IRVINE, Calif. -- Azusa Pacific remained undefeated in PacWest play on the season with a pair of one-goal victories, including a triumph against Fresno Pacific in a battle between regionally-ranked teams.

Azusa Pacific was ranked No. 2 in the West Region in the first regional rankings published by the NCAA, and the Cougars defeated No. 5 Fresno Pacific as both teams battle for a spot in the NCAA West Regional. The tournament will feature the top six teams in the West Region based on the NCAA rankings.


Fresno Pacific bounced back from the loss with a 2-1 win over Biola on Saturday to complete the first half of PacWest play. **Anthony Velarde** scored a goal and assisted the game-winner in the 2-1 win against Biola.

Point Loma began its trip in Hawai'i with a win against Hawai'i Pacific followed by a tie against Chaminade to move up to second place in the PacWest standings with a 5-2-1 conference record.

This week, Azusa Pacific will go for its 10th straight win on Wednesday with a road match against Concordia. Then the Cougars will face Biola on Saturday in an evening match in La Mirada.


Chaminade and Hawai'i Pacific will travel to Northern California this week. The Silverswords will face Fresno Pacific and Holy Names, while the Sharks visit Holy Names and Academy of Art. Fresno Pacific will travel to Dominican on Saturday as the Sunbirds look to return to second place in the conference.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK



Tim Siegfried, Point Loma M, So., 5-11 -- Osterburken, Germany
Siegfried scored two goals and added an assist last week as Point Loma earned a win and a tie to move into second place in the PacWest standings. The sophomore scored a goal in each game to extend his goal streak to four matches. In the Sea Lions' 3-2 win against Hawai'i Pacific, Siegfried recorded a goal and an assist. He scored the game-tying goal in the 70th minute and then assisted the game-winner in the 86th minute of the Sea Lions' fifth conference win. In the next match, Siegfried scored the equalizer in the 79th minute to help Point Loma earn a tie against Chaminade.

Kris Jensson, Academy of Art GK, So., 6-0 -- Reykjavik, Iceland
Jensson earned his second shutout of the season and helped hold opponents to just one goal in two games. The Urban Knights earned their second win of the season, beating Holy Names 4-0 as Jensen faced 14 shots and made six saves. In the next game, Jensson faced a season-high 29 shots and made seven saves to hold Azusa Pacific to just one goal. Jensson raised his save percentage on the season to 69.9 with a 1.92 goals against average.

Costa recorded a goal and an assist for Azusa Pacific last week as the Cougars extended their winning streak to nine games. Costa has recorded a point in all nine games.
