PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSE

JJ Arcega-Whiteside, WR, STAN

In the 31-10 victory over San Diego State, Arcega-Whiteside's 226 receiving yards were the third-most in a game in Stanford history, and the most since 1999. He caught 3 TDs and a two-point conversion, and in all, finished with six receptions and 37.67 yards per catch. His TD catches went for 38, 19 and a career-long 80 yards. His first touchdown gave Stanford the lead just before halftime and his last touchdown came on 3rd-and-15 from the Stanford 20-yard line with the Cardinal leading by just six in the third quarter.

DEFENSE

Nate Landman, ILB, COLO

In Colorado's 45-13 win over Colorado State, Landman recorded 16 tackles (6 solo, 10 assisted), two tackles for loss and one interception, all in his first career start. Tied for second-most tackles by an FBS player in the opening week. The Buffs held Colorado State to 284 total yards, a week after the Rams put up 653 total yards of offense against Hawai'i.

SPECIAL TEAMS

Chase McGrath, PK, USC

McGrath tied the USC record for most field goals in a game when he kicked 5 field goals in USC's 43-21 win over UNLV. His three-pointers were 46, 38, 29, 47 and 36 yards, with no misses. He also hit all 3 of his PATs. He scored USC's first 12 points of the game. He tied a 14-year-old school record, first set in 2004 by Ryan Killen, who had 5 field goals versus UCLA. McGrath's last PAT, following a touchdown with 1:38 to play, was snapped by blind long snapper Jake Olson.

PAC-12 FOOTBALL NOTEBOOK

THE RANKINGS: Four Pac-12 teams are ranked in the AP poll, three in the Coaches poll. WASHINGTON (9/11), STANFORD (10/9), USC (17/12) and OREGON (23/nr) ... WASHINGTON has now appeared in the AP Top 25 for 34 consecutive ranking periods ... UTAH is the top team among others receiving votes in the AP poll, while Oregon is just outside the Top 25 in the Coaches poll.

GOOD HANDS TEAM: The Pac-12 had several key performances from wide receivers during the opening week of the season. STANFORD's **JJ Arcega-Whiteside** and COLORADO's **Laviska Shenault** were just two of three FBS receivers to record 200 or more receiving yards. Arcega-Whiteside turned in a career-high 226 yards on 6 receptions, with 3 TDs. Shenault had 11 receptions for 211 yards and one score. Four other Pac-12 receivers collected at least 100 receiving yards - ARIZONA STATE's **N'Keal Harry** (6 rec., 140 yds, 2 TDs), WASHINGTON's **Aaron Fuller** (7 rec., 135 yds), COLORADO's **K.D. Nixon** (6 rec., 112 yds, 1 TD), OREGON STATE's **Trevon Bradford** (6 rec., 104 yds, 2 TDs).

100-100: 12 FBS teams had a least one 100-yard rusher and one 100-yard receiver in the same game during the opening week. The Pac-12 led all conferences with three such occurrences. Those three were: Arizona State - **Eno Benjamin** (131 rushing yards) and **N'Keal Harry** (140 receiving yards)
Colorado - **Travon McMillan** (103 rushing yards) and **Laviska Shenault** (211 receiving yards)
Oregon State - **Artavis Pierce** (168 rushing yards) and **Trevon Bradford** (104 receiving yards)

EXTRA YARD FOR TEACHERS (#CFPEXtraYard): The College Football Playoff Extra Yard for Teachers Week is set for Sept. 15-22 where teachers and schools in the local community will be recognized during games on Sept. 15 and Sept. 22. However, with ARIZONA STATE on the road for both those dates, it will get a jump on the festivities this weekend by recognizing several Maricopa County elementary schools during Saturday's game with Michigan State.

PAC-12 HEADLINERS: Among 177 returning starters are a number of headliners, including a total of 10 first-team and 12 second-team All-Pac-12 performers. Nine of the 12 squads return at least six starters on offense, and seven squads return at least six starters on defense.

Returning are the reigning Offensive Player of the Year in Stanford senior running back **Bryce Love**, as well as the Freshman Co-Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year in Arizona running back **J.J. Taylor** and Stanford offensive lineman **Walker Little**, and Arizona linebacker **Colin Schooler**. Four teams have multiple returning First Team all-conference performers - USC linebacker **Cameron Smith**, defensive back **Marvell Tell** and all-purpose/special teams **Michael Pittman Jr.**; Stanford's Love and offensive lineman **Nate Herbig**; Washington offensive lineman **Kaleb McGary** and defensive back **Taylor Rapp**; Utah placekicker **Matt Gay** (Lou Groza Award winner) and punter **Mitch Wishnowsky**. Additional returning first team performers include Arizona State junior wide receiver **N'Keal Henry** and Oregon junior all-purpose/special teams **Brenden Schooler**.

