Players to Watch

K/P Joey Farley - Accounted for all 10 of Millersville's points, making a 43-yard touchdown catch and kicking a 21-yard field goal. Farley's touchdown was the first of his career and the longest catch of his career. Farley has made seven of his last eight field goal attempts dating back to last season.

QB Justis Jacobs - Threw his first touchdown pass as a Marauder, going 6-for-10 for 55 yards. Jacobs also led the team in rushing with 24 yards.

WR Chris Dolan - Followed last week's 10-catch performance with nine catches for 97 yards.

Game Notes: Slippery Rock's defense swarmed Millersville for four quarters and The Rock's offense capitalized on five Marauder turnovers in Saturday's 57-10 win.

WEST CHESTER

Players to Watch

QB A.J. Long - Threw for 275 yards and three TDs while also rushing for 118 yards and two more score. Long was responsible for five TDs, four in the first half when WCU ran out to a 49-7 lead, and amassed 393 total yards in the game.

LB Tyler Morrissey - Led WCU with nine tackles (seven solo), 2.5 for loss, and 1.5 sacks. Named PSAC East Defensive Athlete of the Week.

WR Rasheem James - caught five passes for 78 yards, including a 21-yard scoring strike from Long.

Game Notes: West Chester put up five touchdowns in the first half to jump out to a 35-0 lead, before Seton Hill could get on the scoreboard, and never looked back.

DL Malik Bridgeman - Recorded just three tackles, but two stuffed the Kutztown for a loss, and one forced a fumble. Bridgeman provided the highlight play of the game, hauling in an interception, evading a tackle, and rumbling 20 yards for a touchdown.

RB Melvin Blanks - A true freshman, shined in his first career start Saturday against Kutztown, piling up 91 yards rushing on just 15 carries for a 6.1-yard average per rush.

QB Jimmy Keefe - Completed 26 passes on 45 attempts for 248 yards with a long of 30.

Game Notes: Gannon opened up an early lead against Kutztown. Adding the first two scores of the second half, the Golden Knights stayed in front until the Golden Bears used a fourth-quarter surge to grab the 48-33 victory.

CLARION

Players to Watch

DL Alec Heldreth - Posted 10 total tackles, 2.0 tackles for loss and a sack, and also recorded a team-high three quarterback hurries.

DL Saif Khan - Had eight stops, 3.0 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks.

QB Jovante Seard - One of three QBs to see the field this weekend, led the way at 12-of-24 for 169 yards, three touchdowns and no interceptions.

Game Notes: Clarion is coming off a 44-7 non-conference victory over Lincoln on Saturday. The 44 points were the most for Clarion since a 44-29 win over Seton Hill on Oct. 17, 2015.

DT Derek Dorr - Finished with four tackles with a pair of sacks for a loss of 16 yards. Dorr also had a fumble recovery and batted down a pass. He was a crucial part of a front-seven that held ESU's Jaymar Anderson to just 68 yards on 21 carries.

WR Ta'Nauz Gregory - Finished with career-highs for receptions (11) and yards receiving (162), with TD catches of 59 and 12 yards. Gregory threw for Edinboro's first touchdown, completing a 25-yard pass to QB Andrew Tomko on a trick play to give Edinboro a 7-0 lead. He also returned a kickoff 25 yards and had 2 punt returns for 31 yards for a total of 218 all-purpose yards.

Game Notes: Edinboro improved to 3-0 with a 49-24 win over East Stroudsburg in the home opener. The Fighting Scots finished with a season-high 569 yards, with 262 yards rushing and 307 yards passing.

CALIFORNIA

Players to Watch

RB Nelson Brown - Rushed for a career-high three touchdowns (3, 18, 43) for a season-high 132 yards this past weekend. He recorded his first 100-yard game of the year and the eighth of his career.

DB Jermal Martin, Jr. - Led the team with 10 tackles (nine solo) and registered a pair of interceptions while making his first career start on Saturday. Both interceptions came in the first half and halted Shippensburg drives inside the Cal U 10-yard line.

QB Noah Mitchell - Eclipsed 300 passing yards for the third-consecutive week, finishing with 325 passing yards on 21-of-30 attempts and three touchdowns (one rushing).

Game Notes: The Vulcans recorded five interceptions and rushed for five touchdowns on Saturday while claiming a 57-14 victory at Shippensburg.

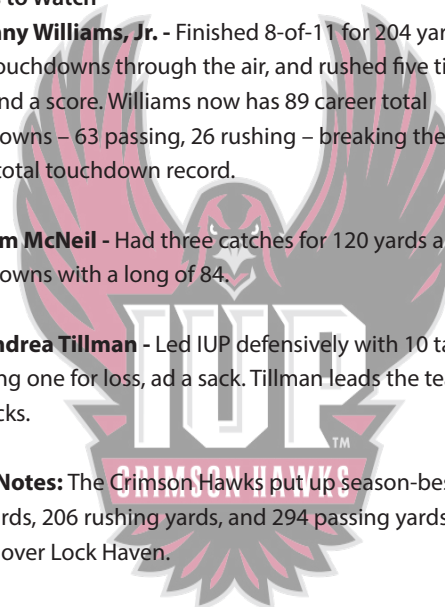
Players to Watch

WR Dom McNeil - Had three catches for 120 yards and two touchdowns with a long of 84.

DL Dondrea Tillman - Led IUP defensively with 10 tackles, including one for loss, and a sack. Tillman leads the team with four sacks.

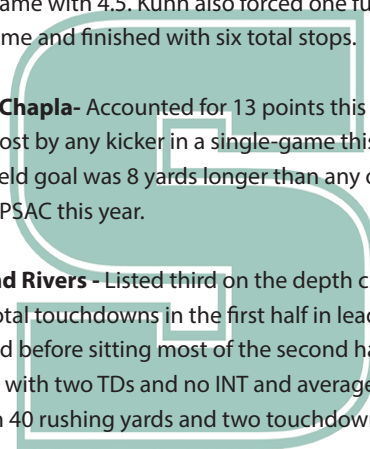
Players to Watch

K/P Jake Chapla - Accounted for 13 points this past weekend are the most by any kicker in a single game this season. His 50-yard field goal was 8 yards longer than any other successful FG in the PSAC this year.

QB Roland Rivers - Listed third on the depth chart, accounted for four total touchdowns in the first half in leading SRU out to a 42-0 lead before sitting most of the second half. He threw for 126 yards with two TDs and no INT and averaged 6.7 yards per carry with 40 rushing yards and two touchdowns on just six carries.

Game Notes: SRU won its eighth straight game over Millersville and improved to 18-4-1 all-time against MU.

TE Shea O'Donnell - Had back-to-back receptions on a third-quarter drive, the second of which resulted in the final SU touchdown of the day. O'Donnell had three receptions for 70 yards and a TD.

RB Raleigh Sirb - Averaged 4.0 yards per carry on 14 totes. He finished with 56 of SU's 92 rushing yards on the day.

Game Notes: Shippensburg could not overcome five turnovers and a strong offensive attack from the opposition on Saturday, as the Red Raiders dropped a 57-14 decision to visiting California.
