METH, MONTCLAIR STATE SWEEP SKYLINE ALL-CONFERENCE MEN'S LACROSSE HONORS

New York, NY – Senior Tyler Meth of Montclair State has been named the 2012 Skyline Conference Men's Lacrosse Player of the Year in voting conducted by the league's seven head coaches.

In addition, the coaches selected John Barney of Montclair State as Rookie of the Year and his coach, Chris Kivlen, as Coach of the Year. The Team Sportsmanship Award was earned by Mount Saint Mary.

Meth, an attackman from Basking Ridge, NJ, enjoyed a stellar regular season, leading the Red Hawks to a 9-5 record, including a perfect 6-0 in league play and the Skyline regular season crown. The All-American North/South Game nominee joins the Skyline All-Conference first team for the 4th time, and is a two-time league tournament MVP, an honor he hopes to earn again this weekend. Meth leads the league in goals per game (2.86), while shooting 43% in league games, and is 3rd in the league in points per game (4.0), while spearheading an offense that scored 16.8 goals in Skyline play.

Barney, a freshman midfielder from Ridgewood, NJ, has had a superb rookie season, helping lead the Red Hawks to the top seed in the Skyline Tournament. He has scored 12 goals and added 15 assists, including 6 goals and 10 assists in conference play.

Kivlen has guided Montclair State to an outstanding season, and hopes to lead it all the way to the NCAA Division III Tournament. In his initial season as a head coach after six seasons as an assistant at the University of Albany, his alma mater, Kivlen has watched his team gel, currently riding an 8-game winning streak.

The 2012 All-Conference First Team consists of attackmen Meth and teammate Jack Skeels, Kean's Richard Cheifitz, and Farmingdale State's Ryan Oswald; midfielders Barney, Nick Angrisani of Kean, and Tim Caden of Farmingdale State; specialty midfielders Jonathan Foss of Kean and Eugene Isola of Richard Stockton; long-stick midfielder Sean Gilmore of Montclair State; defenders Joe Ciaravino of Farmingdale State, Mike Lade of Montclair State, and Zach Williams of Kean; and goalkeeper Mark Glander of Montclair State.
