Notes/Clarifications Shepherd went 9-3 overall and tied for second place in the PSAC East with a 5-2 conference mark in 2022. The Rams lost an All-American in quarterback Seth Morgan and return one in return specialist Miles Greer. Greer ranked fourth nationally in punt returns with a 16.9 average last season. The Rams return their top tacklers in senior linebacker Harold O'Neal (37 solos, 34 assists for 71 total tackles) and junior linebacker JT Kouame-Yao (36 solos, 35 assists for 71 total tackles). Shepherd ranked third nationally in kickoff returns with a 26.79 average and ninth in punt returns (16.32) in 2023.

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COACHING STAFF NOTES

• ESU enters its 5th season under head coach and former Warrior standout **Jimmy Terwilliger '07**. Terwilliger, a record-setting QB was 2005 Harlon Hill Trophy winner as top DII player has led ESU to a 25-22 record, including the program's first NCAA Playoff berth since 2009 in 2023. Under his guidance, the Warriors have garnered 28 All-PSAC East selections and three players have earned All-America status.

• Jimmy's father, Offensive Coordinator **Mike Terwilliger '78**, enters his 46th season as an assistant coach and 50th consecutive season with the program. Terwilliger was the starting quarterback during legendary head coach Denny Douds' first four seasons as Warrior head coach from 1974-78. He has served as ESU's quarterbacks coach and offensive coordinator (2001-present) on the coaching staff since graduation.

• Defensive Coordinator Mike Lackey enters his fifth season leading a revamped defense. In three seasons, Lackey has overseen 13 All-PSAC East selections and a first team All-American in Deshaun McCarthy in 2021.

• Offensive line coach and recruiting coordinator **Mike Santella** (ESU '94) enters his 26th season at ESU and 23rd as the full-time offensive line coach (since 2001). Santella has coached players who have combined for 27 All-PSAC selections and had at least one All-PSAC offensive lineman in 20 of his 23 seasons overseeing the O-Line.

The 2024 season will mark the third for the Bald Eagles under head coach Dan Mulrooney.

In his second season at The Haven (2023), Mulrooney led the Bald Eagles on a remarkable turnaround, as Lock Haven finished the season with five wins, marking the first five-win season since 1982. Lock Haven ended the 2023 season with a 5-6 overall record and finished PSAC Eastern Division play with a 3-4 record with wins over Millersville, Bloomsburg and Shippensburg. The Haven entered this season coming off back-to-back one-win seasons, and the Bald Eagles had won a combined four games in the previous three seasons prior to this fall.

ROAD WARRIORS

En route to their historic season, 2023 Bald Eagles overcame a 1-4 home record by racking up four wins on the road, to finish an impressive 4-1 away from Hubert Jack Stradium. The four road victories was more than the previous five seasons combined.

The Bald Eagles averaged 26 points per game on the road last season, including scoring a season-high 38 points in a convincing victory over Millersville in late September.

BACK FOR MORE

The Bald Eagles return one of their top weapons in dynamic receiver T'iar Young. Young had a monster season in 2023 and finished with 663 yards and six touchdowns on 31 receptions, all team-highs. Young also provided a deep threat for The Haven and hauled in a season-long reception of 79 yards, while averaging 60.27 yards per game.

Returning to action after missing the bulk of the 2023 season is fifth-year senior Maquon Williams. In 2022, Williams recorded 600 yards receiving and hauled in seven TDs. He ranked among the top-12 in the PSAC in total receiving yards and receiving yards per game. Tight end Chris Hicks also returns after setting career-highs in touchdowns (two) and receiving yards (313).

Headlining the defense is All-PSAC East Second Teamer Kasir Henry. The defensive back finished the season with 53 tackles (40 solo), an interception, and two breakups.

