**IRVINE, Calif.** -- Azusa Pacific moved into second place in the PacWest standings with its third and fourth consecutive wins at home against Fresno Pacific and Academy of Art over the weekend.

The Cougars have rebounded from a 1-7-1 start to the season by winning four matches in a row, allowing just one goal during the stretch.

Point Loma extended its lead in first place in the PacWest standings by six points, winning its first two matches in Hawai'i. The Sea Lions earned shutout victories over Hawai'i Pacific and Chaminade to improve to 7-0-1 in conference play.

In the first NCAA West Regional rankings, Point Loma was ranked No. 6 with the next rankings coming out on Wednesday. The PacWest champion will earn an automatic bid into the NCAA West Regional and the regional rankings determine how the teams are seeded.

This week, Point Loma will conclude its trip to Hawai'i against Hawai'i Hilo at 7:30 p.m. on Monday. The Sea Lions are going into the contest with a 13-match unbeaten streak.

Azusa Pacific will be on the road this week, taking on Concordia on Wednesday. Then on Saturday, the Cougars will play against Biola at 7 p.m. in the Cornerstone Cup. Concordia has three home matches this week, including contests against Academy of Art and Notre Dame de Namur. Chaminade and Hawai'i Pacific will begin their trips to Northern California.

#### PLAYER OF THE WEEK



**Emmy Koflanovich, Azusa Pacific F, Jr., 5-2 -- Mount Hermon, Calif.**

Koflanovich helped Azusa Pacific extend its winning streak to four matches as the Cougars moved up to second place in the PacWest standings. The junior played 59 minutes in both of the Cougars' wins and took two shots in each game. In the win against Academy of Art, Koflanovich played a part in all three of Azusa Pacific's goals. She scored her second goal of the season as an insurance goal after assisting the first two goals in the 3-1 win. Koflanovich now has two goals and three assists on the season.

#### DEFENDER OF THE WEEK



**Emma Hinson, Point Loma GK, Fr., 5-10 -- Portland, Ore.**

Hinson extended her shutout streak to four games as Point Loma won its first two games in its trip to Hawai'i. Hinson has recorded 11 shutouts this year and has a goals-against average of 0.21, which currently ranks second on the PacWest's all-time single season list. Hinson recorded five saves in the win against Hawai'i Pacific. Against Chaminade, the freshman didn't face any shots on goal and helped limit the Silverswords to only three shots. Her save percentage rose to 92.3 on the season.

#### FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK



**Christine Messner, Azusa Pacific D, Fr., 5-6 -- San Pedro, Calif.**

Messner helped the Azusa Pacific defense to hold opponents to just one goal in two games as the Cougars' extended their winning streak to four games. On Thursday, Messner scored the game-winning goal in the Cougars' 2-0 win against Fresno Pacific. Messner has scored two goals this year and helped the Cougar defense hold opponents to just one goal during the four-match winning streak. Azusa Pacific allowed only six shots on goal during the week.
