Washington & Jefferson Wins Back PAC Crown

Washington & Jefferson carded three of the top four scores and captured the 2001 PAC men's golf championship Friday at Oglebay's Speidel Golf Club in Wheeling, WV. The Presidents, who won five straight PAC crowns from 1994-1998, placed 14 strokes ahead of runner-up Grove City, who had won the last two titles. Grove City junior Nate Miklos won the individual championship, firing a two-day total of 155, two strokes better than W&J sophomore Mark Brandt (157). W&J senior Matt Henry (158) and sophomore Mark Hazen (160) finished third and fourth, respectively. Grove City junior Mike Solesha (162) rounded out the PAC First Team after defeating Thiel senior Bill Wadrose (162), the defending medalist, in a playoff.
