Patriot League Champion Holy Cross (9-2, 6-0 PL) will host NEC Champion Sacred Heart (8-3, 6-1 NEC) at Fitton Field when first-round play in the 2021 NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) Championship begins on Saturday, Nov. 27. Coverage of the Crusaders and Pioneers will begin at noon on ESPN+.

DEMORAT, DOBBS, CONWAY AND CHESNEY NAMED FINALISTS FOR STATS PERFORM FCS AWARDS

Fordham senior quarterback Tim DeMorat and Holy Cross junior linebacker Jacob Dobbs were selected Patriot League Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year. Both were named finalists for national FCS honors this week. DeMorat is one of 16 finalists for the Stats Perform Walter Payton Award, presented to the top offensive player in the FCS. Dobbs is a finalist for the Buck Buchanan Award, given to the FCS defensive player of the year. Fordham freshman linebacker James Conway is among the finalists for the Jerry Rice Award for FCS rookie of the year, while Holy Cross Head Coach Bob Chesney is up for the Eddie Robinson Award for FCS coach of the year for the second time.

HOLY CROSS CLINCHES THIRD STRAIGHT PATRIOT LEAGUE TITLE AND FCS PLAYOFFS BERTH

Holy Cross clinched the Patriot League title and a berth into the NCAA DI FCS Playoffs for the third-consecutive season. Holy Cross is the first Patriot League team to earn three straight League titles since Lafayette, who accomplished the feat from 2004-06. The Crusaders won three straight League titles between 1989 and 1991.

FORDHAM'S NICK ZAKELJ INVITED TO THE 2022 REESE'S SENIOR BOWL

Fordham 5th-year offensive lineman Nick Zakelj has been invited to compete in the 2022 Reese's Senior Bowl. The team captain and four-time All-Patriot League selection has started at left tackle for a Rams' offense that has been among the most productive in the FCS this season.

RAMS' KOKOSIOULIS AMONG FCS TD RECEPTIONS LEADERS

Fordham Sr. WR Fotis Kokosioulis caught one touchdown pass in the Rams' loss vs. Colgate (11.20) and has reached the end zone nine times in the last six games. He is tied for second in the FCS with 13 touchdown catches in Fordham's 11 games this season, tying for the seventh-best single-season total in League history. Junior teammate Dequee Carter is tied for seven in the FCS with 11 touchdown receptions. Former Lehigh standout and current Bucknell Head Coach Dave Cecchini holds the Patriot League's single-season touchdown record with 15.

COLGATE'S GRUBER TIES KICKOFF RETURN RECORDS

Colgate Sr. DB/RS Will Gruber returned kickoffs for touchdowns in consecutive weeks, tying the Patriot League single-season and career kickoff return for touchdowns record with two. The back-to-back Patriot League GEICO Special Teams Player of the Week first struck with a 100-yard return for a score at Cornell on Oct. 15. Against Holy Cross on Oct. 23, he scored on a 99-yard return. Gruber joins 10 Patriot League football student-athletes in a tie for the career record. He has returned two kickoffs for touchdowns in a single season, joining Bucknell's Dante Ross (2004) and Lafayette's Matt Smalley. He tied for the FCS lead with two kickoff returns for touchdowns this season.

THREE PATRIOT LEAGUERS AMONG FCS TACKLES LEADERS

Three Patriot League defensive players rank among the FCS top-10 leaders in tackles, led by Fordham freshman linebacker James Conway, who posted a career-high 22 tackles vs. Lehigh (Oct. 23). Lafayette junior linebacker Marco Olivas is sixth in the FCS in tackles per game. He recorded a season-high 16 tackles in the Leopards win vs. Bucknell (10.9). Holy Cross junior linebacker Jacob Dobbs has recorded double-digit tackles in five games and is tied for 10th in the nation.

RAMS' CONWAY NAMED TO JERRY RICE AWARD WATCH LIST

Fordham freshman linebacker James Conway was selected to the Stats Perform Jerry Rice Award Watch List. Now in its 11th season, the Rice Award is presented to the national freshman of the year in the FCS. Conway has earned GEICO Patriot League Defensive Player of the Week and is a three-time League rookie of the week this season. He is among the League and FCS leaders in tackles per game (11.9) and forced fumbles per game (0.36).

DEMORAT AMONG FCS TOUCHDOWN PASS LEADERS

Fordham senior quarterback Tim DeMorat threw for 350 yards and two TDs against Colgate on Nov. 20. Earlier this season, he tied the Rams' single-game record with six touchdown passes against Bucknell. He moved to eighth in League history in passing yards (8,570) and is ninth in the FCS this season in passing yards per game (292.2). He has also had a knack for throwing touchdown passes, ranking seventh in the nation with 31, tied for the seventh-best single-season mark in League history. DeMorat is responsible for 19.2 points per game, the eighth-best mark in the FCS.

DEMORAT CLIMBING LEAGUE CAREER LEADERS LISTS

DeMorat moved to eighth on the Patriot League's career passing yards list with 8,570 yards during his time in the Bronx. The Merritt Island, Fla. native, earned Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year for the second time, leading the League and placing among the FCS leaders in passing yards per game (292.2) and touchdown passes (31). He has topped 300 yards passing six times this season, including five times in the last seven games. The senior signal-caller has three or more touchdown passes in six games, including a program-record six in the Rams' win over Bucknell on Oct. 16.

HOLY CROSS'S DOBBS ADDED TO BUCHANAN AWARD LIST

Holy Cross Jr. LB Jacob Dobbs was added to the Stats Perform Buck Buchanan Award Watch List for the FCS Defensive Player of the Year when it was announced on Nov. 10. Dobbs is among the Patriot League and FCS leaders in tackles per game (10.4), tackles for loss per game (1.3) and sacks per game (0.80) while helping the Crusaders to its third-straight League title. He joins Fordham senior linebacker Ryan Greenhagen and Lafayette senior defensive lineman Malik Hamm, who had been selected to the initial watch list before the season.

SLUKA AMONG FCS RUSHING TOUCHDOWN LEADERS

Holy Cross sophomore quarterback Matthew Sluka, the defending Patriot League Rookie of the Year, is 14th in the FCS with 13 rushing touchdowns in 11 games this season. He rushed for two scores against Fordham (Nov. 13). Sluka has rushed for a touchdown in six of the Crusaders' last seven games. He is 38th in the FCS with 12.5 points responsible for per game.

FOUR NAMED CAMPBELL TROPHY SEMIFINALISTS

Four Patriot League football student-athletes were named 2021 NFF William V. Campbell Trophy Semifinalists. Bucknell senior defensive lineman Grayson Cherubino, Georgetown graduate student defensive back Ahmad Wilson, Holy Cross senior running back Peter Oliver and Lehigh senior running back Rashawn Allen were among the 176 semifinalists for the prestigious honor. The Campbell Trophy will be awarded to the best football scholar-athlete in the nation for the 32nd year. Allen, Cherubino, Oliver and Wilson are among the 36 nominees from the FCS level.

PATRIOT LEAGUE DEFENDERS TOP FCS ACTIVE LEADERS IN TFLS

Four Patriot League defensive players rank among the FCS active leaders in tackles for loss per game. Greenhagen, Dobbs and Lafayette senior defensive lineman Malik Hamm, the League's last three defensive players of the year are all among the top-20. Leopards' junior linebacker Marco Olivas is also among the FCS' active top-50.

FIVE PATRIOT LEAGUERS AMONG FCS ACTIVE SACK LEADERS

Three Patriot League defensive players are among the top-20 active FCS student-athletes in sacks. Hamm, the 2019 Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year and 2018 rookie of the year, has 23.5 sacks in 37 games for an average of 0.64 sacks per game. Holy Cross's Dobbs has 8.0 sacks this season give him 14.5 sacks in 28 games. Greenhagen's 16.5 sacks in 31 games give him an average of 0.53 sacks per game.

DOBBS EARNS STATS PERFORM NATIONAL DEFENSIVE PLAYER

Holy Cross junior linebacker Jacob Dobbs was named the Stats Perform FCS National Defensive Player of the Week after compiling 13 tackles, 4.0 tackles for loss (TFLs) and 2.0 sacks in the Crusaders' 20-17 victory over Yale on Sept. 18. Dobbs has recorded double-digit tackles in five games this season and is among the League and FCS leaders, averaging 10.2 tackles per game. He also leads the League in TFLs (1.2) and is second in sacks (0.73). Dobbs joined Greenhagen as League student-athletes to collect national defensive player of the week accolades.

GREENHAGEN BREAKS NCAA DI TACKLES RECORD

Fordham senior linebacker Ryan Greenhagen recorded 31 tackles and one sack in the Rams' season-opening loss at Nebraska on Sept. 4. The performance broke the NCAA Division I single-game tackles record of 30, previously shared between Chattanooga's Josh Cain (2001), Norfolk State's Kevin Talley (2004) and Stetson's Donald Payne (2014). The previous Patriot League record was 28 total tackles, set in 1990 by Lehigh's Lee Picariello, a two-time All-League honoree. He followed up his record-breaking stat line with 28 tackles in a loss to Monmouth on Sept. 11. His 28-tackle performance is tied for the second-highest single-game total in Patriot League history. He is currently leading the nation with 29.0 tackles per game.

THREE EARN PRESEASON FCS STATS PERFORM HONORS

Fordham's Greenhagen and Lafayette's Hamm were selected to the 35-member watch list for the Buck Buchanan Award, presented annually to the top defensive player in the FCS. Fordham senior quarterback Tim DeMorat is on the 35-member pre-season watch list for the Walter Payton Award for the FCS offensive player of the year. DeMorat and Greenhagen were the Patriot League's 2021 Spring Offensive and Defensive Player of the Year. Hamm was the 2019 Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year.

PATRIOT LEAGUE FOOTBALL ALUMS IN THE NFL

Five Patriot League football alums are with NFL teams heading into week 12. Former Fordham running back Chase Edmonds enters his fourth season with the Arizona Cardinals after a record-breaking career with the Rams. Edmonds was a fourth-round selection by the Cardinals in the 2018 NFL Draft. Former Bucknell offensive lineman Julien Davenport has made the Indianapolis Colts 53-man roster after signing with the organization over the summer. Davenport will begin his fifth season in the NFL after being a fourth-round pick of the Houston Texans in 2017. Former Holy Cross wide receiver Kalif Raymond will begin the season with the Detroit Lions. He enters his sixth season in the League after initially signing with the Denver Broncos as an undrafted free agent in 2016. Bucknell alum Abdullah Anderson is a member of the Tennessee Titans practice squad, while Fordham alum Anthony Coyle is on the Indianapolis Colts practice squad.

BUCKRHAM EARNS AWARD FOR LEADERSHIP AND CHARACTER

Former Lehigh defensive back Divine Buckrham was a recipient of the Patriot League Award for Outstanding Leadership and Character. Buckrham is the sixth Lehigh student-athlete and third football player to receive the honor established in 2011-12 to recognize individuals who demonstrate excellence in leadership and service while participating in Patriot League athletics. Buckrham won a university-wide Lehigh University Anti-Racist Creative Idea Proposal contest. He suggested "Student-led Freshmen Seminars" to create spaces where students can have honest, open conversations with peers to talk about race in America and contribute to making meaningful change. His work in that space was not limited to his ideas. Buckrham also served as the Chair of the Diversity and Inclusion Committee and a member of the Elections Committee within the Lehigh Undergraduate Student Senate.

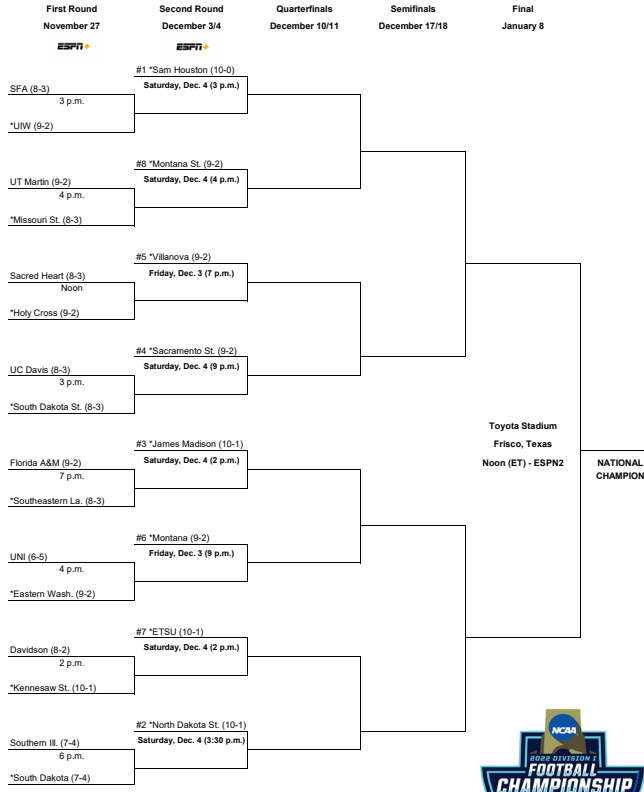

2021-22 PATRIOT LEAGUE ATHLETICS & ACADEMIC SUCCESS

Now in its fourth decade as an all-sport conference combining academic and athletic excellence, the Patriot League sponsors championships in 24 men and women's sports. Initially started as an NCAA Division I-AA football conference in 1986, the Patriot League became an all-sport conference in 1990 and includes American, Army West Point, Boston University, Bucknell, Colgate, Holy Cross, Lafayette, Lehigh, Loyola Maryland and Navy as full members, and Fordham, Georgetown, MIT and Richmond as associate members. These institutions are among the oldest and most prestigious in the nation and their alumni have and continue to play leadership roles in shaping our country.

*The Patriot League's mission is simple: to provide successful competitive athletic experiences while maintaining high academic standards, and to prepare its student-athletes to be leaders in society. During the 2020-21 academic year, Patriot League student-athletes and teams accomplished the following:

*The League's 95 percent graduation success rate (GSR) is the second-best mark in the nation, finishing in the top three in each year since the rating has been released in 2013. All 10 member schools were at 91 percent or higher, each exceeding the record-high national GSR of 90 percent. In addition, the League's 87 percent Federal Graduation Rate (FGR) places it as the national leader for the eighth-consecutive year.

*17 student-athletes earned CoSIDA Academic All-America recognition including first-team accolades for Bucknell's Rick Mottram (Football), Navy's Sean Casey (Men's Track and Field), Thomas Johnstone (Men's Track and Field), Micah Oh (Men's Swimming and Diving) and Victoria Tran (Women's Soccer). Second-team honorees include Fordham's Ryan Greenhagen (Football), Lehigh's Mason Black (Baseball) and Conor Gaffney (Men's Lacrosse), Loyola Maryland's Elli Kluegel (Women's Lacrosse) and Navy's Christian Daniel (Men's Lacrosse), Matt Nocita (Men's Soccer) and Andrew Ton (Men's Tennis). Third-team honorees include Bucknell's Matt Thorsheim (Men's Soccer) Navy's Cam Davis (Men's Basketball), Caroline Kwon (Women's Lacrosse), Zach Stevens (Baseball) and Nicole Victory (Women's Lacrosse).

*47 Patriot League student-athletes received CoSIDA Academic All-District recognition.

*There were 3,739 Patriot League student-athletes named to the Patriot League Academic Honor Roll in 2020-21, the second-highest total in League history and the fourth consecutive year the League has topped 3,000 honorees.

*Lehigh's Divine Buckrham (Football) and Bucknell's Abby Kapp (Women's Basketball) each received the 2020-21 Patriot League Award of Outstanding Leadership and Character, recognizing their shared excellence in leadership and service.

*Colgate's Nia Ahart (Women's Basketball) and David Maynard (Men's Basketball) were named the League's 2020-21 Sportsmanship Award winners for demonstrating fairness, equality and excellence in academics and athletics.

*Bucknell's Kaelyn Long (Field Hockey) was the League's nominee for the 2020-21 NCAA Woman of the Year award, honoring the academic achievements, athletics excellence, community service and leadership of graduating female college athletes.

*MIT's Marla Odell (Women's Rowing) who competed in the 2017 Patriot League Rowing Championship, earned a 2021 Marshall Scholarship when it was announced in December 2020.

*Army West Point's Tyrese Bender (Men's Track & Field) and Hannah Blakey became the fifth and sixth student-athletes in Patriot League history to receive the prestigious Rhodes Scholarship.

*Five Patriot League football student-athletes were named to the 2020-21 FCS ADA Academic All-Star Team; Bucknell's Rick Mottram, an FCS ADA Postgraduate Scholarship Finalist, and Simeon Page, Fordham's Ryan Greenhagen, Holy Cross's Peter Oliver and Lehigh's Austin Dambach.

*Two Patriot League student-athletes were recognized among the 2020-21 Senior CLASS Award finalists with Lehigh's Teddy Leggett (Men's Lacrosse) receiving Senior CLASS Award Second Team honors in men's lacrosse and Navy's Cam Davis (Men's Basketball) claiming Senior CLASS Award Second Team honors in men's basketball.

*11 Patriot Leaguers were All-America selections during the 2020-21 athletic year with first-team status for Bucknell's Maura Fiamoncini (Women's Track & Field), Lehigh's Mike Sisselberger (Men's Lacrosse) and Loyola Maryland's Evan Brown

(Men's Golf).

*Three Patriot League baseball student-athletes were selected in the Major League Baseball (MLB) Draft, including Lehigh's Mason Black and Matt Svanson and Navy's Charlie Connolly. Loyola Maryland's Santi Aldama became the first League student-athlete selected in the NBA Draft since 2013 and fourth ever. Lehigh's Conor Gaffney was selected in the 2021 Premier Lacrosse League (PLL) College Draft. Lafayette's Natalie Kucowski was chosen in the 2021 WNBA Draft.

*Three Patriot League football student-athletes were on rosters when the 2021 NFL season opened, including Bucknell's Julien Davenport (Indianapolis Colts), Fordham's Chase Edmonds (Arizona Cardinals) and Holy Cross' Kalif Raymond (Detroit Lions).

*Two Patriot League men's basketball student-athletes played on NBA rosters during the 2020-21 season, including Bucknell's Mike Muscala (Oklahoma City Thunder), and Lehigh's C.J. McCollum (Portland Trail Blazers). Former Bucknell men's basketball student-athlete Charles Lee earned an NBA Championship as an assistant coach with the Milwaukee Bucks. McCollum was also recently named the President of the National Basketball Players Association.

*Nine Patriot League student-athletes and coaches competed during the 2020 Tokyo Olympics and Paralympics. Olympians include Boston University's Julimar Avila (Honduras, women's swimming) and Anna Weis (USA, sailing), former Bucknell softball head coach Joey Lye (Canada, softball), MIT's Veronica Toro (Puerto Rico, women's rowing) and Navy's Regine Tugade-Watson (Guam, women's track and field). Bucknell's Rayven Sample (USA, men's track and field), Loyola Maryland's McKenzie Coan (USA, women's swimming) and McClain Hermes (USA, women's swimming) and Navy's Brad Snyder (USA, swimming) all competed in the Paralympics.

*Boston University's Julimar Avila finished 16th in women's 200-meter butterfly at the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games. Avila became the first Honduras swimmer to advance beyond the preliminary round.

*Boston University graduate Allie Hammel and Lafayette graduate Amanda Magadan were selected as members of the 2021 U.S. National Field Hockey Team.

*Navy won the Patriot League Presidents' Cup for the seventh-straight time and eighth in the last nine times it has been presented (no award for 2019-20) following the 2020-21 academic year. Army West Point won the men's race, while Boston University topped the women's standings.

*Loyola Maryland's Elli Kluegel (Women's Lacrosse) and Navy's Micah Oh (Men's Swimming & Diving) were named the Patriot League Female and Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year honorees, respectively, for the 2020-21 academic year. Oh was also awarded the Elite 90 Award at the NCAA Men's Swimming and Diving Championship. The honor is presented to the student-athlete with the highest cumulative GPA competing at the NCAA Championships.

*Loyola Maryland's Julia Gray (Women's Soccer) was selected as the Patriot League's representative to the NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Advisory Committee, beginning a two-year term.

*Lehigh and Loyola Maryland qualified for the 2021 NCAA Men's Lacrosse Championship, marking the sixth time in League history that the League has received multiple bids. The Greyhounds won their first-round matchup to advance to the NCAA Quarterfinals.

*Loyola Maryland qualified for the 2021 NCAA Women's Lacrosse Championship and won their first-round matchup, marking the fourth-consecutive season that a League program has won at least one NCAA Tournament game.

*American men's soccer team advanced to the second round of the NCAA Championship, and Bucknell field hockey captured its first NCAA Championship win and advanced to the quarterfinal round.

*Loyola Maryland men's golfer Evan Brown finished tied for eighth at the NCAA Men's Golf Regionals in Kingston Springs, Tenn.

*Bucknell's Maura Fiamoncini placed third at the NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championships in the women's javelin to earn First Team All-America honors. Army West Point's August Cook also qualified for nationals, placing 13th in the men's javelin.
