### THIS YEAR IN PAC-12 VOLLEYBALL

• STANFORD claimed its nation-leading eighth NCAA title and second in three years, giving the Pac-12 its 16th women's volleyball title all-time, the most for any conference. The Cardinal highlighted eight Pac-12 teams that earned NCAA Tournament bids this season, the most of any league, marking the 19th-consecutive year at least six teams have participated in the "Big Dance" and the fifth time in the last six years at least eight received postseason invitations.

• Six Pac-12 teams ended the season ranked in the final AVCA Coaches Poll with national champion and Pac-12 Champion Stanford claiming the top spot while OREGON is No. 9, the first time the Ducks are in the final top 10 since 2012 and just the fourth time ever. WASHINGTON STATE ends at No. 16, its highest final ranking since 2002 and just the third time it appears in the final ranking since that year. WASHINGTON is No. 18, USC is No. 21 and ARIZONA is tied for 25th.

• Stanford was the No. 1 overall seed, marking the first time since 2009 the top seeded team in the tournament won the national championship. USC was also seeded, earning the No. 11 seed, Oregon was the No. 15 seed and WSU was the No. 16 seed. It was the Cougs' highest seeding since 2002. Arizona, COLORADO, UTAH and WASHINGTON received NCAA Tournament bids.

• Seven of the eight Pac-12 teams were making a return trip to the tournament after earning bids last season. The Wildcats were back in after snapping a four-year run. Stanford is one of two teams in the nation to have participated in the event all 38 years. Four members of the Cardinal squad were also on the 2016 national championship team.

• In addition to the five-set national-championship thriller between Stanford and Nebraska, Conference teams were involved in some of the 2018 tournament's most exciting matches, including the Huskies upsetting Big East Champion and No. 9-seed Creighton on the road to get to the regional semifinal. The Ducks took down second-seeded Minnesota for the second time this season, winning an epic 41-39 second set, which led to a 3-1 victory in Minneapolis to claim a spot in the regional final.

• Stanford won its 18th all-time Pac-12 crown going a perfect 20-0. Junior **Kathryn Plummer** was tabbed the Pac-12 Player of the Year for the second-straight year. Teammates **Jenna Gray** and **Morgan Hentz** were repeated as the Pac-12 Setter and Libero of the Year, respectively. Stanford's **Kevin Hambly** was tabbed the Pac-12 Coach of the Year and USC's **Raquel Lázaro** was named the Pac-12 Freshman of the Year.

• Plummer was selected AVCA National Player of the Year for the second-straight year, becoming the first player since 2001 and 2002 to win the honor in back-to-back seasons and just the fourth overall. Plummer headlined a list of 13 AVCA All-Americans from the Pac-12, representing seven teams.

## PAC-12 IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

The Pac-12 has captured 16 out of 38 NCAA titles, including 14 of the last 28. Winning its second title in three years in 2018, Stanford is the national leader for volleyball national championships with eight. Four different Pac-12 teams have claimed NCAA titles and the Conference has had at least six tournament berths for 19-consecutive years. Pac-12 teams have compiled an impressive 472-251 (.653) record in NCAA play. Toss out the 23 postseason matches between Conference teams and the league's NCAA Tournament record against non-conference foes stands at 266-110 (.708) since 2001 with an overall mark of 402-188 (.681). Over the last 19 years, Pac-12 teams are 117-19 (.860) in the first round, including posting a NCAA-record 10-0 in 2014 after a NCAA-record 10 league teams earned bids that season. With eight bids in 2018, the Pac-12 has had at least that many teams go to the postseason in five of the last six years.

The Pac-12 has placed at least one Conference team in the regional semifinal every year of the tournament. Eighteen times in the history of the Conference it has had at least three teams advance to the regional final, and every year but four has there been at least one team advance to the national semifinal (exceptions are 1993, 1998, 2009, 2015). Subsequently, a Pac-12 team has made it to the championship game 28 times.

Every Pac-12 member has earned a NCAA Tournament berth since 2013 and seven different teams have reached the national semifinal all-time.

**ARIZONA IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT ...** Arizona made it back to the NCAA Tournament after missing out last season, breaking a streak of four-consecutive appearances. The Wildcats finished fifth in the Pac-12 after being picked ninth in the preseason. UA made its 29th all-time tournament appearance, falling to Missouri in the first round in Lincoln, Neb. The Wildcats are 30-29 all-time, reaching the NCAA semifinal in 2001.

