, 2012, only two players had achieved the feat with former Stanford standout Nicole Powell accounting for six instances from Feb. 2001-Mar. 2002 and former UCLA great Noelle Quinn had one triple-double to her credit in Feb. 2004. Since Feb. 2012, there has been at least one triple-double each year.

CENTURY MARK

On the opening day of the season, UCLA scored a school-record 129 points to defeat San Jose State (69) at home. That point total broke a school record and was just a bucket shy of the Pac-12 mark (131, Oregon vs. CSU Bakersfield, Nov. 9, 2013). It was the most points scored by a league team since Oregon dropped 130 vs. Southern on Dec. 18, 2013.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Pac-12 teams collectively went 98-39 during the non-conference regular-season slate. It is the third-straight year the Conference posted a .700 or better winning percentage, going .715. 11 league teams posted at least a .500 record during the non-league slate, marking the fourth-straight year at least 11 teams have done so.

HISTORIC CAMPAIGN

Pac-12 women's basketball is coming off back-to-back historic seasons, sending two teams to the NCAA Women's Final Four for the first time ever in 2015-16 and following up with a Conference-record seven teams earning NCAA Tournament bids. At least one Pac-12 team has reached the national semifinal round in nine of the last 10 years. League teams have not lost in the first round of the NCAA Tournament the last two years, combining for a 12-0 record. Additionally, the Conference has set records for the number of league teams advancing to the Sweet Sixteen and Elite Eight, with a combined nine teams reaching the round of 16. The Pac-12 has also boasted the top conference RPI in the country the last two seasons.

In addition to the overall success of league teams last year, it was a special campaign following Washington's Kelsey Plum break the all-time NCAA scoring record and celebrating Stanford's Tara VanDerveer's 1,000th-career win, a feat only one other Division I women's basketball head coach had achieved and only two men's or women's Division I head coach.

ALL-STAR RETURNS

Nine of the 15 All-Pac-12 honorees return this season, including four of the Conference's top-five scorers and three of the top-five rebounders. UCLA's Monique Billings was one of just two players last season to average a double-double, ranking fifth in scoring (16.7) and second in rebounding (10.5). The last two US-BWA National Freshmen of the Year are among the all-star returnees, with CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe earning the honor in 2016 and OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu picking up the award in 2017. The Pac-12's assist and assist-to-turnover leader UCLA's Jordin Canada also returns.

Other All-Pac-12 honorees on team rosters this season are Oregon's Ruthy Hebard, Oregon State's Marie Gulich, Colorado's Kennedy Leonard, Stanford's Brittany McPhee and USC's Kristen Simon.

NEW FACES & FAMILIAR FACES

The Pac-12 welcomes a pair of new coaches to the sidelines this season. USC's Mark Trakh returns for his second stint as head coach of the Trojans. He spent 2005-2009 in Los Angeles, leading USC to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. Most recently, he was coach at New Mexico State where the team earned three-consecutive NCAA Tournament berths. Jody Wynn takes over at Washington after spending the last eight years as head coach at Long Beach State where she led the team to three-consecutive 20-win campaigns and a NCAA Tournament berth.

ROAD TO COLUMBUS

Teams across the country will be focused on getting to Columbus this season, the site of the 2018 NCAA Women's Final Four. To get to Columbus, Ohio, teams will have to go through regional sites at Lexington, Ky., Albany, N.Y., Kansas City, Mo., and Spokane, Wash. The first and second round of the tournament will take place on 16 campus sites with the top-16 seeds hosting.
