# PAC

PAC Names All-Conference Basketball Team;  
Swartz, Juhola, Jones and Baab Garner Top Honors

PITTSBURGH--The Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) announced its 1986-87 all-conference basketball team at a meeting of league coaches. Rod Swartz of Hiram College and Andy Juhola of John Carroll University were named Co-Most-Valuable-Players, while Dany Jones of Washington & Jefferson College was selected the league's Freshman-of-the-Year, and Head Coach Tim Baab of the champion John Carroll Blue Streaks was chosen as the PAC Coach-of-the-Year.

Swartz, a four-time All-PAC selection and two-time MVP, was among the top five in the country with a scoring average of 29.4 points per game this season. The 6'0", 170-pound senior guard from Mogadore, Ohio, set conference records for most points in a game (51), most points in a season (370--PAC games only), and highest scoring average per PAC game (30.8 ppg) this year. As a sophomore he set the league mark with 11.5 field goals per game and 36 field goal attempts in a single game. Swartz ends his collegiate career as the PAC's all-time leading scorer with 2,252 career points which places him 16th in NCAA Division III history.

Juhola, a second-team pick last season and the league's Co-Freshman-of-the-Year in 1984-85, led the Blue Streaks to their second consecutive PAC title this year. Juhola, a 6'5", 187-pound junior forward from Ashtabula, Ohio was the league's second-leading scorer with 18.3 points per game. He also was the PAC's third-leading shooter converting 186 of 358 from the field for 52 percent. Juhola ranked eighth in the conference with a 6.0 rebounds per game average.

Jones, a 6'4", 165-pound forward from Oberlin, Ohio, averaged 15.0 points per contest to rank eighth in the conference. Washington & Jefferson's leading scorer also ranked fifth in the league with 7.5 rebounds per outing and was fifth in the PAC with 34 three-point field goals.

Baab guided the Blue Streaks through adversity this season as three starters, including last season's Freshman-of-the-Year, Craig Huffman, and Jim Berger, a second-team selection in 1985-86, missed the entire PAC schedule. In his six years at John Carroll Baab has coached the Blue Streaks to three PAC titles (1983, 1986, 1987).

Joining Swartz and Juhola on the All-PAC first team is Deron Ryan (15.4 ppg), a 6'1" junior guard for Grove City College, Pete Cwalina (14.3 ppg), a 6'6" senior forward for Carnegie Mellon University who led the PAC with 10.5 rebounds per game, and Andy Turzak (14.3 ppg), a 6'4" junior forward for Washington & Jefferson College.
