P Nico Ruiz - Converted his second fake punt of the season, running 19 yards around the left end on a fourth-and-10 in the first quarter.

Game Notes: IUP beat Clarion 24-23 marking its eighth consecutive over CU dating back to 2011.

CRIMSON HAWKS

GANNON

Players to Watch

RB Marcus Jones - Rushed for 276 yards on 38 carries and two touchdowns. The senior has rushed for 540 yards and six touchdowns over the past two games, both wins for Gannon.

DB Romell Jones - Led Gannon with nine tackles, posted two pass breakups, and had a hand in the biggest play of the game for the defense, as he forced a fumble on a Cal run inside Gannon's 5-yard line in the third quarter to hand the ball back to GU's offense.

QB Jason Dambach - Finished with 167 yards and two touchdowns on nine completions. The 94-yard strike from Dambach to WR Dontae Owens in the third quarter broke the Gannon record for longest pass play.

Game Notes: Gannon earned its first-ever on-field victory against California 29-15 behind Marcus Jones and a bruising effort from the defense.

Players to Watch

QB Roland Rivers - Threw for 403 yards and five touchdowns with the 403 yards marking the 10th most in a single-game in program history. He accounted for six total TDs in a game for the second time in the last five weeks and has now accounted for 22 touchdowns and just three turnovers in five games.

PK Jake Chapla - Made all eight of his PAT kicks to run his current streak to 69 straight makes Chapla now has 130 career made PATs to rank fourth all-time at SRU. He also booted his ninth field goal of the season.

LB Brad Zaffram - Had six total tackles and one TFL in The Rock's 59-28 win over Edinboro. In addition to his tackle numbers, he broke up four passes at the line of scrimmage in the game.

Game Notes: Slippery Rock scored 45 points in the first half and rolled to a 59-28 Homecoming win over Edinboro.

CLARION

Players to Watch

RB Mylique McGriff - Had his second straight 100-yard rushing game last week, going off for 125 yards against IUP. Subtracting the Sept. 15 game against Lincoln when he left with injury after three carries, he is averaging 103.0 rushing yards per game in the other four contests.

WR Dana Jackson - Recorded a touchdown catch for the fourth straight week, recording a 78-yard scoring reception in the first quarter against IUP. He leads Clarion with 358 receiving yards and four scores on the year.

S Quinlin Lambert - Recorded his first interception of the year on Saturday, giving Clarion 13 picks as a team this year.

Game Notes: Clarion outgained the Crimson Hawks 328-263. CU jumped out to a 20-0 lead after one quarter, but got only three more points the rest of the way before falling, 24-23.

DB Tyshaun Pollard - Intercepted the first two passes of his collegiate career with both of his picks coming in the second half. Both led to Huskies' touchdowns as they rallied from a 10-point halftime deficit.

P Kieron Smethers - Had a key rush for four yards on a fake punt set the Huskies up for the first score Saturday. BU went on to score 19 more points in the second half with Smethers punting four times in the game.

Game Notes: Bloomsburg snapped a two-game losing skid with a 26-18 victory over visiting East Stroudsburg on Saturday. Smethers, Pollard and Gooden all received PSAC East Football Athlete of the Week accolades.

RB Chantz Swartz - Rushed for 112 yards, which left him just shy of his career-high of 120.

LB Alex Welch - Had 13 tackles, including six solo stops to go along with two tackles-for-loss, two forced fumbles and a fumble recovery.

WR Nysir Minney-Gratz - Hauled in six catches for 38 yards.

Game Notes: No. 19 Kutztown used a big first half to secure a 41-0, PSAC East win over the visiting Lock Haven Saturday.

QB Chris Jones - Finished the game 10-16 for 173 yards and two touchdowns in one half of play.

LB Cole Shuker - Led the defense with 12 tackles including a sack and one tackle for loss.

Game Notes: Seton Hill defeated Mercyhurst 34-33 on Saturday afternoon after trailing 31-7 early in the third quarter. It's the first win for the Griffins since they defeated MU 55-45 in 2016.

QB Jarrod Kellar - Made his first start at Edinboro at quarterback and threw for 261 yards and three touchdowns.

WR Ta'Nauz Gregory - Hauled in four passes for 109 yards and two touchdowns. It was the third 100-yard game for Gregory in 2018, and the ninth of his career.

RB Kyle Galyk - Returned seven kickoffs, one shy of the school record, for 198 yards. He returned a kickoff for 86 yards for an apparent touchdown, but it was called back due to a penalty. He finished with 255 yards in all-purpose yards, adding 35 yards rushing on five carries and 22 yards on 3 receptions.

Game Notes: Edinboro fell in a high-scoring affair against Slippery Rock, 59-28.

RB Craig Reynolds - Rushed for 46 yards and one touchdown. Reynolds also ended his day with 104 all-purpose yards.

DB Shawn Turber-Ortiz - Led the defensive unit with nine total tackles and an interception.

Game Notes: No. 19 Kutztown scored 41 first-half points, the most this season, and enjoyed a scoring outburst from both sides of the ball in a 41-0 win over Lock Haven Saturday afternoon.

QB Brycen Mussina - Finished 16-of-22 for 235 yards, two touchdowns, and two interceptions.
