RB Fredrick Green - Led the team in rushing with 83 yards on 16 touches, including a long of 14 yards. Caught three passes for 18 yards.

DB Dante Redwood - Accumulated eight total tackles and led the team with three pass breakups.

QB Doug Altavilla - Completed 11 passes for 57 yards while throwing four picks.

Game Notes: In a contest that spanned over two days due to weather, Mercyhurst eventually fell Sunday to California, 23-0, in a contest that began on Saturday afternoon. The Lakers were shutout for the first time since Sept. 1, 2016 (Ashland).

GANNON

Players to Watch

RB Marcus Jones - Rushed for 142 yards on 27 carries while scoring three TDs. Caught a trio of passes for 15 yards. Currently leads the PSAC in YPG and rushing yards.

QB Jason Dambach - Tossed a pair of TD's while throwing for 126 yards on 12 completions.

DB James Simms - Paced the Golden Knight defense with an interception. Simms amassed nine tackles, including one for loss.

Game Notes: Gannon gave No. 23 IUP fits while holding a 28-26 lead at halftime. The game saw multiple delays due to lightening in the area. IUP used 17 second-half points to win the contest 43-34. GU went 1-for-9 on third down.

S Deionte Wilson - Posted a career-high 13 tackles, including six solo. Turned in his second career interception.

WR Winston Eubanks - Hauled in a team-high 10 passes for 138 yards. Scored a pair of TD's in the first quarter - both for over 30 yards.

Game Notes: Shippensburg fell in a high-scoring affair to No. 15 Kutztown, 42-28. The Red Raider offense amassed 560 yards in the loss.

LOCK HAVEN

Players to Watch

RB Chantz Swartz - Rushed for 114 yards on seven touches. Averaged 16.3 yards per rush. Hauled in a trio of passes for 14 yards.

DB Dontae Mason - Paced the team with 12 tackles. Credited with .5 tackles for loss. Intercepted a pass and returned it 22 yards.

QB Cameron Tobias - Completed seven passes for 76 yards and a TD. Punted twice with both pinning Bloomsburg inside the 20.

Game Notes: Lock Haven fell at home to Bloomsburg, 33-7. The Bald Eagles were blanked through the first three quarters of play.

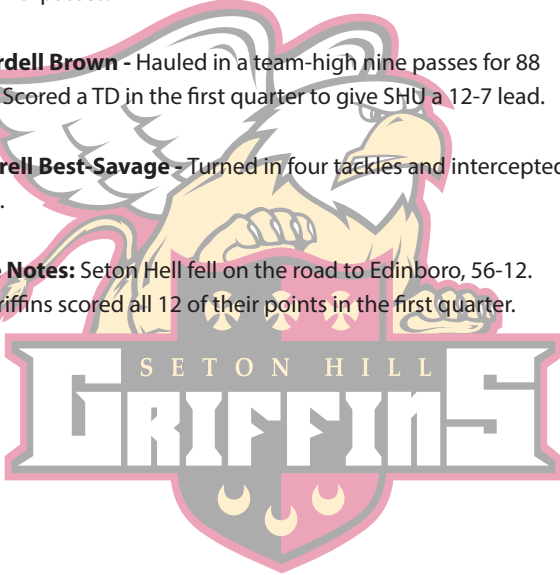
Players to Watch

DB Tyrell Best-Savage - Turned in four tackles and intercepted a pass.

Game Notes: Seton Hill fell on the road to Edinboro, 56-12. The Griffins scored all 12 of their points in the first quarter.

Players to Watch

PK Dillon Sarka - Scored a season-high 13 points, going 3-3 on field goal attempts and 4-5 on extra point attempts and extending his streak to 10 straight made field goals on the season.

QB Lenny Williams - Totaled 352 yards and four touchdowns. He finished 18-28 through the air for 232 yards and three touchdowns, and added 15 carries for 120 yards and a touchdown. Williams became the eighth player in league history to amass 100 total touchdowns (101 - 72 pass, 29 rush) on Saturday.

LB Damon Lloyd - Led the team with seven tackles, including two solo.