THE COACHING RANKS: Five new coaches enter the league this season. It's the highest number of new coaches to grace the sidelines in one season for the Pac-12. Well, one is not so new as UCLA's **Chip Kelly** returns for his second stint in the Pac-12. Kelly posted a 46-7 record in four seasons at Oregon (2009-12) and led the Ducks to the 2010 BCS title game ... ARIZONA's **Kevin Sumlin** has averaged 8.7 wins over 10 seasons, including back-to-back 10-win seasons at Houston (2011) and Texas A&M (2012) ... ARIZONA STATE's **Herm Edwards** moves from his role as an ESPN analyst back to the sidelines where he last coached in the NFL for eight seasons (2001-08 - five with the Jets, three with the Chiefs) ... OREGON's **Mario Cristobal** moves from co-offensive coordinator to head coach. Cristobal has reached the pinnacle of college football with a pair of national titles as a player for Miami (1989, 1991) and one CFP title as an Alabama assistant coach (2015) ... OREGON STATE's **Jonathan Smith** returns to his alma mater for his head coaching debut. Like his Civil War counterpart, Smith achieved success as a player (MVP of the 2000 Fiesta Bowl/BCS) and as a Washington offensive coordinator (2016 Peach Bowl/CFP semifinal) ... Add the seven other league coaches who have a combined FBS record of 399-259 (.606) and Pac-12 football is in good hands.

TAKE IT ON THE RUN: Among the Power 5 conferences, the Pac-12 returns the most players (5) who rushed for 1,000 or more yards last season.

Bryce Love, Stanford - 2,118 yards (needs 1,145 to set Cardinal career rushing mark)

Khalil Tate, Arizona - 1,411 yards (3 200-yard rushing games last year are more than all other Pac-12 quarterbacks combined have tallied in the history of the league)

Myles Gaskin, Washington - 1,318 yards (has rushed for at least 1,300 in each of his first 3 season)

Zack Moss, Utah - 1,173 yards (Utes have had a 1,000-yard rusher in each of the last 4 seasons)

Patrick Laird, California - 1,127 yards (last Bear with back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons was Marshawn Lynch in 2005-06)

AIR IT OUT: Among the Power 5 conferences, no other conference has more returning quarterbacks that averaged better than 200 yards passing per game last season than the Pac-12 (5).

Ross Bowers, California - 253.2 yards per game

Manny Wilkins, Arizona State - 251.5 yards per game

Steven Montez, Colorado - 247.9 yards per game

Tyler Huntley, Utah - 241.1 yards per game

Jake Browning, Washington - 209.2 yards per game

BALANCE: CALIFORNIA, UTAH and WASHINGTON are three of only six Power 5 teams to return a quarterback/running back combination where the quarterback threw for at least 2,000 yards and the running back rushed for at least 1,000 yards (also Alabama, Florida State, Wisconsin).

AROUND THE PAC-12

ARIZONA (0-1) at Houston (1-0)
Sat., Sept. 8 • 11:00 am CT • ABC or ESPN2 • #AZvsUH

ARIZONA: LB **Colin Schooler** finished with a career-high 16 tackles vs. BYU (tied for second-most by an FBS player in the opening week), besting his previous mark of 14 at California last season. The 16 tackles were the most by an Arizona player since Scooby Wright III had 19 stops against UCLA on Nov. 1, 2014 ... Redshirt sophomore **Isaiah Hayes** set a career high with 13 tackles, surpassing previous career mark of nine. Hayes missed the 2017 season with an injury and played his first game Saturday since 2016 ... QB **Khalil Tate** was held to 14 yards rushing, his lowest total since his freshman season. He did add one rushing TD, giving him at least one rushing TD in eight of his last 10 games ... Coach **Kevin Sumlin** spent four seasons (2008-11) at Houston, compiling a 35-17 record, including a 12-1 record in 2011.

