IRVINE, Calif. -- No. 5 Azusa Pacific defeated the defending NCAA West Region champion Cal Poly Pomona 4-3 in overtime before beating West Region No. 7 Point Loma on Saturday to improve to 4-0 on the season.

The Cougars defended their No. 1 ranking in the West Region in the United Soccer Coaches Poll by winning both of their games last week with a total of seven goals scored in the two games.

Chaminade also won both of its games last week, starting the season with a trip to Colorado. **Colin Roemer** recorded a hat trick in the Silverswords' 3-0 win over Colorado Christian and then Chaminade defeated Metro State to start the season 2-0-0.

Concordia got its first win of the season with an impressive come-from-behind victory. The Eagles scored four unanswered goals in the second half against Cal State San Marcos to win the match 5-2. **Bryan Lopez** scored the final two goals.

This week, Point Loma will travel to UC San Diego in a battle between regionally-ranked teams on Thursday. The Sea Lions will also travel to Cal State San Marcos on Saturday as they look to build on their 2-1 start to the season.

Concordia will take on preseason No. 2 Cal Poly Pomona on Thursday before facing Azusa Pacific on Saturday in a non-conference meeting. Fresno Pacific will play at home against Sonoma State this week before playing a road contest against Chico State.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK



Colin Roemer, Chaminade F, Jr., 5-7 -- Cologne, Germany

In his debut in a Silverswords uniform, Roemer recorded a hat trick and helped Chaminade win both of its matches in Colorado. The junior scored all three goals in the Silverswords 3-0 victory against Colorado Christian. Two days later, he needed only seven minutes of play to score his fourth goal of the season as the Silverswords won 3-2 against Metro State. Roemer is the national leader in goals per game and ranks second in the nation in points per game. Chaminade is now one of three undefeated PacWest teams at the top of the conference standings.

DEFENDER OF THE WEEK



Orlando Lozano, Azusa Pacific D, Jr., 6-1 -- Cali, Colombia

Lozano helped Azusa Pacific improve to 4-0 on the season with wins over Cal Poly Pomona and Point Loma. The junior played 92 minutes against Cal Poly Pomona, which was ranked No. 2 in the nation in the preseason poll. He scored a goal on his first shot attempt as a Cougar and helped the Cougars' defense not allow any goals in overtime. Against Point Loma, Lozano held the Sea Lions to just one goal in the game as the Cougars became the first to four wins.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK



Dylan Memory, Biola M, Fr., 6-0 -- Redlands, Calif.

Memory scored the game-winning goal in Biola's first win of the season as the Eagles defeated Cal State San Marcos, 2-0. In the final minutes of the first half, Memory got the ball in space and shot to the left post for the goal. The Eagles went on to win the match 2-0. He also earned his second career start later in the week.
