

PRESIDENTS' ATHLETIC CONFERENCE WOMEN'S SOCCER

GROVE CITY NETS PAC CHAMPIONSHIP

Top-seeded Grove City cruised to the 2000 PAC women's soccer title over the weekend, shutting out defending champion Bethany in the semifinals and second-seeded Waynesburg in the championship game.

Freshman Meg Tilley (Columbia, MD/Hammond) had a hand in six of Grove City's nine tournament goals with three goals and three assists. Tilley netted two goals and an assist in the first half of Saturday's 4-0 championship victory. Tilley's goals were assisted by seniors Erica Snow (Erie, PA/Harbor Creek) and Nanmarie Woodford (Fairfax, VA/Bethlehem Baptist). Freshman Danielle Balliet (Pittsburgh, PA/Fox Chapel) scored what proved to be the game-winning goal, from Tilley, in the fourth minute. Woodford accounted for the fourth goal, unassisted in the 60th minute. Sophomore goalkeeper Katy Turman (Meadowbrook, PA/Abington) made three saves and was named to the All-PAC First Team. Tilley earned the tournament's offensive MVP award, while Lady Wolverine junior sweeper Kathy Keehlwetter (Mercer, PA/Mercer) was voted defensive MVP.

Grove City finished the season 10-0 against PAC opponents, outscoring them 48-5. The title marked the Lady Wolverines' fourth overall, having won three straight in 1995, '96 and '97.

Lady Wolverine season ends in ECAC opener

ANNVILLE, PA, November 1, 2000--The third-seeded Grove City College women's soccer team lost in the preliminary round of the 2000 ECAC Mid-Atlantic Championship Tournament on Wednesday as sixth-seeded and host Lebanon Valley College prevailed, 2-1, outside Harrisburg.

Lebanon Valley broke a scoreless tie in the 65th minute and added a second goal less than three minutes later. The Lady Wolverines cut the deficit in half in the 84th minute when senior Nanmarie Woodford (Fairfax, VA/Bethlehem Baptist) netted her eighth goal of the season, assisted by freshman Meg Tilley (Columbia, MD/Hammond).

Grove City sophomore goalkeeper Katy Turman (Meadowbrook, PA/Abington) made 12 saves as the Dutchmen outshot the Lady Wolverines, 16-6.

Grove City closed the year with an overall record of 14-6, marking the winningest season in its nine-year history. Lebanon Valley improved to 13-4-1 and advances to Saturday's semifinals at Johns Hopkins University in Baltimore, MD.