**COLORADO IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT ...** The Buffs traveled to Minneapolis to face South Carolina in the first round, but fell in a hard-fought battle, 3-2. Colorado was in the tournament for the second-straight year and the 20th time all-time. Colorado owns a 13-20 record all-time in the tournament, making its fourth appearance since joining the Pac-12 in 2011 and second in head coach **Jesse Mahoney's** third season.

**OREGON IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT ...** No. 15-seeded Oregon ended the regular season matching its best-ever showing in Pac-12 play, tying for second. The Ducks last finished second in 2012. Oregon posted its ninth 20-win campaign in 12 years. Making their 16th all-time appearance (18-16) and eighth-straight, the Ducks played host to WAC Champion New Mexico State, winning the first-round matchup, 3-1, then took down Baylor in a two-point, five-set victory. For the second time this season, the Ducks upset second-seeded Minnesota in the regional semifinal, essentially knocking out the home team out of the national championship hunt. Oregon won an epic 41-39 second set, and went on to defeat the Golden Gophers, 3-1. But the Cinderella story ended with a 3-0 loss to Nebraska in the regional final.

**STANFORD IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT ...** Stanford became the first No. 1 seed since 2009 to win the NCAA Championship. The Cardinal went a perfect 20-0 in league play, posting just one loss all season, to earn the top seed. The Cardinal are the first undefeated Pac-12 Champion since 2003 and the ninth all-time. Stanford is one of just two teams to have earned a berth to all 38 NCAA Tournaments along with Penn State. Claiming the most NCAA titles all-time (8), the Cardinal are the winningest team in tournament history, becoming the first to 100 postseason wins (125-31, .801). Stanford defeated Nebraska in a thrilling five-set match to claim its eighth trophy. It also handily avenged its only loss of the season, defeating fourth-seeded BYU in the national semifinal, 3-0. The road to the championship began with wins over Alabama State and Loyola Marymount in the first two rounds by a score of 3-0 each, then taking down Washington State and knocking out Penn State in the regional tournament by identical 3-1 scores. Stanford (34-1) extended the nation's longest home winning streak to 36 after winning its first four tournament matches at home and has eclipsed the 30-win plateau for the 19th time in program history, pushing its season win streak to 32 matches, a school record. Stanford made its third-straight semifinal appearance and 22nd all time.

**USC IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT ...** Ending the season tied for second in the Pac-12 for the second-straight year, boasting a 13-7 league record and 21-10 overall. USC was the No. 11 seed overall in the tournament. The Trojans easily made it to the second round with a 3-0 win over SoCon Champion Samford, but hit a stumbling block in the second round, falling to San Diego, 3-0. The Trojans made their 36th all-time NCAA Tournament appearance, winning the title in 2002 and 2003. The 2003 squad was the last undefeated Pac-12 Champion, also going a perfect 35-0 that year.

**UTAH IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT ...** The Utes did not travel far for their NCAA Tournament appearance, going to Provo, Utah, and defeating Summit League Champion Denver, 3-0, in the first round. It was a rematch of a Aug. 25 clash which was decided in five sets, the Utes coming away with the win at that time. Utah made its 15th tournament appearance and boasts an all-time record of 15-15. It is the third-straight year and fifth time in six years Utah was in the tournament. Utah fell to fourth-seeded BYU, 3-0, in the second round.

**WASHINGTON IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT ...** Washington defeated Saint Mary's (3-1) before toppling Big East Champion and ninth-seeded Creighton, 3-0, to get to the regional semifinal for the sixth time in seven years. The Huskies made their 23rd appearance and 17th straight. Washington is 50-22 (.694) all-time in the tournament, advancing to the national semifinal four times and winning the crown in 2005. The Huskies fell to Penn State in the regional semifinal at Stanford, 3-0.

**WASHINGTON STATE IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT ...** No. 16 seed WASHINGTON STATE made its third-straight NCAA Tournament appearance, a feat it last achieved from 2000-2002. The Cougs' seeding was also its highest since garnering the No. 12 seed in 2002. The Cougs advanced to the regional semifinal for the first time since that year, also the only time they have been to the regional final. They defeated Northern Arizona (3-1) and Tennessee (3-1) to reach regionals at Stanford, falling to the Cardinal, 3-1. WSU finished the 2018 regular season in fourth with a 12-8 league record, the team's best showing since 2002. It was only the second 20-win campaign since 2003, also going over the 20-win mark for the second time in three years. Making its 13th all-time appearance, WSU is 13-13 all-time in the NCAA Tournament.