Game Notes: IUP outlasted Gannon, 43-34, in a contest that saw multiple weather delays. The Crimson Hawks turned in 516 yards of offense.

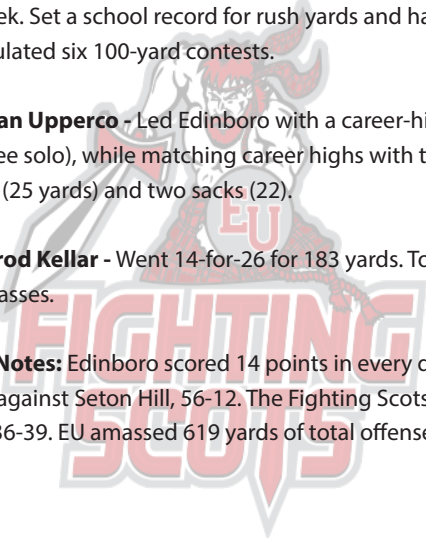
Players to Watch

RB Walter Fletcher - Put on a clinic with 328 rushing yards on 21 carries and four TDs. Named PSAC West Offensive Athlete of the Week. Set a school record for rush yards and has accumulated six 100-yard contests.

DE Ethan Upperco - Led Edinboro with a career-high 10 tackles (three solo), while matching career highs with three tackles for loss (25 yards) and two sacks (22).

QB Jarrod Kellar - Went 14-for-26 for 183 yards. Tossed a pair of TD passes.

Game Notes: Edinboro scored 14 points in every quarter in its win against Seton Hill, 56-12. The Fighting Scots outrushed SHU, 436-39. EU amassed 619 yards of total offense.

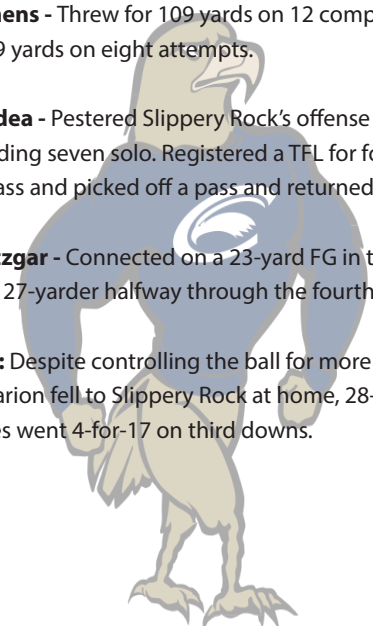
Players to Watch

RB Mark Dukes - Led all rushers with 76 yards on 17 carries and a touchdown to close the gap to 14-10 early in the second half.

Game Notes: Before a bye week last week, #12/13 West Chester completed a second-half comeback for a 17-14 victory on the road over Bloomsburg.

Players to Watch

QB Collin DiGalbo - Accumulated 504 yards of total offense and four TDs. Threw for 402 yards on 32 completions while leading the team in rushing with 102 yards.

CB Ahkee Cox-Cowan - Returned a blocked field goal for a 74-yard TD at the end of the first half to tie the contest at 21. Amassed 13 tackles with a pass breakup.

RB Craig Reynolds - Was a trick of all trades with seven receptions for 46 yards, eight rushes for 21 yards and a passing TD.

Game Notes: No. 15 Kutztown posted 21 points in the fourth quarter in an entertaining 42-28 win against Shippensburg. The Golden Bears averaged 7.3 yards per play while accumulating 531 yards on offense.

QB Roland Rivers III - Improved to 6-0 as the SRU starting QB and has now accounted for 25 touchdowns and five turnovers in six games. Rivers' three TD passes Saturday gave him 19 on the year, which ties for the ninth most in a single-season in SRU history.

Game Notes: Slippery Rock improved to 8-1 against Clarion since the "Milk Jug" trophy was introduced to the rivalry in 2010. SRU stayed in sole possession of first place in the PSAC West at 5-0 and can lock up the division title with a win next Saturday at California.

DT Malik Diggs - Made 15 tackles from his defensive tackle position in his first career start--the most by a Marauder defensive lineman in the "Statcrew Era" which dates to 2003. Diggs' 15 stops were the third-most by a PSAC player this season.
