**SUMMARY:** The Grove City College men's tennis team captured its 12th consecutive PAC men's tennis team title this weekend in Grove City. Under the direction of head coach **Joe Walters**, the Wolverines captured three of the six singles titles and two of the three doubles titles to edge Washington & Jefferson, which was tied with Grove City following the first day of competition. The Presidents captured two singles titles and Waynesburg captured one, while Bethany captured the #1 doubles crown.

Grove City sophomore **Patrick Donahue (Lafayette, IN/Lafayette Jefferson H.S.)** earned his second consecutive PAC Player of the Year award after capturing the #1 singles title and teaming with freshman **Phil Springirth (Erie, PA/Harborcreek H.S.)** to win the #2 doubles bracket. Walters was named PAC Coach of the Year.