UCLA (0-1) at Oklahoma (1-0)
Sat., Sept. 8 • 12:00 noon CT • FOX • #UCLAvsOU

UCLA: Freshman RB **Kazmeir Allen** rushed for 103 yards, including a 74-yard TB in the third quarter. It was the third-longest run by a UCLA true freshman and the longest rush for a Bruin since Paul Perkins' 82-yarder against Colorado on Oct. 31, 2015. Allen is just the fourth Bruin to rush for at least 100 yards in a game since Nov. 14, 2015 ... Redshirt senior DB **Adarius Pickett** (15), sophomore LB **Jaelan Phillips** (9) and sophomore DB **Quentin Lake** (9) all had career highs in tackles vs. Cincinnati.

Portland State (0-1) at OREGON (1-0)
Sat., Sept. 8 • 11:00 am PT • P12N • #PSUvsOU

OREGON: With the 58-24 win over Bowling Green, the Ducks have now won 14 straight home openers at Autzen Stadium, and seventh straight scoring 50+ points ... QB **Justin Herbert** threw for 281 yards (nation-leading 28.1 yards per completion) and 5 TDs. He has surpassed 4,000 career passing yards, equaling the fastest to reach the plateau in terms of games (18- Marcus Mariota) and starts (16 - Joey Harrington) ... The Ducks have averaged 42.3 points per game in Herbert's 16 career starts ... DL **Jalen Jelks** led the team with nine tackles ... 10 true freshmen saw action for the Ducks on Saturday.

COLORADO (1-0) at Nebraska (0-0)
Sat., Sept. 8 • 2:30 pm CT • ABC • #COLOvsNEB

COLORADO: In the win over Colorado State, the Buffs produced a 300-yard passer, a 200-yard receiver and a 100-yard rusher in the same game for the first time in its history ... QB **Steven Montez** was 22-of-25 for 338 yards and 4 TDs, **Laviska Shenault** pulled in 11 receptions for 211 yards and one score, TB **Travon McMillan** rushed for 103 yards on 10 carries and 1 TD ... Shenault was the fourth player in CU history to record 200-yard receiving game ... A total of 34 players made their Buffalo debut in the season-opener, easily the most in CU history dating to when records are available.

North Dakota (1-0) at WASHINGTON (0-1)
Sat., Sept. 8 • 2:00 pm PT • P12N • #UNDvsUW

WASHINGTON: RB **Myles Gaskin** rushed for 75 yards in the loss to Auburn. He pushed his rushing total to a UW career record 4,135 yards, passing Napoleon Kaufman (4,106 yards from 1991-94) ... WR **Aaron Fuller** had career-best seven receptions for 135 yards. Over the last two games, Fuller has 13 receptions for 196 yards and one score ... With 296 passing yards vs. Auburn, QB **Jake Browning** now has 9,400 career passing yards. He needs 821 yards to pass Cody Pickett (10,220 yards, 1999-2003) as the UW career leader.

UTAH (1-0) at Northern Illinois (0-1)
Sat., Sept. 8 • 6:30 pm CT • ESPN • #UTAHvsNIU

UTAH: The Utes have won 11 straight season-openers ... Weber State was held to just 61 yards of total offense, the third lowest yard total the Utes have held an opponent in program history ... RB **Zack Moss** posted sixth career 100-yard rushing game with 150 yards on 16 carries ... QB **Tyler Huntley** completed 24 of 39 passes for 253 yards and 4 TDs. It was the third time he's thrown 4 TD passes in his career ... 12 different receivers caught at least one pass in the win over Weber State ... In his first game since 2015, WR **Britain Covey** was second on the team with 119 all-purpose yards (64 rushing, 53 receiving).

Southern Utah (0-1) at OREGON STATE (0-1)
Sat., Sept. 8 • 5:00 pm PT • P12N • #SOUvsOSU

OREGON STATE: The Beavers had a 100-yard rusher (**Artavis Pierce**, 168 rushing yards) and 100-yard receiver (**Trevon Bradford**, 104 receiving yards) in the loss at Ohio State ... Pierce had 168 yards on 11 carries, with 2 TDs (80- and 78-yard runs). His rushing total was the seventh-most by an FBS player in the opening week ... Sophomore QB **Conor Blount** came on in relief of starter **Jake Luton**, who was injured in the game's first offensive series for the Beavers. Blount responded by completing 12 of 19 pass attempts for 169 yards and 2 TDs. Entering the season, Blount had played in just four games, completing 19 of 35 passes for 183 yards.

