Chaminade Wins Hawai'i Invite, Beats No. 7 UCSD

IRVINE, Calif. -- Fresno Pacific and Academy of Art each pulled off big upsets against Chaminade last week, while Azusa Pacific defeated Concordia on Saturday, leaving only Point Loma with an undefeated record in PacWest play.

On New Year's Eve, Fresno Pacific became the first team this season to defeat No. 12 Chaminade with a 74-72 victory. **Adrian Antunez** found **Aamondae Coleman** open for a triple with a minute left in the game for a five-point lead that the Sunbirds never let go of.

Two days later, Chaminade suffered another narrow loss as Academy of Art was the next team to upset the Silverswords. **Andija Blatancic** scored 24 points with 11 rebounds and two blocks on 9-of-13 shooting to lead the Urban Knights to victory.

That left only Concordia and Point Loma with undefeated records in PacWest play going into 2019. Then on Saturday, Azusa Pacific handed Concordia its first loss. The Cougars had a 70.8 field-goal percentage in the second half, scoring 52 points to run away with an 85-68 win.

Point Loma dodged the upset bug that was traveling through the conference with narrow wins against Holy Names and Biola to remain undefeated. In the latest D2SIDA regional rankings, Point Loma was selected as the No. 1 team in the West Region.

Point Loma will visit Azusa Pacific tonight in the second meeting between the two teams as the Sea Loins look to remain undefeated in conference play.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK



Andrija Blatancic, Academy of Art F, Jr., 6-7 -- Bergen, Norway

Blatancic played full minutes for the first time since arriving at Academy of Art, and it didn't take long for the junior transfer to make an impact. He scored 24 points on 9 of 13 shooting

to lead Academy of Art to a 71-69 upset of No. 12 Chaminade. In three games, he more than doubled his minutes on the season and scored 81 points on 31-of-45 shooting. Against Hawai`i Hilo, Blatancic scored a team-high 31 points with a 73.3 field-goal percentage. Academy of Art finished the week with two wins to improve to 3-4 in conference play.

DEFENDER OF THE WEEK



Selom Mawugbe, Azusa Pacific F, Jr., 6-10 -- Canyon Country, Calif.

Mawugbe earned his second-consecutive PacWest Defender of the Week honor as he continues to climb the alltime block leaders list in the PacWest. The junior ranks second with 173 ca-

reer blocks, which is 25 away from the all-time record. He is also 36 blocks away from the single-season record after recording six blocks against Concordia as Azusa Pacific became the first team to hand Concordia a loss in the PacWest this season. Mawugbe helped Azusa Pacific hold Concordia to a 35.3 field-goal percentage.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK



Jalen Thompson, Hawai`i Hilo G, Fr., 6-3 -- West Linn, Ore.

Thompson scored 25 points during the three games of Hawai'i Hilo's trip to northern California, where the Vulcans won all three games. In just one week, the Vulcans equaled their pro-

gram best for road wins in an entire season since the 2008-09 season. Thompson made four shots from beyond the arc on the week and has made 16 of 44 three-point attempts so far this season.
