SLIPPERY ROCK

Players to Watch

QB Roland Rivers III- He completed 20-of-26 passes for 294 yards with four touchdowns and no interceptions. He also rushed for 15 yards to finish with 309 yards of total offense. Named PSAC Co-West Offensive Athlete of the Week.

WR Henry Litwin- Pulled down nine catches for 134 yards and two touchdowns to lead the receivers against Gannon.

Game Notes: Jake Chapla broke the all-time PSAC record for scoring by a kicker, Roland Rivers III broke the Slippery Rock single-season and career touchdown passing records and Slippery Rock improved to 10-0 for the first time in program history with a dominant 56-7 win at Gannon. The Rock finished with 518 total yards of offense while holding the Golden Knights to 181.

KUTZTOWN

Players to Watch

RB Darryl Davis-McNeil- Davis-McNeil gaining 88 yards on 11 carries against Millersville.

RB Abdul-Hassan Neblett- Neblett averaged 5.5 yards per carry, finishing with 83 yards on the ground. He also added four catches for 88 yards.

QB Eric Nickel- Finished with 205 yards passing, 57 yards rushing and three total touchdowns.

Game Notes: Kutztown racked up 517 yards of total offense and forced four turnovers to improve to 10-0 for the first time in 104 seasons of Golden Bear football by defeating Millersville 37-17. The Golden Bears defense held the Marauders rushing game to just 79 yards on 30 attempts.

Players to Watch

S Brandon Anderson- Led Edinboro defense with 7 tackles and a fumble recovery against IUP.

RB Alvin Lara- Rushed for a game-high 58 yards on 17 carries, both career highs.

Game Notes: Edinboro drops to IUP, 35-6 after posting only two field goals by Vicente Arriagada. Statistically, the game was very even. IUP would outgain Edinboro by 277 yards to 258. Arriagada continues to excel as Edinboro's placekicker. Against IUP, he tied the programs season record for field goals in a season. He has made good on 15-of-18 attempts.

BLOOMSBURG

Players to Watch

WR Michael Allen- Allen finished with eight catches for 132 yards and two scores against Shepherd.

RB Khalil Nelson- Nelson had 44 yards rushing on 13 carries.

Game Notes: Bloomsburg went toe-to-toe with Shepherd, but fell short in the fourth 42-35. Up by one with 11:15 left in the fourth, the Huskies would not be able to hold onto the lead. Shepherd went on to score twice to seal the win. The Huskies finished with 298 yards of total offense, with 207 of those coming through the air. Shepherd would post 336 passing yards and 140 yards on the ground.

RB Garrett Owens- Rushed for 192 yards and three touchdowns against Clarion. Owens would add 26 yards receiving. Named PSAC Co-West Offensive Athlete of the Week.

LB Jacob Holl- Holl picked up six tackles as well as his fumble return touchdown.

Game Notes: The Mercyhurst offense rushed for over 300 yards and the Laker defense forced five turnovers as Mercyhurst cruised to a 57-10 victory over host Clarion. The Lakers finished with 145 passing yards and 345 on the ground. Clarion posted 268 in the air with just 43 rushing.

MILLERSVILLE

Players to Watch

DB Christian Martir- Led the team with 17 stops and two passes broken up against Kutztown.

WR Evan Morrill- Morrill finished with five catches for 53 yards.

Game Notes: Kutztown, the top-ranked team in Super Region 1 remained undefeated at 10-0 while Millersville dropped to 2-8 with a 37-17 decision. QB Collin Shank went 3-for-3 for 68 yards but for the fifth time in 10 games, he missed the majority of the game because of injury. The offense managed just 37 passing yards after Shank's exit and finished with 184 yards on 53 plays. Kutztown totaled 517 yards on 88 plays.

Game Notes: A late push by the Griffins would not be enough to overcome the 21-0 deficit going into the fourth quarter against Cal U. The Vulcans would earn the 28-14 victory after posting 334 total yards of offense, outgaining the Griffins who registered 231.

RB Deonte Glover- Glover rushed 19 times for 135 yards and five touchdowns in the win over Bloomsburg. Named PSAC East Offensive Athlete of the Week.

QB Tyson Bagent- Bagent completed 30-of-39 passes for 336 yards and a score.

Game Notes: Behind the running game of Deonte Glover, Shepherd defeats Bloomsburg 42-35. Shepherd amassed 476 yards of total offense. Bloomsburg had 298 total yards.

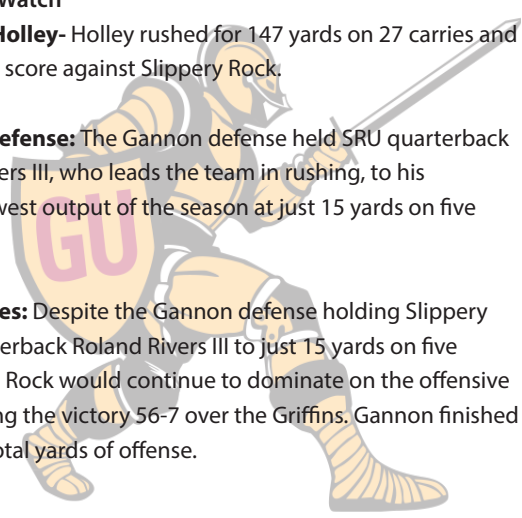

RB Zevin Holley- Holley rushed for 147 yards on 27 carries and added one score against Slippery Rock.

Gannon Defense: The Gannon defense held SRU quarterback Roland Rivers III, who leads the team in rushing, to his second-lowest output of the season at just 15 yards on five carries.

