PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL HEADS INTO THANKSGIVING WEEK WITH ANTICIPATED BIG MATCHUPS

Nearly every Pac-12 team hits the road for the week of Thanksgiving and some have potential matchups with some of the nation's highest-ranked programs ... Five Pac-12 teams are featured in the latest *Associated Press* and *USA Today/*WBCA Coaches poll, including three in the top 10. No other conference has as many top-10 ranked teams. OREGON continues to lead the way with a No. 3 ranking in both polls, followed by No. 8/7 STANFORD and No. 9/8 OREGON STATE. CALIFORNIA moved up to No. 18/23 and ARIZONA STATE is No. 19/25 ... Four from the Pac-12 appeared on the WBCA's Wade Watch List which was announced this week. Oregon is represented by Sabrina lonescu and Ruthy Hebard, Cal's Kristine Anigwe is on the list, as is Stanford's Alanna Smith ... ARIZONA's Aari McDonald was voted the Pac-12 Player of the Week making her the first Wildcat to earn the honor since 2015. She enters the week as the nation's scoring leader, averaging 29.5 points per game after netting a school-record tying 39 points on Nov. 19 ... UTAH's Dre'Una Edwards was voted the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week for the second-consecutive week ... The Sun Devils face another top-five challenge when it travels to Las Vegas to face No. 5/4 Louisville on Friday at the South Point Shootout ... The Beavers could also have a couple of big games coming up, potentially facing No. 13/12 South Carolina on Friday and a possible matchup against defending NCAA Champion Notre Dame on Sunday at the Vancouver Showcase.

2019 PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT KEYARENA, LAS VEGAS, NEV. THURSDAY-SUNDAY, MARCH 7-10

After a record-setting six years in Seattle, the 18th-annual Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament presented by New York Life heads to Las Vegas for two years. The tournament will be held at the MGM Grand Garden Arena in 2018 from March 7-10, 2019 and will receive unprecendented television coverage once again as each game of the tournament is scheduled to be televised either on the Pac-12 Networks or ESPN2.

The tournament made its debut in 2002 and has been held annual since. The University of Oregon campus played host the first season. The Conference's premier women's sporting event then moved to HP Pavilion in San Jose for a six-year run (2003-08). It spent four years (2008-2012) in Los Angeles, with Galen Center playing host. The final two-year run of the event saw it combined with the men's tournament and the semifinal and championship games were played at the STAPLES Center. The tournament then moved to Seattle's KeyArena for six years where it saw record attendance numbers each year.

The winner of the 12-team tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeds and Conference Champion are determined by the 18-game regular-season Pac-12 schedule.

ANIGWE APPROACHES MILESTONES

California's Kristine Anigwe is just 49 points from scoring 2,000 in her career. She is also 70 rebounds from her career 1,000th. Only 19 players in Pac-12/10 history have scored 2,000-career points and only 22 have grabbed 1,000 boards. The All-America candidate is also looking to become just the 11th player in league history to both score 2,000 points and grab 1,000 rebounds.

IONESCU OWNS TRIPLE-DOUBLE RECORDS

With her 12th triple-double on Nov. 18 against Buffalo, Oregon junior Sabrina lonescu tied the NCAA men's career record held by Kyle Collinsworth of BYU. She was already the NCAA's women's record holder heading into the season, wasting no time adding to her total by logging her first triple-double in the season opener at Alaska Fairbanks. Calfornia's Kristine Anigwe is currently one of two players in the NCAA that has scored over 1,900 career points. She is looking to become just the 20th player in Pac-12 women's basketball history to reach the 2k threshold. She leads active leaders in the country in free throws made and attempted.

SISTER ACTS

With :38 seconds remaining in the first quarter vs. Saint Mary's on Nov. 11, Washington State's three Molina sisters - Chanelle, Celena, and Cherilyn - appeared on the court together for the first time. The three sisters played 1:21 together on the floor. They are the only trio of active sisters in the Power 5 conferences.

Other sister acts in the Pac-12 include the Moore duo, Minyon and Mariya. The Trojans' Desiree Caldwell older sister Recee is a member of the California Golden Bears and is pursuing a master's degree in public health. The Sabally sisters also wear the same colored jersey in Eugene. Older sister Satou was the Pac-12 Freshman of the Year last season but younger sister freshman Nyara will sit out this season because of an injury.

PRESEASON RANKINGS

For the third-straight year and just the fourth time ever, the Pac-12 had five teams ranked in the preseason Associated Press poll, including three in the top 10 for the first time ever. It was the most of any league in the country in the top 10.

HISTORIC CAMPAIGN

Pac-12 women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful run, coming off a fifth-straight season with at least five NCAA Tournament bids. Since 2015-16, the Conference boasts the most NCAA Tournament wins (41) of any league and the best winning percentage among peer conferences (.695), posting double-digit NCAA Tournament victories in each of the last three seasons. The Pac-12 is the only conference to have at least two teams in the Elite Eight the last three years, placing at least four in the Sweet 16 during that time. Four Pac-12 teams appeared in the final Associated Press poll, the fourth- straight year the Conference had at least that many teams in the final ranking.

ALL-STAR RETURNS

Ten of the 15 All-Pac-12 honorees return this season, including national award winners at their respective positions Oregon's Sabrina lonescu (Nancy Lieberman Award winner) and Ruthy Hebard (Katrina McClain Award winner). Cal's Kristine Anigwe was a three-time All-Pac-12 honoree, with Colorado's Kennedy Leonard also earning a spot on the team the last two seasons. Also returning are UO's Maite Cazorla, Wasington State's Borislava Hristova, Utah's Megan Huff, Arizona State's Kianna Ibis, Washington's Amber Melgoza and Stanford's Alanna Smith.

In addition, three former national freshmen of the year dot the Pac-12 rosters. Anigwe and Ionescu both were honored with the award by the USBWA in 2016 and 2017, respectively. Redshirt sophomore Destiny Slocum was bestowed the honor by the WBCA in 2017 before transferring to Oregon State.

NEW FACES & FAMILIAR FACES

The Pac-12 welcomes a new face to the sidelines as Kamie Ethridge takes over the Washington State bench. Ethridge is one of the legendary figures in women's basketball, earning a place in the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame. Prior to arriving in Pullman, she spent four seasons at Northern Colorado, leading the team to the NCAA Tournament. The other 11 coaches return for the 2018-19 campaign.

The other 11 coaches return for 2018-19, including Hall of Fame head coach Tara VanDerveer who is in her 33rd season at Stanford and is serving her 40th season as a head coach over three stops. The second-most tenured head coach in the Pac-12 is Arizona State's Charli Turner Thorne who is in her 22nd season with the Sun Devils. She is a graduate of Stanford where she was a guard for VanDerveer for three years. The other Pac-12 head coaches have been at their respective institutions for single-digit seasons. Oregon State's Scott Rueck is one shy of the 10-year mark.

ROAD TO TAMPA

Teams across the country will be focused on getting to Tampa this season, the site of the 2019 NCAA Women's Final Four on April 5 and 7. To get to Tampe, Fla., teams will have to go through regional sites in Albany, N.Y., Chicago, Greensboro, N.C., and Portland, Ore., where the Oregon State Beavers are hosts Regional play takes place from March 29-April 1, with specific dates to be announced. The first and second round of the tournament will take place on 16 campus sites with the top-16 seeds hosting, March 22-25, 2019. The top 64 teams will learn their fates in the broadcast of the annual selection show on Monday, March 18, 2019.