## CONFERENCE NOTES

• **STANFORD CLAIMS 18TH PAC-12 CROWN ...** Stanford dominated league play, claiming its second-straight and 18th all-time Pac-12 crown with two weeks left in the regular season. Under the direction of second-year head coach **Kevin Hambly**, became the first Pac-12/10 team since 2003 to go undefeated in league play and ninth all-time. Stanford has also posted undefeated league seasons in 1991, 1995 and 1997. UCLA (1988, 1989, 1990) and USC (2003) are the only other programs to accomplish the feat. Stanford also became the second team in Conference history to post 20 league victories. USC did it first, going 20-2 in 2011, the year the Pac-12 expanded to include Colorado and Utah.

• **HIGH HONORS FOR PAC-12 STUDENT-ATHLETES ...** 13 Pac-12 student-athletes earned AVCA All-America nods, including Stanford's **Kathryn Plummer**, who was tabbed the AVCA National Player of the year for the second-consecutive year, making her the fourth player in the history of the award to earn the honor in back-to-back seasons. She is the seventh Pac-12 player in nine years to win the honor and the 16th all-time. She is a first team All-American for the third-consecutive year.

Plummer and teammates **Morgan Hentz** and **Jenna Gray** were also named to the first team. The trio leads five Cardinal All-Americans. Seven different Pac-12 schools were represented on the AVCA All-American squad, either on the first, second or third teams, including Colorado, Oregon, Stanford, USC, Utah, Washington and Washington State. The Ducks were the only other league team to have multiple honorees with **Ronika Stone** (second team) and **August Raskie** (third team) earning spots.

• **AVCA POLL NOTES ...** The final poll has NCAA Champion and Pac-12 Champion Cardinal in the No. 1 spot of the AVCA Coaches Poll with six total teams ranked. It was ranked in the top two every week but one, including spending the first two weeks and final two polls at No. 1. OREGON is in the top 10 for just the fourth time ever, coming in at No. 9, while Washington State receives its highest ranking since 2002, coming in at No. 16. Washington is ranked No. 18, USC is No. 21 and Arizona finishes tied for 25th. Utah received votes.

At least seven teams were ranked in 13 weeks of the polling this season, including the preseason. Eleven different teams earned a top-25 ranking or received votes with a season-high nine appearing in the ranking on Sept. 24.

• **IN THE NATIONAL STATS ...** The Pac-12 killed it this season, literally. The Conference had four teams ranked in the top 35 in kills per set, with Stanford leading the league and ranking fourth in the nation with 14.80 kps. Oregon lands at sixth with 14.69 kills per set, USC is 26th at 13.94 and Arizona is 35th with 13.86. Individually, Arizona's **Kendra Dahlke** was one of the league's best offensive talents, ranking fifth in the country with 4.77 kills per set. Stanford's **Kathryn Plummer** also impressed, ranking 11th with 4.70 kps while USC's **Brooke Botkin** is 18th at 4.39. Fellow Trojan **Khalia Lanier** rounds out the top 25 with an average of 4.27 kills per set... So many of those kills were assisted by some of the best setters in the country, as three Pac-12 student-athletes rank in the top 25 in assists per set. Pac-12 Setter of the Year **Jenna Gray** set the standard in the league and ranks second in the country with 12.27 assists per set. Oregon's **August Raskie** is sixth (11.79 apts) and Pac-12 Freshman of the Year **Raquel Lázaro** landed at 21st (11.22). Lázaro is one of just two freshmen in the country in the top 20 in the statistical category, boasting the second-best average among the nation's freshman class... The Conference also boasts some of the best defensive talent in the nation with three teams ranked in the top 30 in blocks per set, including Stanford at the top of the list with 3.40 bps. Washington State ranks 26th (2.63 bps) and Colorado is 30th (2.62). Stanford's title-winning defense was led by **Tami Alade**, who ends the season with the best blocks per set average in the nation (1.87). Meanwhile, Colorado's **Naghede Abu** ranks 18th with 1.40 block per set, becoming CU's all-time leader in the category, finishing her career with 582 total blocks.

