South Division champ Bucknell (2-1 PL, 2-0 South) hosts North Division winner Holy Cross (2-0 PL, 1-0 North) in the first Patriot League Football Championship Game on Saturday at Christy Mathewson-Memorial Stadium in Lewisburg, Pa. The game will be nationally televised on CBS Sports Network with live coverage beginning at 2 p.m. ET. Jason Knapp will handle play-by-play duties, while Ross Tucker will provide analysis. A Bucknell audio broadcast featuring Doug Birdsong and Kevin Herr will be available on BucknellBison.com and locally on 100.9 The Valley (WVLY). The winner of the Patriot League Championship Game will earn the League's automatic bid to the NCAA DI FCS Championship.

DEMORAT, GREENHAGEN, SLUKA AND CECCHINI CAPTURE POSTSEASON MAJOR AWARDS

Fordham junior quarterback Tim DeMorat and junior linebacker Ryan Greenhagen were selected Patriot League Offensive and Defensive Player of the year, respectively, when the Patriot League announced All-League honors and major awards for the 2021 spring season. Holy Cross freshman quarterback Matthew Sluka was named Patriot League Rookie of the Year for the North Division champion Crusaders. Bucknell Head Coach Dave Cecchini claimed Patriot League Dick Biddle Coach of the Year honors for the South Division champion Bison. Lafayette placed a League-high 15 student-athletes on the two All-Patriot League teams, including five first-team members. The Crusaders garnered 14 All-League selections with six on the first-team, followed by Fordham with 13 (9 first-team) and Bucknell with 11 (7 first-team). Lehigh and Colgate finished with six and three All-League honorees, respectively.

PATRIOT LEAGUE NOTEBOOK (CHAMPIONSHIP)

BUCKNELL AND HOLY CROSS TO MEET IN TITLE GAME

Bucknell clinched the South Division title and a spot in the first Patriot League Football Championship Game with a 6-0 win at Lehigh on April 3 for the program's first shutout win since 2017. They will host defending Patriot League Champion Holy Cross, who earned the North Division Crown after the cancellation of their Week Five matchup against Colgate. The Patriot League Football Championship Game is scheduled for Saturday, April 17 and will be nationally televised on CBS Sports Network at 2 p.m. The winner will earn the League's automatic bid to the 2021 FCS Championship.

ALL-PATRIOT LEAGUE FOOTBALL BY THE NUMBERS

Twenty-four of the All-Patriot League football selections are multi-year honorees. Bucknell senior linebacker Simeon Page and Fordham senior linebacker Glenn Cunningham expanded the four-time All-Patriot League club to 20 members. Page and Cunningham each earned a spot on the first team for the third time this season. Five student-athletes joined the list of 94 Patriot League football players to earn All-League honors three times. Three of the first-team offensive linemen, including Colgate senior Jack Badovinac, Fordham senior Nick Zakelj and Holy Cross senior Brian Foley received All-League honors for the third time. Greenhagen and Lafayette junior defensive lineman Malik Hamm, the 2019 Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, each received their third All-League accolade. All were first-team selections this season.

MOTTRAM AND HAFFNER JOIN ELITE CLUB

Mottram (physics, 3.97 GPA) and Lehigh senior linebacker Pete Haffner (finance, 3.64 GPA) became the eighth and ninth football student-athletes to earn Academic All-Patriot League honors for the third time. Bucknell's Alex Pechin, Fordham's Josh Cerra and Dan Light, Holy Cross's Sam Jones, John Macomber and Jake Wiczorek, and Lafayette's Mark Ross were all three-time Academic All-Patriot League Football selections.

DOBBS NAMED STATS PERFORM FCS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Holy Cross So. LB Jacob Dobbs was named the Stats Perform FCS National Defensive Player of the Week when announced on March 29. Dobbs posted 12 tackles, including nine solo tackles, 1.5 TFLs and a half-sack in the Crusaders' 34-24 comeback victory against Fordham on March 27. Dobbs is the first Patriot League FCS national weekly honoree since former Lafayette QB Keegan Shoemaker was named rookie of the week on Sept. 17, 2019.

