

Chris Bonner, CSU-Pueblo Quarterback Senior, 6-7, 225 San Diego, Calif./Grossmont JC

Being touted as a Harlon Hill Award candidate after being named RMAC Offensive Player of the Year in 2013 and helping the

Pack to the conference championship.. Bonner is on the Beyond Sports Network (BSN) Preseason Division II All-American team. Last season he had 3413 yeards with 33 touchdowns against just nine interceptions. The first-team All-RMAC selection had a QB efficiency rating of 161.1, completing 225 of 274 attempts for a 60.2 percentage.

PRESEASON DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR



Darius Allen, CSU-Pueblo Defensive End Senior, 6-3, 239 Pueblo, Colo./Pueblo East HS

Allen won the prestigious Gene Upshaw Award as the top lineman (offensive or defensive) in NCAA Division II. He was

also named National Defensive Player of the Year by Don Hansen's Football Gazette, and First Team All-America after leading Dll in sacks with 15.5, setting the new CSU-Pueblo single season record. He also had 26.5 tackles for loss, another school record and good for top 10 in the country. Is a preseason All-America pick for BSN, Sporting News and Lindy's.

Preseason Special Teams Player of the Year



Avery Llewellyn, Colorado Mines Kicker/Punter Junior, 6-4, 180 Durango, Colo./Durango HS

Named RMAC Special Teams Player of the Year in 2013 after serving double duty as the Orediggers starting kicker and punter.

He led the RMAC in field goals made with 14, scoring 86 total points. His longest field goal of the season was 50 yards and he booted 34 kickoffs for touchbacks. As a punter, Llewellyn averaged 44.2 yards per punt. He is on the Fred Mitchell watch list, which goes to the top small college kicker (DII, DIII, Division FCS, NAIA and NJCAA).
