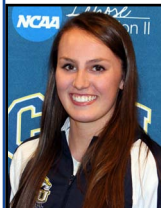

Was named RMAC Offensive Player of the Week (October 28) and CCU Athletics Breakout Athlete of the Year. In her freshman season in 2012, Sturms was AVCA Third Team All-America, AVCA South-Central Region Freshman of the Year, AVCA South-Central Region Team and RMAC Freshman of the Year. In 2013 & 2012 she was named to the RMAC Volleyball All-Tournament team.
