



ALL-PAC FIELD HOCKEY AND VOLLEYBALL TEAMS NAMED

WASHINGTON, Pa. -- For the second-consecutive season, Michele Crayton (Stow, Ohio) of Bethany College was named the Presidents' Athletic Conference most valuable player in field hockey. Crayton concluded the season with 14 points (eight goals and six assists) and led Bethany to a 6-0 conference record and an 11-4-1 overall mark. Last season she captured the conference's first MVP award, collecting nine goals and three assists in 17 games. Bethany's head coach, Judy Soderlund, was named coach of the year and has guided Bethany teams to a 12-0 conference mark and a 23-8-2 slate during the past two seasons.

The volleyball voting was much closer, as Thiel College's Diane Musick (Latrobe, Pa.) and Grove City College's Sue Shadle (Cooperstown, Pa.) tied for the most-valuable-player honors. Musick ranked first in the PAC in spiking aces (5.15/game) and was third in blocking (1.65/game). Also a first-team selection last year, Musick assisted the Lady Cats to a second-place conference finish with a 10-2 PAC record.

Shadle, also a member of last season's all-conference team, was sixth in spiking (2.76/game) and fourth in blocking (1.41/game). She was instrumental in leading Grove City (12-0 in the PAC and 36-5 overall) to its second-conference championship in as many seasons.
