#### THE PAC ALL-SPORTS TROPHIES ...

Washington and Jefferson swept both the Men's and Women's All-Sports Trophies in 1993-94 as 11 of its 18 varsity teams finished first or second. Grove City, whose women's teams had won the last five All-Sports Trophies, showed the most first-place finishes with six. The PAC Men's and Women's All-Sports Trophies are given annually to the institution totaling the most points after all varsity sports are completed at the end of the academic year. Schools are awarded five points for a first-place finish, four points for a second-place finish, and so on.
