2002 PAC Coach of the Year: Jerry Tennant, Thiel College 2002 PAC Outstanding Wrestler: Wesley Koteski, Washington & Jefferson College, 184 lbs.

CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

The Thiel College Matcats captured their third consecutive PAC wrestling team title, and 10th team crown in the past 12 seasons, at the 2002 PAC Wrestling Championships, hosted by Waynesburg College in Waynesburg, Pa. Thiel captured six of the 10 individual weight classes en route to the victory. The Cats now have won 12 PAC wrestling team titles in the 44 years the PAC has crowned a wrestling team champion. First-year Thiel head coach **Jerry Tennant** was selected as PAC Coach of the Year.

Leading the individual champions was Washington & Jefferson senior **Wes Kotesk**i, who captured his fourth consecutive PAC title at 184 pounds. Koteski was honored as the Outstanding Wrestler at the tournament. Other repeat winners included 133-pound champion **Chris Brown** of Thiel, who won the 125-lb. title last year, and 141-pound champion **Jeff Linn** of Thiel, who won the 133-lb. crown in 1999.
