ALLEGHENY WINS PAC GOLF TITLE

HIRAM--Allegheny College won the Presidents' Athletic Conference golf championship this past weekend with a 36 hole total of 796 at Avalon Lakes Golf Course in Youngstown, O.

The Gators were paced by Greg Stone who finished with a 153. He was also named to the All-PAC team.

Completing the list of All-PAC golfers were Allegheny's John Jones and Jack McCauley, Carnegie-Mellon's Allen Meyerhoff and Thiel's Dan Phillips and Bob Hagman. Low medalist honors went to Phillips, who had a 36 hold total of 149.

Thiel placed second with a 815 total, while Washington and Jefferson and Carnegie-Mellon tied for third place with 822.

Rounding the standings were Case Western Reserve with 835 for fourth place, Hiram with 852 for fifth place and Bethany shot 862 for sixth place.
