SUMMARY: The Grove City College women's tennis team captured an unprecedented 15th consecutive PAC women's tennis team title this weekend at Thiel College in Greenville, Pa. Under the direction of 10th-year head coach **Cathy Jacobs**, the Lady Wolverines did not lose a match in singles or doubles competition en route to the team title. Bethany placed second in five of the six singles draws and in all three doubles draws to finish second, followed by Washington & Jefferson, Waynesburg and host Thiel.

Grove City senior **Alyssa Bradford (Akron, OH/Cuyahoga Valley Christian H.S.)** earned her fourth consecutive PAC Player of the Year award after capturing the #1 singles title and teaming with sophomore **Allison Atwood (Warren, PA/Warren H.S.)** to win the #1 doubles bracket. Earning PAC Coach of the Year laurels was Washington & Jefferson head coach **John DeLaura**.