Game Notes: Despite the Gannon defense holding Slippery Rock quarterback Roland Rivers III to just 15 yards on five carries, the Rock would continue to dominate on the offensive end, earning the victory 56-7 over the Griffins. Gannon finished with 181 total yards of offense.

Players to Watch

QB Kyle Knight- Knight ran for 166 yards on 23 carries and he also hauled in a touchdown catch. He was 10 of 24 passing (2 INTs) for 79 yards.

RB Dante Graham- He racked up 104 yards on 25 carries.

Game Notes: Quarterback Kyle Knight and running back Dante Graham combined for 270 yards to lead the way for the Lock Haven but the strong individual offensive outings were not enough as West Chester won, 56-14.

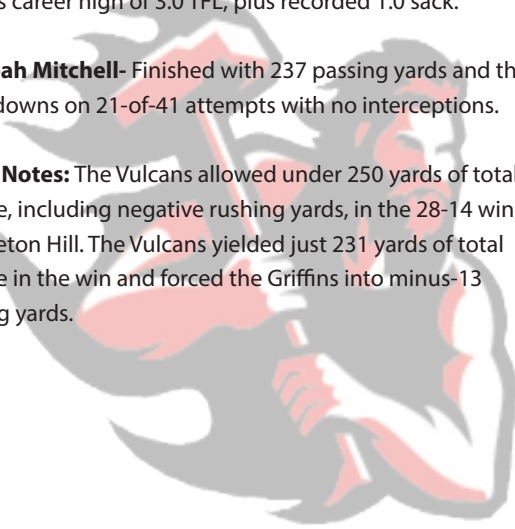

QB Noah Mitchell- Finished with 237 passing yards and three touchdowns on 21-of-41 attempts with no interceptions.

Game Notes: The Vulcans allowed under 250 yards of total offense, including negative rushing yards, in the 28-14 win over Seton Hill. The Vulcans yielded just 231 yards of total offense in the win and forced the Griffins into minus-13 rushing yards.

QB Paul Dooley- Completed 17-of-24 passes and accounted for four touchdowns against Lock Haven.

WR Lex Rosario- Led the Golden Rams with 98 receiving yards on five catches.

Game Notes: The Golden Rams would post 304 passing yards and 213 rushing yards to defeat the Bald Eagles 56-14. Despite Lock Haven's Kyle Knight and Dante Grahams combined 270-yard run-game, West Chester would remain unstoppable on the offensive boards. The Golden Rams would go into the half with a 35-0 lead and continued their scoring drives in the second half to put the game out of reach for the Bald Eagles.

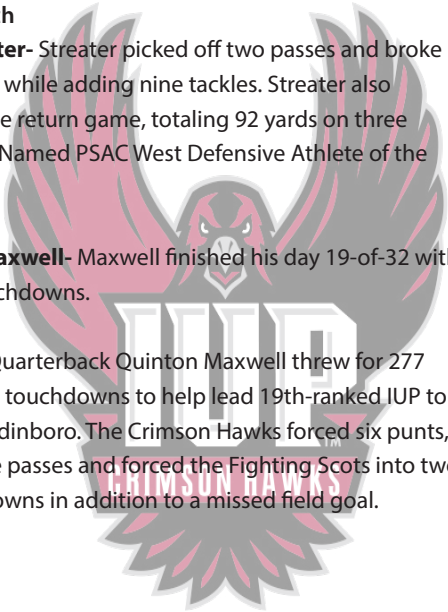

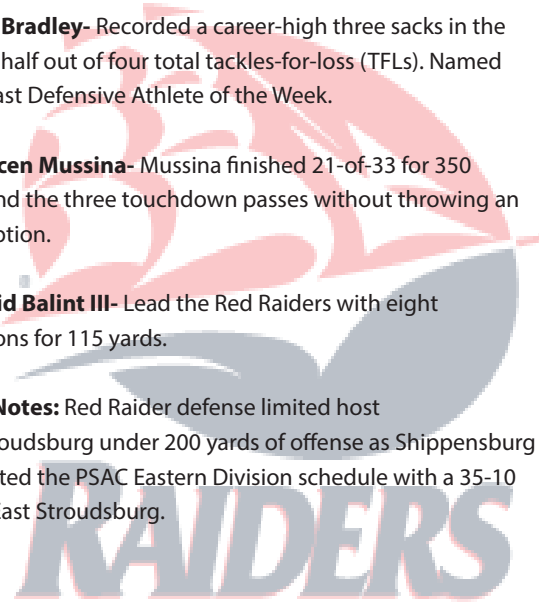
Players to Watch

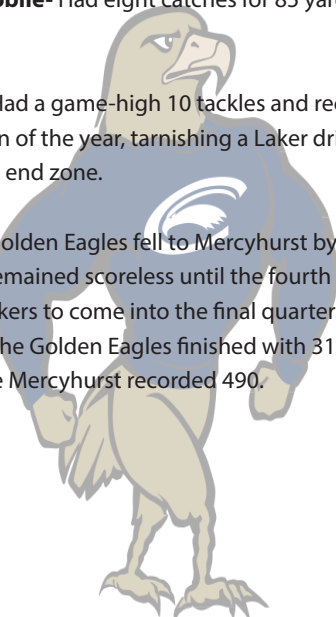

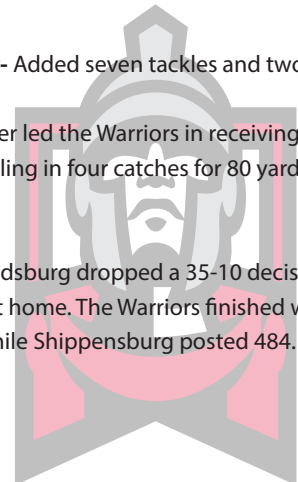