DEMORAT AND BRENEMAN AMONG FCS ACTIVE LEADERS

Fordham junior quarterback Tim DeMorat and Colgate senior quarterback Grant Breneman are 19th and 22nd, respectively, among FCS active leaders in total offense per game. DeMorat has averaged 203.5 yards of total offense per game in 25 career games. Breneman has averaged 194.3 yards of total offense per game in 32 games. Breneman has totaled 6,216 yards of total offense during his four-year career.

UPPERCLASSMEN DOMINATE ALL-LEAGUE SELECTIONS

Seniors accounted for 27 of the 62 spots on the two All-League squads, while 19 juniors received postseason honors. Fifteen sophomores filled the roster, with Lehigh freshman defensive back La'Treil Wimberly as the lone first-year player to be voted onto the teams by the League coaches.

SIX FIRST-TEAM, FOUR SECOND-TEAM ALL-PATRIOT LEAGUE HONOREES MAKE ACADEMIC TEAM

Ten members of the Academic All-Patriot League squad were recognized as All-League members when it was announced by the League. Fordham Sr. LB Glenn Cunningham (economics, 3.49 GPA), Jr. LB Ryan Greenhagen (business administration, 3.84 GPA) and Sr. OL Nick Zakelj (finance, 3.66 GPA), Lafayette Sr. PK/P Jeffery Kordenbrock (mechanical engineering, 3.76 GPA), along with Bucknell Sr. LB Simeon Page (creative writing, 3.48 GPA) and Colgate junior defensive back/return specialist Will Gruber (psychology, 3.60 GPA), were all first-team selections. Haffner, Lafayette Sr. LB Major Jordan (engineering, 3.6 GPA) and Sr. OL John Burk (electrical engineering and computer engineering, 3.72 GPA) collected second-team accolades. Gruber and Kordenbrock earned spots on the first- and second-teams at different positions.

FOOTBALL PROGRAMS PLACE AMONG NCAA LEADERS IN GRADUATION RATE REPORT

The Patriot League's seven football programs registered the best FGR score (90) in the NCAA and the third-best GSR score (91). Five teams posted a GSR of 90 or better, including Georgetown (100), Holy Cross (97), Lafayette (97), Colgate (93) and Bucknell (91).

SERIES HISTORY: Holy Cross and Bucknell meet for the 37th time in series history with the Crusaders holding a 23-13 advantage. The series dates back to Oct. 31, 1925, when the Crusaders defeated the Bison 23-7. Holy Cross has won 11 of the last 15 games. Bucknell has won three of its last six, specializing in close games. The three Bison victories have come by a combined 11 points, including a 31-24 overtime win in 2014.

WHAT HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE? Bucknell and Holy Cross have traded victories through their last seven meetings, with the road team winning each contest. The Crusaders defeated Bucknell at Christy Mathewson-Memorial Stadium, 21-14, in 2019. The Bison earned a 19-16 victory at Fitton Field in 2018.

LAST MEETING: (October 5, 2019) - Holy Cross junior quarterback Connor Degenhardt threw one touchdown pass then rushed for a pair of scores to lead the Crusaders to a 21-14 comeback victory to spoil homecoming at Bucknell.

*Degenhardt completed 19-of-34 passes for 276 yards with one touchdown and two interceptions and senior running back Domenic Cozier carried 16 times for 101 yards to lead the offense.

*Crusaders' junior defensive lineman Benton Whitley had five tackles and two sacks, while senior defensive back Corey Stefanik had seven tackles and recovered two fumbles.

*Bucknell sophomore wide receiver Brandon Sanders posted career-highs with 14 catches and 122 yards to lead the Bison offense.

