# Swimming & Diving

### Grove City Defends Swim Titles

Grove City's men's and women's swimming diving teams repeated as PAC champions last Saturday, winning the conference meet by margins of 321 and 230 points, respectively. The three-day event was contested as part of the Grove City College Invitational Swimming & Diving Championships, February 19-21. The men, under first-year head coach Keith Bullion, cruised to their sixth consecutive PAC championship title by capturing gold in 17 of 20 events. Senior Luke Arnholt (Bartlesville, OK/Bartlesville) claimed MVP honors after winning two individual events and swimming on four championship relays. W&J head coach Mike Orstein was named PAC Men's Coach of the Year. The Lady Wolverines secured their third straight PAC crown with wins in 11 of 20 events. Junior Hope Vanden Berg (Beverly Hills, MI/Southfield Christian) led GCC with three individual gold-medal times, including two that set new PAC records. W&J senior Amy Seaman (Pittsburgh, PA/Woodland Hills) earned the women's MVP award with three first-place individual swims and one winning relay. Grove City's 10th-year head coach Cathy Jacobs was named PAC Coach of the Year for the third straight season. What follows are the top three finishes in each event, representing the All-PAC first, second, and third teams. New records and times which provisionally qualified for the NCAA Division III Swimming & Diving Championships are noted.
