Southland Quick Hits

- Abilene Christian rallied from a 14-point deficit to defeat FBS foe Troy, 38-35. It was the first win over an FBS opponent for ACU since 1959 and the 21st Southland team to defeat an FBS team since 2000
- Northwestern State quarterback Zach Adkins completed 19 consecutive passes against Southern, setting a school record. He finished the game 30-for-35 (85.7 percent)
- Lamar is only one of seven Division I schools to score at least 70 points this season. After giving up 73 against Texas A&M, the Cardinals responded by scoring 73 against Texas College

Week Three News & Notes

Abilene Christian and UIW Open Conference Play: Abilene Christian will welcome former Lone Star Conference rival UIW to Shotwell Stadium for the first matchup between the two schools as Southland members. This will mark the first league game of the year for the conference and will be the opening game of the 2014 SLCTV broadcast package. Kickoff is set for 3 p.m., CT. Last season, the two schools split the season series with the Wildcats winning 40-6 in Abilene and the Cardinals taking a 38-31 decision in San Antonio.

Adkins Named to the College Sports News All-Stars Weekly Team: After threatening two NCAA FCS passing accuracy records Saturday night to spearhead a 51-27 win against in-state rival, Northwestern State senior quarterback Zach Adkins was among five players named College Sporting News All-Stars among the nation's FCS ranks Monday for remarkable performances in last week's football games. Adkins completed 30 of 35 passes, including a school-record 19 in a row, and had four touchdown throws as the Demons raced to a 48-7 lead less than four minutes into the second half. His 30 of 35 aim (85.7 percent) was close to the NCAA FCS record for completion percentage.

Abilene Christian Defeats FBS Program for First Time in 55 Years: Abilene Christian twice rallied from 14-point deficits and used a 27-yard field goal from Nic Grau to stun Troy University 38-35 in Veterans Memorial Stadium, its first victory over an FBS-level opponent in 55 years. The Wildcats' last win over a team that was at the time playing at the highest level of college football and is currently an FBS member was Nov. 14, 1959, when the Wildcats went to El Paso and knocked off UTEP, 28-22, at the Sun Bowl. The Wildcats trailed 28-14 midway through the third quarter before they were able to post 24 straight points and come away with the win. Sophomore quarterback Parker McKenzie completed 73.5 percent of his passes (25 of 34) while throwing for 312 yards and two scores. ACU is the 21st Southland team to beat an FBS opponent since 2000.

Southland Has Three Ranked Teams in National Polls: The Southland Conference has three teams ranked in both major FCS Polls. Defending Southland Conference champion Southeastern Louisiana remained the league's top-ranked team, coming in at No. 3 in the Sports Network poll and No. 4 the FCS Coaches' Poll.

- McNeese State is No. 6 in both polls after picking up its first win of the season with a 48-16 showing against Prairie View A&M
- Sam Houston State dropped to No. 25 in both polls after having its 23-home game winning streak snapped against Division II power Colorado State-Pueblo.
- Central Arkansas received votes in both polls while Abilene Christian and Stephen F. Austin each picked up votes the Sports Network Poll.

Returning the Favor: Lamar is only one of seven Division I schools to score at least 70 points this season. Of the seven schools, only three compete at the FCS level (Lamar, Southeast Missouri State and Murray State). Lamar is the only Division I school to respond to giving up 73 points by scoring the same amount the following week when it blanked Texas College, 73-0.

Southland Pioneers Instant Replay for FCS Conferences: The Southland Conference and DVSPORT, Inc., the leader in collegiate football high-definition (HD) replay technology, have partnered to provide the league and its 11 football-playing institutions with the cutting-edge technology and efficient workflow of DVSPORT's HD Replay™ system beginning with the 2014 season. The Southland Conference is the first NCAA Football Championship Subdivision league to implement a full-time instant replay solution for all home games, regardless of television coverage.

Thirteen Southland Games Scheduled vs. FBS in 2014: For the fourth consecutive year, a Southland team defeated an FBS program when Abilene Christian upset Troy 38-35 on Sept. 13. The Wildcats rallied from a 14-point second-half deficit to defeat the Trojans and pick up their first win over an FBS program in 55 years. In 12 games so far, the Southland is 1-10 against the FBS with three of the losses coming by seven points or less. Sam Houston Has Its 23-Game Home Win Streak Snapped: After opening up the home season with a win, the Bearkats' had its 23-game home winning streak snapped in a 47-21 loss to Division II power Colorado State-Pueblo. The Bearkats' streak, which dated back to 2010, is tied with Northern Iowa (1983-87) for the 11th-longest home winning streak in FCS history. Georgia Southern holds the record when it won 39 in a row from 1997-2001.

Southland TV Entering Seventh Season: The league's award-winning syndicated network will broadcast 10 games in 2014, all set to air on over 25 affiliates. While most are in the Southland's footprint of Arkansas, Louisiana and Texas, SLCTV is also carried by stations in Colorado, Florida, Kansas and Oklahoma, and available nationally via ESPN3 and ESPN GamePlan. In addition, ESPN3 will have exclusive coverage of several Southland match-ups. Southland teams are also set to appear on ESPN, ESPNU, SEC Network, Fox Sports Southwest and the American Sports Network this fall. Football Grows to 11 Teams in 2014: With the additions of Abilene Christian, Houston Baptist and UIW, the Southland Conference will feature 11 football teams in 2014: ACU, Central Arkansas, HBU, UIW, Lamar, McNeese State, Nicholls, Northwestern State, Sam Houston State, Southeastern Louisiana and Stephen F. Austin. It marks the highest number of football-playing schools in the conference's 51-year history. Abilene Christian and UIW will not be eligible to win a Southland Conference championship during their transition periods. Pending NCAA approval, they will become fully eligible for the 2017 football season.

Battle of Piney Woods Returns to Houston for Fifth Time: The Battle of the Piney Woods between Sam Houston and Stephen F. Austin returns to NRG Stadium in Houston, Texas, in 2014 for the fifth consecutive season. It will be the 89th football duel between the two rivals. The series is the second oldest FCS rivalry in Texas. The Battle of the Piney Woods dates back to 1923, with Sam Houston State holding a 51-35-2 edge in the series.

Frisco Will Host FCS Title Game through 2015 Season: Prior to the 2013 Division I Football Championship Game, the NCAA agreed to a three-year extension with Frisco, Texas, for title game to be held at Toyota Stadium and hosted by the Southland Conference, the city of Frisco and the Hunt Sports Group. Frisco has hosted the last four FCS title games, the last three of which have been sellouts. The extension will keep the championship game in Frisco through the 2015 season.

About the Football Championship Subdivision: There are 124 teams within 13 conferences competing in the NCAA Division I FCS. The championship bracket consists of 24 teams, 11 of which are selected via automatic qualification. The remaining 13 at-large teams are selected by the Division I Football Championship Committee, assisted by four regional advisory committees that serve in an advisory capacity only. At-large selections are based on multiple factors including overall record and strength of schedule. The championship is conducted via single elimination format. All preliminary-round games (first round, second round, quarterfinals and semifinals) are hosted on campus sites. Sites are selected and announced during the selection show and as teams advance throughout the championship. The remaining teams will be selected on an at-large basis. The top eight teams in the bracket will be seeded and receive a first-round bye.