The Bald Eagles, who ranked second in the conference in sacks in 2023, also return Justin Anderson to the defensive line, after racking up seven sacks for 41 yards to rank second on the team. Linebacker Izzy Ramos returns and was one of nine players to rack up over 30 total tackles (31), while also finishing with 1.5 sacks, one forced fumble/recovery and one interception.

ON THE HORIZON

Lock Haven will open the 2024 season on the road on Saturday, Sept. 7 at Glenville State University (Glenville, W.Va.). It marks the second meeting between the two schools since 2008.

The Week-1 home game is one of six road games for the Bald Eagles in 2024. Lock Haven will hit the road for PSAC contests at Shepherd, Kutztown, East Stroudsburg, West Chester and Gannon. The Bald Eagles kick off a three-game home stand on Sept. 14 when they welp PSAC powerhouse IUP to Hubert Jack Stadium. The Haven will also host Cal (Pa.), Millersville, Bloomsburg and Shippensburg at home this year. The Week-4 matchup at home against Millersville is Lock Haven's 2024 Homecoming Weekend and is set for Saturday, Sept. 28.

BRIGHT LIGHTS

The Bald Eagles will host a pair of night games in 2024, including the home opener against IUP on Sept. 14 (6 p.m.) and the Hall of Fame Game on Oct. 19 when Bloomsburg comes to town (6 p.m.).

BRIGHT FUTURE

On Feb. 7 head coach Dan Mulrooney and the Lock Haven football team announced a talented and impact-ready 42 person signing class as part of 2024 National Signing Day. The initial class featured 35 incoming freshmen and seven transfers. The seven transfers consist of six graduate students and one junior. During the second signing period, Mulrooney announced the addition of 14 transfer athletes to round out the group of talented newcomers.

BALD EAGLES IN THE PROS

The National Football League's (NFL) Baltimore Ravens signed standout running back Chris Collier following the 2024 NFL draft.

Collier is the first known Bald Eagle signed to an NFL roster since Karri Kuuttila signed with the St. Louis Rams in 2011.

Collier's postseason accolades include: D2football.com Elite 100, First Team AFCA DII All-American, Don Hansen All-American HM, Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) Offensive Player of the Year, First Team All-PSAC East selection and Second Team D2CCA All-Region honoree and First Team AFCA All-American.

Collier, who led the PSAC is total rushing yards (1,393), rushing yards-per-game (126.6) and ranked second in rushing touchdowns (12), helped lead the Bald Eagles to their first five-win season since 1982.

In the process, he became Lock Haven's first 1,000-yard rusher since 1981, while his 1,393 rushing yards broke the Lock Haven single-season record set by Lock Haven Hall of Famer Joe Speese's in 1979.

TEAM NOTES

- After a promising 3-1 start that included the program's first win over West Chester in 21 years, Millersville closed the 2023 season on a seven-game skid that included four one-score losses. In 2023, Millersville was tied with nationally ranked Shepherd at the half, lost by five against eventual PSAC champion Kutztown and started the fourth quarter with a lead in a three-point loss to Bloomsburg. Millersville enters 2024 having lost four of its five All-PSAC East performers from the 2023 team and returns just six offensive and four defensive starters. The lone All-PSAC East returnee is running back Jaheim Morris, who was a first-team selection despite missing three full games.