• **UPSETS MOUNT ...** There were a total of 38 upsets this season (based on the weekly AVCA poll) by Pac-12 teams, 26 coming in league matches. The most recent upset came in the regional semifinals when No. 14 Oregon upset No. 2 Minnesota for the second time this season, this time on the Gopher's home court. The Ducks previously defeated then-No. 1 Minnesota, 3-1, on Sept. 7. Washington led the league in upsets this season with six, three in non-conference play and three in Conference matchups. Washington State and Utah tied for second with five each, with all five of the Utes upsets coming in league matches while the Cougs had two upsets against non-conference opponents and three against league teams.

• **AROUND THE LEAGUE ...** Arizona's **Dave Rubio** joined an elite company after claiming his 500th victory while at Tucson on Sept. 14. In his 27th season at the Wildcat helm, he is only the second head coach in Pac-12 history to reach the milestone. Rubio led UA to double the win total from last season (11) and also more than doubled its Pac-12 win total (5). It posted three upset-wins this season, all coming in league play. Arizona is in the final AVCA poll for the first time since 2016 ... ARIZONA STATE broke a lengthy losing streak, picking up its first Pac-12 win since 2016 and the first under head coach **Sanja Tomasevic** on Sept. 23 over then-No. 12 Oregon. The win over the Ducks was the first over a ranked team since 2016 and was also the first sweep of UO since 2005. They posted three wins over ranked opponents this season, including ASU's first over UW since Nov. 21, 2012 and the first sweep of the Huskies since Sept. 22, 2000. The Sun Devils have surpassed their overall win total from all of last season ... California defeated four ranked opponents this season marking the first time the Bears have beaten four ranked teams since 2011. The Bears have more Pac-12 wins and total wins from last year (6 Pac-12, 14 overall) ... Colorado posted its fourth double-digit Pac-12 win season in five years ... Oregon recorded its second 20-win season in three years, surpassing its Pac-12 win total from a season ago. It's second-place finish in the Pac-12 ties for the program's best-ever showing, last time coming in 2012 ... Oregon State recorded its second-straight 10-win non-conference season going 10-2, including a win over then-No. 23 San Diego ... Stanford posted its second-straight 30-win campaign, which would be the program's first back-to-back since going three years with 30 victories from 2006-2008. The Cardinal have 19 30-win campaigns in program history ... All but one of UCLA's losses this season were to teams who have earned bids to the 2018 NCAA Tournament ... Utah posted double-digit league wins the last three seasons and was one shy of the 20-win mark ... Washington has reached the 20-win threshold every year since 2002. That streak includes three-straight 30-win campaigns from 2013-15 ... Washington State posted its second 20-win season in three years and just its second since 2002. Its 12 Pac-12 wins ties a program record set in 1997.

## ALL-PAC-12 HONORS

### PLAYER OF THE YEAR -- KATHRYN PLUMMER, JR, OH, STANFORD (Aliso Viejo, Calif.)

Kathryn Plummer was voted the Pac-12 Player of the Year for the second-consecutive year, becoming the sixth player in league history to win the honor in back-to-back seasons. She joins fellow Stanford Cardinals to have achieved the feat including Kerri Walsh (1998-99), Logan Tom (2001-02) and Foluke Akinradewo (2007-08). UCLA's Daiva Tomkus was the first to repeat as player of the year in 1998 and 1989, and Washington's Krista Vansant was the most recent back-to-back honoree (2013-14) before Plummer. Last year as a sophomore, Plummer became just the second player in Conference history and first in 27 years to be named the league's player of the year a season after being voted the league's freshman of the year. It is the 16th time a Cardinal has earned the Pac-12's top honor. An All-Pac-12 honoree for the third-straight year, Plummer has led the Cardinal to its 18th Pac-12 crown and second-straight. Stanford won the title going a perfect 20-0 in league play becoming the first team since 2003 to run the table in league play. Seventh in the nation in kills per set (4.78) and fourth in points per set (5.48), she has helped Stanford post the second-best kills average in the country at 14.95. Plummer was voted Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Week three times this season (Sept. 10, Sept. 17, Oct. 15). She eclipsed the 1,000-kill mark this season, tallying 1,426 to-date.

### FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR -- RAQUEL LÁZARO, S, USC (Córdoba, Spain)

Raquel Lázaro is the eighth Trojan to garner Pac-12 Freshman of the Year nods and the first since 2013. She is also the fourth Trojan to win the award since 2010. Other notable Trojan winners of the honor are April Ross (2000) and Samantha Bricio (2012). Lázaro ranks third in the Pac-12 in assists per set, averaging 11.20 aps. She is one of just two freshmen in the country to rank in the top 20 in the statistical category, boasting the second-best average among the nation's freshman class, also ranking 20th among all players. Lázaro was voted Pac-12 Freshman of the Week four times this season. With her directing the offense, she has helped USC to a tie for second place in the Pac-12 standings and the No. 11 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

### SETTER OF THE YEAR -- JENNA GRAY, JR, STANFORD (Shawnee, Kansas)

Junior Jenna Gray is the Pac-12 Setter of the Year for the second-straight year, marking the fifth time in the eight-year history of the award a Cardinal has won the award. She and former Cardinal Madi Bugg (2013-15) are the only two to have won the award multiple times. Gray has helped the Cardinal claim the Pac-12 crown for the 18th time in program history, the team going a perfect 20-0. She ranks second in the country in assists per set with 12.43 aps, helping the Cardinal post the third-best assists average in the country (14.09). With her directing the attack, the Stanford attack is second in the country in kills per set (14.95) and hitting percentage (.306). Gray has accumulated 3,799 career assists, ranking 18th among the NCAA's active leaders.

### LIBERO OF THE YEAR -- MORGAN HENTZ, JR, STANFORD (Lakeside Park, Ky.)

Junior Morgan Hentz is the third multiple-time recipient of the Pac-12 Libero of the Year award after winning the honor for the second-consecutive year. Only four players have won the honor in the eight years a libero of the year has been selected. With Hentz anchoring the defense, the Cardinal have the best opponent hitting percentage in the Pac-12, allowing other teams just a .165 hitting rate. She was named Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week five times this season. She is one of 35 players in league history to collect over 1,500 career digs (1,580 digs).

### COACH OF THE YEAR -- KEVIN HAMBLY, STANFORD

Kevin Hambly becomes the third-different Stanford head coach to win the Pac-12 Coach of the Year honor, which is voted on by his league peers. It marks the eighth time a Cardinal mentor garners the award after Don Shaw (1987, 1991, 1997-co) and John Dunning (2001, 2007-08, 2012) won the award multiple times. In his second season on the Stanford sideline, Hambly wins the coach of the year award after leading the Cardinal to a second-consecutive Pac-12 title, winning the 2018 crown in dominant fashion and going 20-0 in league play to become the first undefeated Pac-12 Champion in 15 years. It is also marks the second Pac-12 team that has posted 20 league victories and first since 2011. Stanford has lost just eight sets in league play this season, going to five sets just once. It has lost 13 sets in all of 2018, three of those coming in the team's only setback of the season back in August. Claiming the No. 1-overall seed in the NCAA Tournament, Stanford was ranked No. 1 in the country after the conclusion of the regular season, ranking in the top two in the country every week except one. The Cardinal have won 26-straight matches and 32-straight at Maples Pavilion, the longest current home win streak in the nation.

## HISTORICALLY SPEAKING

- The Pac-12 has captured eight of the last 17 NCAA crowns (Stanford - 2018, 2014, 2004, 2001; USC - 2002, 2003; UCLA - 2011; Washington - 2005) and 16 NCAA titles overall.
- Since 1990, Pac-12 players have garnered AVCA Player of the Year honors 16 times, including seven of the last nine years - CAL's Carli Lloyd (2010), USC's Alex Jupiter (2011), ORE's Alaina Bergsma (2012), WASH's Krista Vansant (2013), USC's Samantha Bricio (2015), and the most recent honoree, two-time winner STAN's Kathryn Plummer (2017, 2018). The NCAA Honda Sports Award honor has been bestowed upon a Pac-12 volleyball player 19 times, including six of the last seven years through 2017 (2018 honoree has not been announced).
- Pac-12 volleyball head coach have been named AVCA National Coach of the Year nine times, while Arizona's Dave Rubio was tabbed the ASICS Coach of the Year in 2001.
- The Pac-12 has had 10 or more All-Americans selections in 12 of the last 17 years, including 13 in 2018 with six schools represented. Eleven former Pac-12 players have earned All-America honors four times, while 20 players in all have earned All-American honors three times.

