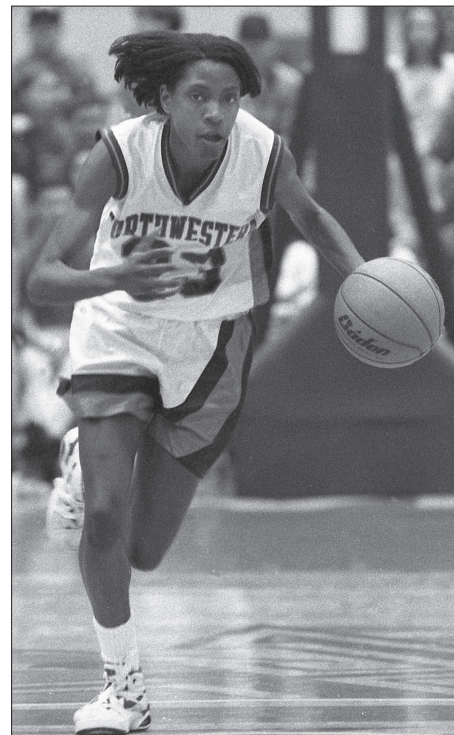

Throughout the 2012-13 season, the Southland Conference announced all-decade teams for the three decades the league has played women's basketball.

To best assess the candidate pool for the all-decade team, the Southland Conference developed a metric that analyzed numerous elements of a student-athlete's performance and value within the league at the time. Most notably, the conference honored "real-

time" factors such as all-conference selection by coaches and a player's statistical performance among his peers at the time.

Further, other components of selection including a player's effort toward helping her team win a championship or finish near the top of the conference, whether she earned individual honors from the league, if she participated in postseason tournaments.