*Junior quarterback Logan Bitikofer completed 20-of-29 passes for 185 yards and senior running back Chad Freshnock carried 14 times for 78 yards.

*Bucknell freshman defensive back Gavin Pringle had nine tackles and three pass breakups while junior linebacker Rick Mottram added nine tackles and 1.0 TFL. Junior safety Conner Romango had five tackles and an interception.

*Junior linebacker Gerrit Van Itallie intercepted a pass and returned it 52 yards for a score to extend the Bison lead to 14-0.



2020-21 PATRIOT LEAGUE ATHLETICS & ACADEMIC SUCCESS

Now in its fourth decade as an all-sport conference combining academic and athletic excellence, the Patriot League sponsors championships in 24 men and women's sports. Initially started as an NCAA Division I-AA football conference in 1986, the Patriot League became an all-sport conference in 1990 and includes American, Army West Point, Boston University, Bucknell, Colgate, Holy Cross, Lafayette, Lehigh, Loyola Maryland and Navy as full members, and Fordham, Georgetown, MIT and Richmond as associate members. These institutions are among the oldest and most prestigious in the nation and their alumni have and continue to play leadership roles in shaping our country.

The Patriot League's mission is simple: to provide successful competitive athletic experiences while maintaining high academic standards, and to prepare its student-athletes to be leaders in society. During the 2019-20 academic year, Patriot League student-athletes and teams accomplished the following:

*92 Patriot League teams (47 percent of League teams) earned NCAA Public Recognition Awards for ranking in the top 10 percent of their sport in Academic Progress Rate (APR), with 80 squads earning perfect scores.

*The Patriot League ranked second among all conferences in Public Recognition Awards, and also placing second for the highest percentage of teams earning the honor at 47 percent.

*The League's 94 percent graduation success rate (GSR) is the third-best mark in the nation, finishing in the top three in each year since the rating has been released in 2013. All 10 member schools were at 90 percent or higher, each exceeding the record-high national GSR of 89 percent. In addition the League's 83 percent Federal Graduation Rate (FGR) places it as the national leader for the sixth-consecutive year.

*14 student-athletes earned Google Cloud CoSIDA Academic All-America recognition including first-team accolades for Army West Point's Anthony Giachin (Baseball) and Serica Hallstead (Women's Swimming & Diving), Bucknell's Rick Mottram (Football), Navy's Caddie Higginson (Women's Soccer), Paige Miles (Women's Volleyball) and Micah Oh (Men's Swimming & Diving). Second-team honorees include Army West Point's Jacob Hurtubise (Baseball) and Benjamin Petrella (Men's Cross Country/Track & Field), Lehigh's Conor Gaffney (Men's Lacrosse) and Navy's Jared Leins (Baseball). Third-team recipients include Loyola Maryland's Anne Hayburn (Women's Swimming & Diving), Navy's Michael Coritz (Baseball), Christian Daniel (Men's Lacrosse), and Victoria Tran (Women's Soccer).

*47 Patriot League student-athletes received Google Cloud/CoSIDA Academic All-District recognition.

*There were a Patriot League record 3,960 student-athletes named to the Patriot League Academic Honor Roll in 2019-20, besting the previous record, set in 2018-19, by 837 members.

*Loyola Maryland's Jimmy Hayburn (Men's Swimming & Diving) and Holy Cross' Maegan Moriarty (Women's Rowing) each received the 2019-20 Patriot League Award of Outstanding Leadership and Character.

*Colgate's Milan Williams (Men's Basketball) and Taylor Wright (Women's Rowing) were named the League's 2019-20 Sportsmanship Award winners.

*Boston University's Abigail Gugel (Women's Cross Country/Track & Field) and Loyola Maryland's Ann Ernst (Women's Volleyball) were the League's nominees for the 2019-20 NCAA Woman of the Year award.

*Army West Point's Lynne Mooradian (Women's Cross Country/Track & Field) became the seventh student-athlete in Patriot League history to receive the prestigious Marshall Scholarship.

