**IRVINE, Calif.** -- Academy of Art and Point Loma both won a pair of matches last week to improve to 2-1 on the season, beating regional opponents to become the first two PacWest teams with multiple wins in the 2018 season.

Academy of Art had a successful trip to the Pacific Northwest, defeating two GNAC teams. **Alice Michell** had two goals and an assist to defeat Saint Martin's and Western Oregon. The Urban Knights have already surpassed their win totals of the past two seasons.

Point Loma only needed one goal in each match to defeat Cal Poly Pomona and Cal State San Marcos. **Julia Glaser** provided the game-winning goals in each triumph, while **Emma Hinson** was rewarded with both shutouts to help the Sea Lions improve to 2-1.

Hawai`i Pacific earned a tie on Tuesday against the No. 2 team in the nation, UC San Diego. The Sharks got a goal in the 82nd minute off a header by **Tehani Furuta** as she was the first to get to a rebound from a free kick. **Marissa Froio** did the rest for the Sharks in her collegiate debut, making 11 saves in the match to preserve the tie.

This week is the last full week of non-conference play. On Saturday, Biola will have a key regional contest, taking on Seattle Pacific at home. Meanwhile, Notre Dame de Namur will be on the road to play against Cal Poly Pomona as **Samantha Sanchez** tries to break the PacWest assists record that she tied last week.

### **PLAYER OF THE WEEK**



Alice Michell, Academy of Art F, Sr., 5-4 -- Saint Paul, Minn.

Michell played a part in three of the Urban Knights' four goals last week as they recorded wins over Saint Martin's and Western Oregon in the Pacific Northwest. Michell scored an insur-

ance goal in Academy of Art's 2-0 win over Saint Martin's to put her team in the win column for the first time this year. Two days later, Michell scored the game-tying goal in the 59th minute against Western Oregon. She was also credited with an assist on the game-winning goal in the 78th minute. It is the first time that Academy of Art has won consecutive matches since 2015.

Hinson earned her first two wins in goal of her collegiate career with a pair of 1-0 shutouts for Point Loma against CCAA opponents. Hinson earned her first career shutout as the

Sea Lions got their first win of the year, beating Cal Poly Pomona. Hinson had two saves in the match. Against Cal State San Marcos, Hinson had two more saves to record a second-consecutive shutout. She brought her goals against average on the season down to 0.63 with eight saves through three matches.

### FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK



Marissa Froio, Hawai`i Pacific GK, Fr., 5-4 -- Simi Valley, Calif.

Froio helped Hawai`i Pacific earn a tie against No. 2 UC San Diego in her collegiate debut. The freshman faced 27 shots by the Tritons, but didn't allow a single goal in overtime as she pre-

served a 1-1 tie. In 110 minutes, Froio recorded 11 saves to get a tie against the defending West Region champions. Against Eckerd, Froio registered another eight saves and has a save percentage of 86.4 so far this year.
