Rosenbaum had a pair of goals, including the overtime game-winner, in Geneva's 3-2 victory over Carnegie Mellon on September 10. He opened the scoring in the 53rd minute, converting on assists from **Gib McCracken** and **Jeremy Troutman**, before recording the game winner in the 100th minute off of a **Robert Butler** assist.

Little has surrendered just two goals in his four starts for the Titans this season.