- Jaheim Morris is the engine to Millersville's offense. In 2022, he was named All-PSAC East Second Team with 822 yards and seven rushing touchdowns for the most yards by a Marauder since 2013 and the most touchdowns since 2010. Last season, Morris became the first Marauder running back since 2000 to be named named All-PSAC East in back-to-back seasons. He tied a school record with a 93-yard run and totaled 229 yards against Shepherd in addition to 177 against West Chester. Over the last three seasons, Millersville is 3-1 when Morris rushes for 100 yards and 7-4 when he scores a touchdown. Morris enters the season 11 carries shy of becoming the 11th back in school history with 400 carries. He needs 269 yards to become the second Marauder with 2000 with 2,000 rushing yards, and he is five rushing touchdowns outside of the all-time top 10.
- Quarterback Robert Footman has had back-to-back seasons hampered by an injury, and the junior now has 12 games of experience under his belt since 2022. In the first five games of the 2023 season he accounted for 12 touchdowns and just two interceptions, but after a career-high 329 yards vs. Lock Haven, he completed just 36 passes and one touchdown over the final six weeks. He's won six of his 11 games as Millersville's primary quarterback, throwing nine touchdown passes to three picks in those wins.
- Millersville's defense lost seven of its eight leading tacklers, but Hez Faison is primed to be the next Marauder linebacker to earn All-PSAC East honors. Millersville has produced nine All-PSAC East linebackers since 2016, including four the last two seasons. Faison ranked second on the team with 10 TFL in 2023.
- In the secondary, Millersville lost three starting safeties but returns its top two corners in Gus Ross and Imir Lilliston. Ross was limited to five games in 2023, but Millersville is 8-4 in games that he has played the last two seasons. Lilliston also missed five weeks in 2023 after starting 20 games in 2021-22. He's broken up 11 passes in his last 17 games.
- Despite losing All-PSAC East punter Zach Banta, Millersville special teams are in solid shape with the return of kicker Trent McDowell and kick returner Hakim Melvin. McDowell went 8 for 11 on field goals, hitting the longest in school history with a 52-yarder vs. Seton Hill. Melvin was the only player in the PSAC with two kickoff returns for touchdown. He was the first player in school history to score a receiving, rushing and kick return TD in the same season. He did that damage while returning kicks in just five of the 11 games. He averaged 27.3 yards per return.

QUICK NOTES

- Bloomsburg finished the year 3-8 in 2023 in head coach Frank Sheptock's fourth season at the helm. The Huskies defeated Clarion 21-7 on the road for the first win of the season and then put together back-to-back wins over Shepherd (14-10) and Millersville (34-31) at the end of the year.

- The Huskies return a pair of all-PSAC players in senior linebacker Tom Goetz and senior defensive lineman Giovanni Cancro. Cancro earned his first career postseason honor as a second-team defensive lineman. The Pequannock, N.J. native had a breakout year for the Huskies with 29 total tackles this year, including 15 solo stops. He had 5.0 tackles for a loss of 22 yards and broke up two passes. Cancro finished with one quarterback hurry and a blocked kick. Goetz had an exceptional comeback season for the Huskies in 2023 after playing in just four games before a season-ending injury in 2022. Goetz had a career-best 76 tackles, 9.5 tackles for loss (34 yards), and 4.5 sacks (23 yards). The Wenonah, N.J. native had a pair of interceptions and three pass breakups for the year. Both of his INTs came against Clarion – one that was recovered for a touchdown and the second to seal the win for the Huskies late in the fourth quarter. He led the team in tackles for loss and sacks.

- The Bloomsburg offensive line returns a talented group of veterans that know how to protect their QB. The Huskies allowed the fewest sacks in the PSAC last year - giving up just 11 in 11 games for 76 yards. In conference play, teams had just 10 sacks against the Huskies in seven games. The run game ran for 122.5 yards on 359 carries and had 15 rushing touchdowns.

- Bloomsburg returns eight of its top-10 tacklers for the 2024 season, including team-leader Ryan D'Ambra. The senior linebacker had 90 tackles in 2023, including 5.0 tackles for loss and 2.0 sacks. He added four broken up passes and four quarterback hurries to his resume. For his career, D'Ambra has 160 tackles and six passes defended.

- Ben Ries returns to lead the Huskies' offense that will be under new OC, Tim Landis. Ries threw for 747 yards and went 68-125-3 with one touchdown last year in the final eight games of the season. He went 14-for-26 with 168 yards and 2 INTs in the Huskies 14-10 win over Shepherd. Ries also ran for 97 yards on the year on 47 attempts and had two touchdowns on the ground.