*Loyola Maryland's Anne Hayburn (Women's Swimming & Diving) and Navy's Thomas Buffone Men's Outdoor Track & Field both received 2019-20 NCAA Post-graduate Scholarships.

*Bucknell's Alex Pechin (Football) was presented with the 2019 Doris Robinson Scholar-Athlete Award. Named after the late school teacher and wife of legendary Grambling State coach Eddie Robinson, the fifth annual Doris Robinson Award has been presented to an FCS student-athlete who excels in the classroom, the community and beyond.

*Four Patriot League football student-athletes were named to the 2019 FCS ADA Academic All-Star Team, including Bucknell's Rick Mottram and Alex Pechin, Colgate's Chris Puzzi and Georgetown's Ahmad Wilson.

*Navy's Sydney Fortson (Women's Soccer) was selected in nationwide balloting as the 2019 Senior CLASS Award winner in NCAA Division I women's soccer. Loyola Maryland's Ann Ernst (Women's Volleyball) received Senior CLASS Award Second Team honors in women's volleyball.

*A pair of Patriot League women's basketball student-athletes - Colgate's Rachel Thompson and Lafayette's Kyle Stout - are recipients of the Victory Scholarship for the 2020-21 academic year to attend graduate school in Ireland and Northern Ireland. Twenty-two Patriot League graduates have participated in the program.

*23 Patriot Leaguers were All-America selections during the shortened 2019-20 athletic year with first-team status for Bucknell's Alex Pechin (Football) and Loyola Maryland's Livy Rosenzweig (Women's Lacrosse) and Katie Detwiler (Women's Lacrosse).

*A record-tying nine Patriot Leaguers were selected in the Major League Lacrosse (MLL) Draft, with five in the top-25, including Army West Point's Tom Rigney, Boston University's Reece Eddy and Chase Levesque and Bucknell's Will Yorke. Three League student-athletes were picked in the 2020 Premier Lacrosse League (PLL) Draft and three were selected in the 2020 NLL Draft. Army West Point's Zac McGraw and Loyola Maryland's Josh Fawole and Barry Sharifi were taken in the 2020 Major League Soccer (MLS) SuperDraft. Holy Cross's Lauren Manis was chosen in the 2020 WNBA Draft.

*Three Patriot League football student-athletes were on active rosters when the 2020 NFL season opened, including Bucknell's Julien Davenport (Miami Dolphins), Fordham's Chase Edmonds (Arizona Cardinals) and Holy Cross' Kalif Raymond (Tennessee Titans).

*Three Patriot League men's basketball student-athletes played on NBA rosters during the 2019-20 season, including Bucknell's Mike Muscala (Oklahoma City Thunder), Holy Cross' Malcolm Miller (Toronto Raptors) and Lehigh's C.J. McCollum (Portland Trail Blazers).

*Boston University graduate Allie Hammel and Lafayette graduate Amanda Magadan were both selected as members of the 2020 U.S. National Field Hockey Team.

*Loyola Maryland's Pat Spencer (Men's Lacrosse) became the second Patriot League student-athlete to win the Tewaaron Award (nation's top men's lacrosse player) in 2019. He was also a finalist in 2017 and 2018. He joined Colgate's Peter Baum (2012) as the only Patriot League Tewaaron Award winner.

*Navy won the Patriot League Presidents' Cup for the sixth-straight time and seventh in the last eight years following the 2018-19 academic year. Army West Point won the men's standings with a record 77 points, while Boston University topped the women's standings.

*Loyola Maryland's Kristen Yanchoris (Women's Lacrosse) and Alex Pechin (Football) were named the Patriot League Female and Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year honorees, respectively for the 2018-19 academic year.

*Navy and Loyola Maryland both qualified for the 2019 NCAA Women's Lacrosse Championships, marking the second time in as many years the League received two bids to the tournament. The Mids and Greyhounds both won their first-round matchups.
