HALF THE PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TEAMS ARE STILL UNDEFEATED

As of Nov. 27, 36 of the nation's 330 women's basketball teams remain undefeated with six of those coming from the Pac-12. CALIFORNIA, OREGON, STANFORD, USC and UTAH each stand at 6-0 with COLORADO just behind opening the season with five wins ... Five Pac-12 teams are ranked again in the national polls with three still in the top 10: No. 3/3 OREGON, No. 8/7 STANFORD, No. 9/9 OREGON STATE, No. 15/18 CALIFORNIA and No. 19/23 ARIZONA STATE. USC is receiving votes in both the *Associated Press* and *USA Today*/WBCA Coaches polls ... Cal's Kristine Anigwe was voted Pac-12 Player of the Week for the second time. She leads the nation in double-doubles, recording double-digits in points and rebounds in every game this season. She is seven points from becoming the 20th player in league history to tally 2,000-career points ... ARIZONA's Cate Reese was tabbed the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week, the first-ever Wildcat to earn the honor. She is one of nine players in the country to be perfect from the free throw line so far this season, going 19-for-19 ... UA teammate and redshirt sophomore Aari McDonald is tied for the nation's lead for the highest scoring average (as of 11/27), tallying 26.6 points per game. USC redshirt freshman Shalexxus Aaron boasts the best three-point percentage in the country with a blistering 70.0 percent ... In his sixth season in Eugene, Kelly Graves is one shy of 100 win at Oregon ... A full lineup of Pac-12 women's basketball coverage is scheduled on Pac-12 Network on Saturday, Dec. 1 with four televised games and another matchup slated for Sunday, Dec. 2.

2019 PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT KEYARENA, LAS VEGAS, NEV. THURSDAY-SUNDAY, MARCH 7-10

After a record-setting six years in Seattle, the 18th-annual Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament presented by New York Life heads to Las Vegas for two years. The tournament will be held at the MGM Grand Garden Arena in 2018 from March 7-10, 2019 and will receive unprecendented television coverage once again as each game of the tournament is scheduled to be televised either on the Pac-12 Networks or ESPN2.

The tournament made its debut in 2002 and has been held annual since. The University of Oregon campus played host the first season. The Conference's premier women's sporting event then moved to HP Pavilion in San Jose for a six-year run (2003-08). It spent four years (2008-2012) in Los Angeles, with Galen Center playing host. The final two-year run of the event saw it combined with the men's tournament and the semifinal and championship games were played at the STAPLES Center. The tournament then moved to Seattle's KeyArena for six years where it saw record attendance numbers each year.

The winner of the 12-team tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeds and Conference Champion are determined by the 18-game regular-season Pac-12 schedule.

ANIGWE APPROACHES MILESTONES

California's Kristine Anigwe is just seven points from scoring 2,000 in her career. She is also 44 rebounds from her career 1,000th. Only 19 players in Pac-12/10 history have scored 2,000-career points and only 22 have grabbed 1,000 boards. The All-America candidate is also looking to become just the 11th player in league history to both score 2,000 points and grab 1,000 rebounds.

IONESCU OWNS TRIPLE-DOUBLE RECORDS

With her 12th triple-double on Nov. 18 against Buffalo, Oregon junior Sabrina lonescu tied the NCAA men's career record held by Kyle Collinsworth of BYU. She was already the NCAA's women's record holder heading into the season, wasting no time adding to her total by logging her first triple-double in the season opener at Alaska Fairbanks. NCAA STATISTICAL LEADERS

Four Pac-12 players are leading the nation in several statistical categories as of Nov. 27, including a pair of freshmen. Arizona's Cate Reese has been perfect from the free throw line through the team's first five games of the season, making her one of just nine players in the country with a 1.000 shooting percentage from the line. USC redshirt freshman Shalexxus Aaron is also displaying a hot shooting hand, knocking down a nation's-best 70.0 percent from three-point range.

Wildcat sophomore Aari McDonald's prolific scoring to-date in tied for the best in the nation as she averages 26.6 points per game. California senior Kristine Anigwe is the nation's double-doubles leader, posting double digit points and rebounds in all six games this season. Oregon junior Sabrina lonescu is the national leader in triple-doubles, logging two this season. She already owns the NCAA career record in the category.

