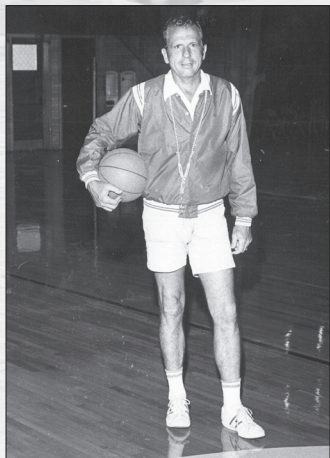


Throughout the 2012-13 season, the Southland Conference announced all-decade teams for the five decades the league has played men's basketball.

To best assess the candidate pool for the all-decade team, the Southland Conference developed a metric that analyzed numerous elements of a

student-athlete's performance and value within the league at the time. Most notably, the conference honored "real-time" factors such as all-conference selection by coaches and a player's statistical performance among his peers at the time.

Further, other components of selection including a player's effort toward helping his team win a championship or finish near the top of the conference, whether he earned individual honors from the league, if he participated in postseason tournaments, and if he was drafted by the NBA or ABA at the time.

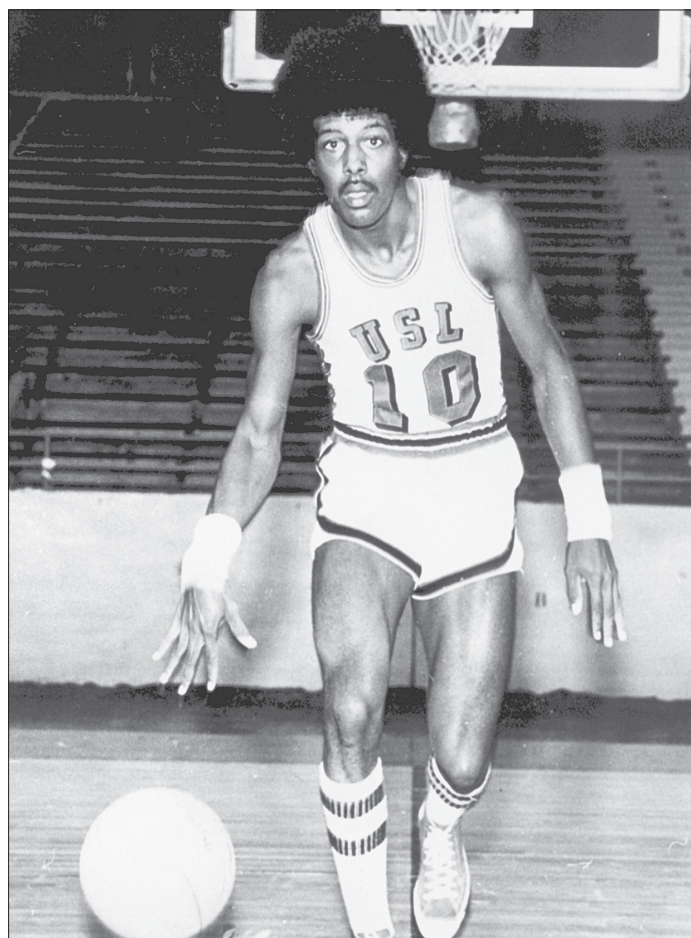
