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Azusa Pacific Takes Over First Place In PacWest

IRVINE, Calif. -- With two weeks left in the regular season, Azusa Pacific has its nose in front in the race for the PacWest regular-season title with a 15-2 record, while all three Hawai'i schools have a 13-3 record in PacWest play.

On Wednesday, Hawai'i Pacific got a three-set win over Chaminade to help create what is now a three-way tie for second place in the standings. **Perla Escobar** had 15 kills in the match to lift the Sharks to the crucial victory.

Azusa Pacific won three matches in a busy week that started with a trip to Fresno, where the Cougars won in three sets. They then held off Academy of Art at home for another straight-set victory before going to Biola for a rivalry match on Saturday night. Azusa Pacific made it three wins in one week with a four-set win against Biola, coming back after losing the first set against the Eagles for the second time this season.

The penultimate week of the regular season contains several of the biggest matches of the season over the span of six days as Chaminade, Hawai'i Pacific and Hawai'i Hilo make their trip to Southern California.

On Monday, Azusa Pacific and Chaminade will meet for a second time. The Cougars won the first meeting when Chaminade was still at the top of the PacWest standings. Hawai'i Hilo and Hawai'i Pacific will also have tough opening matches against Biola and Point Loma, respectively. Hawai'i Hilo and Azusa Pacific will play a rematch of their five-setter on the Big Island on Thursday, and then Hawai'i Pacific will get its turn against APU on Saturday.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK



Julianne Miller, Azusa Pacific MB, Sr., 6-1 -- Rocklin, Calif.

Miller led Azusa Pacific to three wins last week as the Cougars moved into first place in the PacWest standings. She had 27 kills with only two errors on 50 attacks on the week. She tallied eight kills with no errors on 11 attacks against Fresno Pacific for her best single-match hitting percentage this season. Miller also had six blocks on the week with two in each match. The senior has a total of 244 kills this season and a .387 hitting percentage as she has led Azusa Pacific to a 15-2 record in conference play following the wins over Fresno Pacific, Academy of Art and Biola.

DEFENDER OF THE WEEK



Sami Hover, Biola L, Jr., 5-5 -- Glendale, Ariz.

Hover tallied 50 digs last week, which was the most in the PacWest for the week while only playing seven sets. The junior had 20 digs in Biola's three-set win against Fresno Pacific and then had 30 digs in four sets against Azusa Pacific. Hover had zero receiving errors for the week. She now has 484 digs this season with an average of 5.32 digs per set. Hover also had seven assists for Biola in the two matches, pushing her total for the season up to 97 as Biola improved to 13-11 this year.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK



Annaka Jorgenson, Azusa Pacific OH, Fr., 6-1 -- Eastvale, Calif.

Jorgenson has recorded double-digit kills in seven-consecutive matches and had 40 kills last week as she helped Azusa Pacific win all three matches. The freshman recorded 18 kills in Azusa Pacific's four-set win against Biola with a .280 hitting percentage. She also had 10 digs in the match for a double-double. Jorgenson had a total of 32 digs, four assists, two blocks and two aces on the week.