In addition to being one of the six Pac-12 teams that remain undefeated (which accounts for six of 36 in the country), Oregon also boasts the country's best assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.86, and ranks in the top three of two other categories (field goal percentage and free throw percentage).

SISTER ACTS

With :38 seconds remaining in the first quarter vs. Saint Mary's on Nov. 11, Washington State's three Molina sisters - Chanelle, Celena, and Cherilyn - appeared on the court together for the first time. The three sisters played 1:21 together on the floor. They are the only trio of active sisters in the Power 5 conferences.

Other sister acts in the Pac-12 include the Moore duo, Minyon and Mariya. The Trojans' Desiree Caldwell older sister Recee is a member of the California Golden Bears and is pursuing a master's degree in public health. The Sabally sisters also wear the same colored jersey in Eugene. Older sister Satou was the Pac-12 Freshman of the Year last season but younger sister freshman Nyara will sit out this season because of an injury.

Also for the first time ever, the Pac-12 had three teams in the top 10 of the WBCA Coaches poll and four total teams ranked. For a week-by-week listing of team rankings, go to page 2.

HISTORIC CAMPAIGNS

Pac-12 women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful run, coming off a fifth-straight season with at least five NCAA Tournament bids. Since 2015-16, the Conference boasts the most NCAA Tournament wins (41) of any league and the best winning percentage among peer conferences (.695), posting double-digit NCAA Tournament victories in each of the last three seasons. The Pac-12 is the only conference to have at least two teams in the Elite Eight the last three years, placing at least four in the Sweet 16 during that time. Four Pac-12 teams appeared in the final Associated Press poll, the fourth- straight year the Conference had at least that many teams in the final ranking.

ALL-STAR RETURNS

Ten of the 15 All-Pac-12 honorees return this season, including national award winners at their respective positions Oregon's Sabrina Ionescu (Nancy Lieberman Award winner) and Ruthy Hebard (Katrina McClain Award winner). Cal's Kristine Anigwe was a three-time All-Pac-12 honoree, with Colorado's Kennedy Leonard also earning a spot on the team the last two seasons. Also returning are UO's Maite Cazorla, Wasington State's Borislava Hristova, Utah's Megan Huff, Arizona State's Kianna Ibis, Washington's Amber Melgoza and Stanford's Alanna Smith.

In addition, three former national freshmen of the year dot the Pac-12

rosters. Anigwe and Ionescu both were honored with the award by the USBWA in 2016 and 2017, respectively. Redshirt sophomore Destiny Slocum was bestowed the honor by the WBCA in 2017 before transferring to Oregon State.

NEW FACES & FAMILIAR FACES

The Pac-12 welcomes a new face to the sidelines as Kamie Ethridge takes over the Washington State bench. Ethridge is one of the legendary figures in women's basketball, earning a place in the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame. Prior to arriving in Pullman, she spent four seasons at Northern Colorado, leading the team to the NCAA Tournament. The other 11 coaches return for the 2018-19 campaign.

The other 11 coaches return for 2018-19, including Hall of Fame head coach Tara VanDerveer who is in her 33rd season at Stanford and is serving her 40th season as a head coach over three stops. The second-most tenured head coach in the Pac-12 is Arizona State's Charli Turner Thorne who is in her 22nd season with the Sun Devils. She is a graduate of Stanford where she was a guard for VanDerveer for three years. The other Pac-12 head coaches have been at their respective institutions for single-digit seasons. Oregon State's Scott Rueck is one shy of the 10-year mark.

ROAD TO TAMPA

Teams across the country will be focused on getting to Tampa this season, the site of the 2019 NCAA Women's Final Four on April 5 and 7. To get to Tampe, Fla., teams will have to go through regional sites in Albany, N.Y., Chicago, Greensboro, N.C., and Portland, Ore., where the Oregon State Beavers are hosts Regional play takes place from March 29-April 1, with specific dates to be announced. The first and second round of the tournament will take place
