

PRESIDENTS' ATHLETIC CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL

2001 ALL-CONFERENCE AWARDS

Junior forward Keith Schubert of Bethany was voted the league's Most Valuable Player award and Bison sixth-year head coach Rob Clune received the PAC's Coach of the Year award following the team's first conference championship and first post-season berth in 19 years. Schubert ranks as the league's third leading scorer (19.9 ppg) and 33rd among the top point-getters in Division III. He also ranks among the PAC leaders in field-goal shooting (43.1%), free-throw shooting (75.4%) and rebounding (6.4 rpg). Clune reversed last year's 1-7 conference record with a 7-1 mark that sealed Bethany's first PAC title since 1981-82. The team's 16-9 overall record marked the Bison's most wins in a season since 1977-78 and earned them a berth in the 2001 ECAC Southern Championship Tournament. Bethany junior sharpshooter Nevada Smith joined Schubert on the PAC First Team after leading the nation in three-pointers made per game (3.9) and ranking among the Top 10 in three-point shooting accuracy (49.2%). Waynesburg junior Rob Strcula, the PAC's second leading scorer (20.4 ppg) who ranks 32nd on the national scoring chart, netted a spot on the first team, as did Thiel junior Erik Hemsing, last year's MVP, and sophomore teammate A.H. Davis.

BETHANY GOES FROM WORST TO FIRST, CAPTURES FIRST PAC TITLE IN 19 YEARS

The Bethany Bison secured their first PAC men's basketball title since the 1981-82 season, holding off defending champion Thiel, 80-74, on Feb. 14. Keith Schubert and Todd McGuinness scored 17 points apiece as the Bison improved to 6-1 in the league after finishing last at 1-7 a year ago. Thiel, who dropped to 4-3 in the PAC, rallied from 22-8 and 67-55 deficits to lead 73-71 with 2:25 left to play. Schubert, however, sparked the Bison with five points in a 9-1 run in the final 1:48 to preserve the victory and the school's eighth PAC title all-time. Only Washington & Jefferson has won more PAC men's basketball championships with nine. Bethany, a PAC member since 1958, also claimed crowns in 1961-62, 1963-64, 1965-66, 1966-67, 1967-68, 1977-78 and most recently with an 11-3 record in 1981-82.