## STANFORD PICKED TO REPEAT AS PAC-12 VOLLEYBALL CHAMPS

**SAN FRANCISCO** - The 12 league women's volleyball coaches voted 2017 Pac-12 Champion STANFORD the preseason favorite to win the regular season in 2018, the Conference office announced on Wednesday. The Cardinal received all 11 possible votes for 121 points to come out first in the polling for the fifth time in six years. USC received the only other first-place vote and collected 100 points for second place, while OREGON is third with 96 points.

In addition to the annual coaches poll, the Pac-12 announced the Preseason All-Pac-12 team, as voted on by the league coaches. Nine of the 14 all-Conference honorees from a year ago appear on the 14-player preseason squad this year, including the 2017 AVCA National Player of the Year and Pac-12 Player of the Year Kathryn Plummer of Stanford.

The Cardinal are the overwhelming favorite as it prepares to welcome back five starters from last year's squad that advanced to the NCAA semifinal, including Plummer, Pac-12 Setter of the Year Jenna Gray and Morgan Hentz, who was tabbed the Pac-12 Libero of the Year. All three players were also key figures in the Cardinal's run to the NCAA title two years ago. Stanford was also voted the No. 1 in the nation in the AVCA preseason poll.

No. 10 in the preseason national coaches poll, USC returns All-American and leading scorer junior Khalia Lanier, who intends to lead a squad that is under the direction of first-year head coach Brent Crouch. The Ducks have three of their top five offensive performers and look to build on a NCAA Tournament second-round appearance from last season.

UCLA came in fourth in the polling with 90 points. The Bruins have a pair of seniors on the squad and finished tied for fifth in the Conference last year with COLORADO. The Buffs, who come in fifth in the coaches poll with 89 points, have AVCA All-Pacific South Freshman of the Year Brynna Deluzio back to lead the squad.

WASHINGTON is just two years removed from winning back-to-back Pac-12 titles and was voted to finish sixth by the league's coaches (73 points). It is the Huskies' lowest predicted finish since 2003. WASHINGTON STATE is seventh in poll, collecting 64 points, returning its primary blocking core that ranked sixth in the NCAA total blocks.

UTAH picked up 47 points to place eighth in the coaches polling. The Utes are coming off their best showing in the Pac-12 since joining the league, finishing fourth in the standings and advancing to the NCAA Tournament third round in 2017. Utah edged ARIZONA, which collected 46 points for ninth place. The Wildcats look to bounce back from a underperforming season last year, with the help of all starters returning. Coming off a historic season which saw the Beavs win a program-record tying 11 league matches, OREGON STATE followed with 27 points for 10th. ARIZONA STATE (24) and CALIFORNIA (15) round out the polling. The Sun Devils have five upperclassmen to help lead the team, while the Golden Bears have a new head coach on the sideline in Jennifer Dorr.

The AVCA National Preseason Coaches Poll was released last week and the Pac-12 led the nation with seven ranked teams. In addition to the Cardinal earning the top ranking in the country, USC was tabbed No. 10, followed by No. 11 UCLA, No. 15 Colorado, No. 17 Washington and No. 19 Utah. Oregon State and Washington State received votes.

## PAC-12 IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

The Pac-12 has won a NCAA-record 16 of 38 NCAA titles awarded with Stanford winning its NCAA-record eight crown in 2018. The Cardinal won in 2014 after UCLA claimed the trophy in 2011, while Washington was the national champion in 2005, Stanford in 2001 and 2004, and USC was the winner in 2002 and 2003 ... Pac-12 teams have compiled an impressive 472-251 (.653) record in NCAA play. Toss out the 23 postseason matches between Conference teams and the league's NCAA Tournament record against non-conference goes stands at 266-110 (.708) since 2001 and an overall mark of 402-188 (.681) ... Over the last 19 years, Pac-12 teams are 117-19 (.860) in the first round, including posting a NCAA-record 10-0 in 2014 after a NCAA record 10 league teams earned bids last year. It is the 19th-consecutive year the Conference has had at least six teams earn NCAA Tournament bids. Below is the current won-loss records of Pac-12 members in NCAA play:
