HOW TO WATCH TO PATRIOT LEAGUE FOOTBALL THIS WEEKEND

The 2021 Patriot League spring football season resumes on Saturday with a pair of important divisional matchups. Holy Cross (1-0 PL, 0-0 North) welcomes Fordham (0-0 PL, 0-0 North) to Fitton Field with Kevin Gehl and Rich Fisher providing the call on ESPN+, beginning at 1 p.m. Bucknell (0-0 PL, 0-0 South) opens its season by hosting Lafayette (1-0 PL, 0-0 South) at Christy Mathewson - Memorial Stadium. Doug Birdsong and Kevin Herr will be on the ESPN+ broadcast, beginning at 4 p.m.

PATRIOT LEAGUE 2021 SPRING FOOTBALL SEASON EXPLAINED

The Patriot League's six football teams are split into two three-team divisions for the 2021 spring season. Colgate, Fordham and Holy Cross play in the North Division. Bucknell, Lafayette and Lehigh play in the South Division. Teams will play each divisional opponent once along with non-divisional games. The League schedule will conclude on Saturday, April 17, with a championship game between the two division winners. Make-up games will be played on Saturday, April 10. The Georgetown football program will forgo participation in the spring 2021 season. If conditions allow and within permissible local and federal guidelines, the Hoyas will work to bring football student-athletes back for training in the spring in preparation for the traditional fall 2021.

HOLY CROSS PICKED TO DEFEND PATRIOT LEAGUE TITLE

Defending Patriot League champion Holy Cross (7-6, 5-1 PL in '19) topped the preseason poll, receiving 45 points and five first-place votes. Colgate (4-8, 3-3 PL in '19) was picked second with 36 points and two first-place votes, Fordham (4-8, 2-4 PL in '19) finished third with 35 points and four first-place votes, while Lafayette (4-8, 4-2 PL in '19) placed fourth with 28 points and one first-place vote. Lehigh (4-7, 3-3 PL in '19) and Bucknell (3-8, 3-3 PL in '19) ranked fifth and sixth, respectively, to round out the preseason poll.

PATRIOT LEAGUE RESCHEDULES WEEK THREE GAMES

The originally scheduled matchups for Saturday, March 27 between Bucknell-Lehigh and Holy Cross-Colgate have been postponed with a pair of games being rescheduled in their place. Bucknell will host Lafayette in a Southern Division game and Fordham opens its season against North Division foe Holy Cross. Lehigh will have a bye week while Colgate remains out due to a positive COVID-19 test within the program's Tier 1 from March 17. The schedule adjustments were made to provide all teams the opportunity to play both divisional opponents during the remainder of the League season. Games for the weekend of Saturday, April 10 will be announced at a later date.

THREE EARN STATS PERFORM PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA HONORS

Three Patriot League football student-athletes received 2020 Stats Perform FCS Preseason All-America honors in September. Lafayette Jr. DL Malik Hamm earned First-Team Preseason All-America honors after being named the 2019 Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year. Fordham So. LB Ryan Greenhagen was named to the second team after compiling 123 tackles and 18.5 TFLs in 2019. Holy Cross Sr. OL Brian Foley, a two-time first-team All-League received third-team accolades after helping the Crusaders' offense gain 409.0 yards of total offense per game.

PATRIOT LEAGUE DEFENDERS TOP FCS ACTIVE LEADERS IN TFLS

The Patriot League boasts four players of the top 10 among the FCS active leaders in tackles for loss per game. Fordham junior linebacker Ryan Greenhagen, led the League in TFLs per game last season at 1.54. His 18.5 TFLs in 2019 was the third-best single-season mark in program history. Bucknell senior linebacker Simeon Page has 34.5 TFLs in 27 career games. Lafayette sophomore defensive lineman Malik Hamm has 27.5 TFLs in 24 games while Fordham junior linebacker Glenn Cunningham has 38.5 TFLs in 33 career games.

FOOTBALL PROGRAMS PLACE AMONG NCAA LEADERS IN GRADUATION RATE REPORT

The Patriot League's seven football programs registered the best FGR score (90) in the NCAA and the third-best GSR score (91). Five teams posted a GSR of 90 or better, including Georgetown (100), Holy Cross (97), Lafayette (97), Colgate (93) and Bucknell (91).

MOTTRAM AND BRENNEMAN NAMED CAMPBELL TROPHY SEMIFINALISTS

Bucknell's Rick Mottram and Colgate's Grant Breneman were named a semifinalists for the 2020 William V. Campbell Trophy®, the National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame (NFF) in 2020. The two Academic All-Patriot League honorees were among a record 199 semifinalists for this prestigious award. Mottram, a two-time CoSIDA Academic All-District 2 and Academic All-Patriot League Team honoree, finished 2019 with 102 tackles to become the first Bison to reach the century mark in a single campaign since Evan Byers (119) in 2014. He also totaled eight tackles for a loss, four sacks, two interceptions and one fumble return for a touchdown. Mottram was voted as a team captain during the summer of 2020 and represents the Patriot League on the NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Connection Group. A Mechanical Engineering major with a 3.97 grade point average, Mottram will work as a systems engineer at Lockheed Martin Space following his graduation from Bucknell. A senior quarterback, Breneman already ranks ninth in school history in both career passing yards (4,787) and career total offense (5,707). The Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania, native is a two-time Academic All-Patriot League choice, an All-Patriot League First Team pick and former conference Rookie of the Year.

PATRIOT LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME ON CBS SPORTS NETWORK

The Patriot League Football Championship Game, scheduled for Saturday, April 17 will be nationally televised on CBS Sports Network at 2 p.m. The winner of the Patriot League North will take on the winner of the Patriot League South in the first League championship game in the League's 35-year history.

FORDHAM RAMS (0-0 PL, 0-0 North) AT HOLY CROSS CRUSADERS (1-0 PL, 0-0 North)

Fitton Field | Worcester, Mass.Saturday, March 27, 1 p.m., ET (ESPN+)

SERIES HISTORY: Holy Cross and Fordham meet for the 58th time in series history and for the 35th time since the Ram-Crusader Cup has been awarded to honor Major Frank Cavanaugh, who served as head coach at both programs. The Crusaders lead the all-time series (30-25-2) that began in 1902. Since the beginning of the Ram-Crusader Cup in 1951, Holy Cross is 19-15.

LAST MEETING: (Nov. 6, 2019) - Holy Cross scored 35 points in the fourth quarter, as they overcame an early 14-point deficit to claim at least a share of the Patriot League regular-season title with a 49-27 victory at Fordham. Junior quarterback Connor Degenhardt rushed for a pair of fourth-quarter touchdowns in the comeback win. Degenhardt also completed 15-of-29 passes for 194 yards and a touchdown. Senior running back Domenic Cozier rushed for a game-high 170 yards and two touchdowns, including a 12-yard score in the fourth quarter to give the Crusaders their first lead of the game. Freshman wide receiver Ayir Asante caught 11 passes for 119 yards, and junior wide receiver Tenio Ayeni finished with five catches for 96 yards. Fordham sophomore quarterback Tim DeMorat 23-of-41 passes for 346 yards, three touchdowns and two interceptions. He threw a first-quarter touchdown pass to freshman wide receiver Dequece Carter to give the Rams a 14-0 lead. Carter finished with seven catches for 120 yards and two touchdowns and junior wide receiver Hamze El-Zayat caught nine passes for 122 yards and one touchdown. Junior running back Trey Sneed rushed for 92 yards on 14 carries and senior running back Zach Davis scored a touchdown and rushed for 60 yards on 17 carries.

Christy Mathewson Memorial Stadium | Lewisburg, Pa.4 p.m., ET (ESPN+)

SERIES HISTORY: Bucknell and Lafayette meet for the 98th time in series history with the Leopards holding a 54-37-6 advantage. The Bison and Leopards first met in 1883, with Lafayette earning a 59-0 victory. The Bison have won five of the last nine meetings between the two schools, including a 13-7 overtime win at Fisher Stadium in 2017.

LAST MEETING: (Oct. 26, 2019) - Lafayette freshman quarterback Keegan Shoemaker completed 23-of-27 passes for 207 yards and a touchdown pass, in addition to rushing for a touchdown to lead Lafayette to a 21-17 victory over Bucknell. Shoemaker connected with senior wide receiver Nick Pearson on a 43-yard touchdown pass and junior running back Selwyn Simpson rushed for a 22-yard score for 14 unanswered fourth-quarter points to lead the Leopards comeback. Bucknell junior quarterback Logan Bitikofer completed 13-of-26 passes for 165 yards and two touchdowns, both to sophomore wide receiver Brandon Sanders, who finished with eight receptions for 66 yards and two touchdowns. Lafayette junior linebacker Major Jordan led the Leopards with 14 tackles, and Olivas added five tackles, 2.0 sacks and a forced fumble. Bucknell junior linebacker Rick Mottram posted a game-high 16 tackles, 2.0 sacks and an interception. Junior linebacker Simeon Page added six tackles, 2.0 TFLs and 1.0 sack for the Bison.

2020-21 PATRIOT LEAGUE ATHLETICS & ACADEMIC SUCCESS

Now in its fourth decade as an all-sport conference combining academic and athletic excellence, the Patriot League sponsors championships in 24 men and women's sports. Initially started as an NCAA Division I-AA football conference in 1986, the Patriot League became an all-sport conference in 1990 and includes American, Army West Point, Boston University, Bucknell, Colgate, Holy Cross, Lafayette, Lehigh, Loyola Maryland and Navy as full members, and Fordham, Georgetown, MIT and Richmond as associate members. These institutions are among the oldest and most prestigious in the nation and their alumni have and continue to play leadership roles in shaping our country.

The Patriot League's mission is simple: to provide successful competitive athletic experiences while maintaining high academic standards, and to prepare its student-athletes to be leaders in society. During the 2019-20 academic year, Patriot League student-athletes and teams accomplished the following:

*92 Patriot League teams (47 percent of League teams) earned NCAA Public Recognition Awards for ranking in the top 10 percent of their sport in Academic Progress Rate (APR), with 80 squads earning perfect scores.

*The Patriot League ranked second among all conferences in Public Recognition Awards, and also placing second for the highest percentage of teams earning the honor at 47 percent.

*The League's 94 percent graduation success rate (GSR) is the third-best mark in the nation, finishing in the top three in each year since the rating has been released in 2013. All 10 member schools were at 90 percent or higher, each exceeding the record-high national GSR of 89 percent. In addition the League's 83 percent Federal Graduation Rate (FGR) places it as the national leader for the sixth-consecutive year.

*14 student-athletes earned Google Cloud CoSIDA Academic All-America recognition including first-team accolades for Army West Point's Anthony Giachin (Baseball) and Serica Hallstead (Women's Swimming & Diving), Bucknell's Rick Mottram (Football), Navy's Caddie Higginson (Women's Soccer), Paige Miles (Women's Volleyball) and Micah Oh (Men's Swimming & Diving). Second-team honorees include Army West Point's Jacob Hurtubise (Baseball) and Benjamin Petrella (Men's Cross Country/Track & Field), Lehigh's Conor Gaffney (Men's Lacrosse) and Navy's Jared Leins (Baseball). Third-team recipients include Loyola Maryland's Anne Hayburn (Women's Swimming & Diving), Navy's Michael Coritz (Baseball), Christian Daniel (Men's Lacrosse), and Victoria Tran (Women's Soccer).

*47 Patriot League student-athletes received Google Cloud/CoSIDA Academic All-District recognition.

*There were a Patriot League record 3,960 student-athletes named to the Patriot League Academic Honor Roll in 2019-20, besting the previous record, set in 2018-19, by 837 members.

*Loyola Maryland's Jimmy Hayburn (Men's Swimming & Diving) and Holy Cross' Maegan Moriarty (Women's Rowing) each received the 2019-20 Patriot League Award of Outstanding Leadership and Character.

*Colgate's Milan Williams (Men's Basketball) and Taylor Wright (Women's Rowing) were named the League's 2019-20 Sportsmanship Award winners.

*Boston University's Abigail Gugel (Women's Cross Country/Track & Field) and Loyola Maryland's Ann Ernst (Women's Volleyball) were the League's nominees for the 2019-20 NCAA Woman of the Year award.

*Army West Point's Lynne Mooradian (Women's Cross Country/Track & Field) became the seventh student-athlete in Patriot League history to receive the prestigious Marshall Scholarship.

*Loyola Maryland's Anne Hayburn (Women's Swimming & Diving) and Navy's Thomas Buffone Men's Outdoor Track & Field both received 2019-20 NCAA Post-graduate Scholarships.

*Bucknell's Alex Pechin (Football) was presented with the 2019 Doris Robinson Scholar-Athlete Award. Named after the late school teacher and wife of legendary Grambling State coach Eddie Robinson, the fifth annual Doris Robinson Award has been presented to an FCS student-athlete who excels in the classroom, the community and beyond.

*Four Patriot League football student-athletes were named to the 2019 FCS ADA Academic All-Star Team, including Bucknell's Rick Mottram and Alex Pechin, Colgate's Chris Puzzi and Georgetown's Ahmad Wilson.

*Navy's Sydney Fortson (Women's Soccer) was selected in nationwide balloting as the 2019 Senior CLASS Award winner in NCAA Division I women's soccer. Loyola Maryland's Ann Ernst (Women's Volleyball) received Senior CLASS Award Second Team honors in women's volleyball.

*A pair of Patriot League women's basketball student-athletes - Colgate's Rachel Thompson and Lafayette's Kyle Stout - are recipients of the Victory Scholarship for the 2020-21 academic year to attend graduate school in Ireland and Northern Ireland. Twenty-two Patriot League graduates have participated in the program.

*23 Patriot Leaguers were All-America selections during the shortened 2019-20 athletic year with first-team status for Bucknell's Alex Pechin (Football) and Loyola Maryland's Livy Rosenzweig (Women's Lacrosse) and Katie Detwiler (Women's Lacrosse).

*A record-tying nine Patriot Leaguers were selected in the Major League Lacrosse (MLL) Draft, with five in the top-25, including Army West Point's Tom Rigney, Boston University's Reece Eddy and Chase Levesque and Bucknell's Will Yorke. Three League student-athletes were picked in the 2020 Premier Lacrosse League (PLL) Draft and three were selected in the 2020 NLL Draft. Army West Point's Zac McGraw and Loyola Maryland's Josh Fawole and Barry Sharifi were taken in the 2020 Major League Soccer (MLS) SuperDraft. Holy Cross's Lauren Manis was chosen in the 2020 WNBA Draft.

*Three Patriot League football student-athletes were on active rosters when the 2020 NFL season opened, including Bucknell's Julien Davenport (Miami Dolphins), Fordham's Chase Edmonds (Arizona Cardinals) and Holy Cross' Kalif Raymond (Tennessee Titans).

*Three Patriot League men's basketball student-athletes played on NBA rosters during the 2019-20 season, including Bucknell's Mike Muscala (Oklahoma City Thunder), Holy Cross' Malcolm Miller (Toronto Raptors) and Lehigh's C.J. McCollum (Portland Trail Blazers).

*Boston University graduate Allie Hammel and Lafayette graduate Amanda Magadan were both selected as members of the 2020 U.S. National Field Hockey Team.

*Loyola Maryland's Pat Spencer (Men's Lacrosse) became the second Patriot League student-athlete to win the Tewaaron Award (nation's top men's lacrosse player) in 2019. He was also a finalist in 2017 and 2018. He joined Colgate's Peter Baum (2012) as the only Patriot League Tewaaron Award winner.

*Navy won the Patriot League Presidents' Cup for the sixth-straight time and seventh in the last eight years following the 2018-19 academic year. Army West Point won the men's standings with a record 77 points, while Boston University topped the women's standings.

*Loyola Maryland's Kristen Yanchoris (Women's Lacrosse) and Alex Pechin (Football) were named the Patriot League Female and Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year honorees, respectively for the 2018-19 academic year.

*Navy and Loyola Maryland both qualified for the 2019 NCAA Women's Lacrosse Championships, marking the second time in as many years the League received two bids to the tournament. The Mids and Greyhounds both won their first-round matchups.
