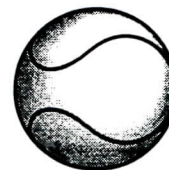

Grove City Wins Ninth Straight PAC Crown

Grove City claimed its ninth consecutive PAC women's tennis title last Friday at Bethany College, sweeping all six championship singles matches and all three doubles flights. Grove City senior **Jennifer Mulcahy (Beaver, PA/Beaver)** was named the league's Most Valuable Player for the third straight year, after rallying from one set down in the first singles match to beat Bethany freshman **Kelly Matthews (Atlantic Highlands, NJ/Middletown South)**, 2-6, 6-2, 6-4. Grove City head coach **Cathy Jacobs**, in her fourth season, was named PAC Coach of the Year.
