Bethany Falls To OWU In NCAA Playoff

Bethany's 16th trip to the NCAA Division III Men's Soccer Championship Tournament ended in the first round Wednesday as Ohio Wesleyan defeated the PAC champion, 4-0, at Roy Rike Field on the OWU campus. The Battling Bishops (17-2-1), making their NCAA-record 23rd national playoff appearance, built on a 1-0 halftime lead with three goals in the final 20 minutes. The Bison (13-7-1), who fell in the first round last year to Johns Hopkins, were making their seventh NCAA playoff appearance in the 1990s.

Bethany Wins 20th Straight PAC Crown

Stuart Bracher scored four goals as the Bethany Bison claimed their 20th consecutive Presidents' Athletic Conference championship title with a 6-2 win over Grove City in Saturday's tournament final in Bethany, WV. The Bison jumped out to a 3-0 halftime lead on goals by Dan Irwin, Markus Overheu and Bracher. The Wolverines cut the deficit to one on a pair of goals by Steve Harley, but Bracher answered with three goals in a 10-minute span, giving him a league-high 19 goals on the season. Overheu added three assists for the Bison and Irwin and Richard Radomski each had one assist. Cory Nordman and Tom Salkeld had assists for Grove City. The Wolverines settled for their third straight second-place finish since splitting the title with Bethany in 1996.