USC (1-0) at STANFORD (1-0)
Sat., Sept. 8 • 5:30 pm PT • FOX • #USCvsSTAN

USC: Trojans and Cardinal have now opened Pac-12 play each of the last five seasons in either week 2 or 3. The teams split the previous four meetings ... Freshman QB **J.T. Daniels** was just the second true freshman to start USC's season opener (Matt Barkley, 2009). He completed 22-of-35 for 282 yards - most passing yards by a Trojan in his first outing ... Freshman WR **Amon-Ra St. Brown**, Daniels' high school teammate, pulled in seven receptions for 98 yards. No Trojan ever caught more passes in their frosh debut ... Sophomore PK **Chase McGrath** was perfect on five field goal attempts as he tied a USC record for most field goals made in a game.

STANFORD: With the 31-10 win over San Diego State, the Cardinal have now won 11 consecutive home openers ... Junior QB **K.J. Costello** completed 21 of 31 passes for a career-best 332 yards and 4 TDs in the win ... WR **JJ Arcega-Whiteside** had six receptions for a career-best 226 yards and 3 TDs. He has 6 TD receptions over the last two games ... P **Jake Bailey** averaged 48.80 yards per punt on five boots ... LB **Joey Alfieri** had eight tackles, 1.5 tackles for loss and 1.0 sacks in leading the Cardinal defense. Stanford recorded 5.0 sacks ... The night prior to the team departing for the Alamo Bowl last December, senior ILB **Ryan Beecher** was informed that tests revealed he had non-Hodgkins lymphoma under his right arm. He underwent six rounds of chemotherapy and missed two quarters of school and spring practice, uncertain if he would play again. In July, a full body scan came back negative. Beecher not only suited up for the season-opener, but he appeared on kickoff return and punt coverage units.

CALIFORNIA (1-0) at BYU (1-0)
Sat., Sept. 8 • 8:15 pm MT • ESPN2 or ESPN • #CALvsBYU

CALIFORNIA: RB **Patrick Laird** logged 95 rushing yards on 29 carries with one rushing TD. It was Laird's 10th career rushing TD after collecting eight in 2017 and one in 2015. Laird also hauled in his second career receiving TD, marking his first career game with both a rushing and a receiving TD ... The Bears came up with four interceptions, led by a pair by S **Jaylenn Hawkins**. The active Cal defense held North Carolina to 15 of 35 passing for 137 yards with seven pass breakups ... ILB **Evan Weaver** led Cal with a career-high 13 tackles (previous best was nine last year vs. Oregon State).

Michigan State (1-0) at ARIZONA STATE (1-0)
Sat., Sept. 8 • 7:45 pm PT • ESPN • #MSUvsASU

ARIZONA STATE: The Sun Devil defense came up big in the 49-7 win over UTSA, holding the Roadrunners to 2 yards rushing on 34 attempts. ASU recorded nine sacks against UTSA, the most since the Sun Devils sacked the UCLA Bruins the same amount of times on Nov. 23, 2013. ASU recorded 15 tackles for a loss, the most since the Sun Devils recorded that same amount against Washington State on Oct. 30, 2010. The Roadrunners lost 85 yards on those plays ... WR **N'Keal Harry** had six receptions for 140 yards and 2 TDs. He's collected at least one reception in all 26 games of his career ... QB **Manny Wilkins** was an efficient 16-of-24 for 237 yards and 4 TDs.

San Jose State (0-1) at WASHINGTON STATE (1-0)
Sat., Sept. 8 • 8:00 pm PT • P12N • #SJSUvsWSU

WASHINGTON STATE: QB **Gardner Minshew II** got the starting nod for the Cougars in their 41-19 win at Wyoming and delivered with 38 completions in 57 attempts for 319 yards and 3 TDs ... WSU won its first road season opener since 2004 at New Mexico, snapping a seven-game skid when opening the season on the road ... RB **James Williams** had a busy afternoon with 16 carries for 82 yards and 1 TD, while adding 10 catches for 53 yards and another score. It was his second straight 10 reception game and the fifth career game with 10+ receptions.

The Cardinal are one of eight teams to have appeared in the preseason AP poll in each of the last eight seasons, joining Alabama, Ohio State, Florida State, USC, Oklahoma, LSU and Georgia ... USC has appeared in each of the last 17 preseason AP polls and 58 preseason polls overall. Only Ohio State (65) and Oklahoma (60) have appeared in more preseason AP Top 25 polls.
