The Sun Belt Conference: Together We Rise

- A record six Sun Belt teams went to bowl games last season, breaking the previous record of four set in 2012 and 2015. The four bowl wins were the most ever by the Sun Belt in its league history.
- The Sun Belt's .667 winning percentage in bowl games fell one win shy of claiming a win in ESPN's "Conference Bowl Challenge" among all 10 FBS conferences, and percentage-wise finished tied with the Big 12 Conference for the second spot. It was the best bowl winning percentage among the "Group of Five" conferences.
- The Sun Belt finished third in the annual "Group of Five" conference rankings in 2016 after finishing fifth the past two seasons.
- The College Football Playoff distributed \$50 million to the "Group of Five" conferences to be split evenly amongst the leagues, with the other \$35 million distributed based on regular season and post season performance. The Sun Belt's third-place finish resulted in an extra \$3 million to be distributed evenly among its membership.
- The Sun Belt will add a significant boost to its officiating program this year as it was recently announced that the conference will use a collaborative replay system. The system will allow officials in a central location to review replays and assist officials at each game.
- The Sun Belt will determine its football conference champion with a championship game for the first time in league history beginning with the 2018 season. The game will be played between the winners of the East and West divisions at the home stadium of the divisional winner with the best ranking in the College Football Playoff poll. If there is not a team ranked in the CFP Poll, the average computer ranking of the six computer polls that made up the BCS system will be used to determine the site.

Brandon Silvers, Troy (Sr., QB)

Used his arm and his legs to lead Troy to a big road victory at New Mexico State. Combined for 335 yards of total offense with 286 through the air and 49 on the ground. Sealed Troy's victory with a 32-yard touchdown as he kept on an option read as NMSU crashed the middle on Jordan Chunn on fourth-and-1 and he went around right end.



**Defensive
Player of the Week
(Sept. 18)**

Anthony Flory, Appalachian State (Jr., LB)

Flory set career highs with nine tackles (six solo) and 2.0 sacks (-9 yards) in the conference-opening win at Texas State. - He was also credited with a pair of QB hurries. - Flory helped App State limit the Bobcats to 13 points and contributed to a Mountaineer defense that clamped down to allow only six points in four Texas State trips to the red zone.



**Special Teams
Player of the Week

Gus Nave, South Alabama (Fr., DB)

Nave returned a blocked field goal 83 yards for the Jags' first touchdown of the night, sparking a stretch late in the first quarter in which South scored 21 points in less than three minutes to break open the game. He later added his first career interception and chipped in a career-high-tying three tackles on defense to help USA record its first shutout since Oct. 16, 2010, and the program's largest margin of victory ever against an NCAA Division I opponent while giving up just 172 total yards.

Sun Belt Membership

Appalachian State, Arkansas State, Coastal Carolina, Georgia Southern, Georgia State, Louisiana, ULM, South Alabama, Texas State and Troy give the league 10 full-time members that compete in football. Little Rock and UTA compete as Sun Belt members in all sports other than football. Idaho and New Mexico State compete only in the sport of football.

Sun Belt Bowl Partners

In 2001, the Sun Belt Conference began sponsoring football and created the inaugural New Orleans bowl in December of that year. The conference now stands as one of the 10 premier college football leagues in the country.

As part of the College Football Playoff a worthy football team in the Sun Belt can be in the national championship picture, and the league is a permanent part of the "Group of Five" conferences (joining the American Athletic Conference, the Mountain West Conference, the Mid-American Conference and Conference USA) that sends its highest-rated champion to a premier January 1st bowl game.

In the last four years the Sun Belt Conference has gone from having two primary bowl partnerships to five in 2017. From 2001 to 2009 the Sun Belt Conference had only one bowl partner.

Sun Belt Conference Championship Game

The Sun Belt Conference will hold its first ever football championship game as the league's presidents and chancellors, as well as athletic directors, voted unanimously to play the game beginning in 2018. The addition of Coastal Carolina and the decision to move forward as a 10-team football league, along with the NCAA Division I Council's rules on championship games, means that the championship game has become a reality.

Sun Belt Athletes are Student-Athletes

During the recent 2016-17 academic year, Sun Belt member institutions awarded over \$50 million in scholarships to more than 3,100 student-athletes, while also providing life experiences such as team building, domestic and foreign travel, community service, mentoring and recognition through honors and awards. The commitment to education recently led to over 2,100 Sun Belt Conference student-athletes being named to the 2016-17 Commissioner's List and Academic Honor Roll. The list is comprised of 1,087 student-athletes on the Commissioner's List (3.5 grade point average or better) and 1,045 student-athletes on the Academic Honor Roll (GPA between 3.0 and 3.49).

- App State quarterback Taylor Lamb threw for 167 yards in the 20-13 win at Texas State, and freshman receivers accounted for 148 of the yards. True freshman Thomas Hennigan had 57 yards on a team-high six catches, including his first career touchdown, and true freshman Malik Williams had four catches for a team-high 68 yards. They accounted for three of the Mountaineers' four third-down conversions, and redshirt freshman Jalen Virgil had 23 receiving yards on two receptions. Lamb threw the 69th touchdown pass of his App State career, putting him five away from tying Armanti Edwards for the school record.

- Texas State finished with a 7:02 advantage in possession time. It was the biggest negative discrepancy for the Mountaineers since they won 34-27 at South Alabama in 2015 despite having the ball for 7:30 less than the Jaguars.

- App State is expecting one of its largest crowds in school history for next Saturday's showdown against regional rival Wake Forest at Kidd Brewer Stadium. It will be Wake Forest's first visit to Boone in the 22-game series history.

- The Red Wolves stand 1-1 or better through two games for the first time since 2014 when it defeated Montana State before falling to Tennessee.

• Coastal and Western Illinois are meeting for the third time each team claiming a win in the previous meetings. Both games were played in Conway and both came down to a defensive stop in the final seconds.

• In 2010, CCU hosted the Leathernecks in the first round of the NCAA FCS playoffs. WIU's Matt Barr's five-yard touchdown run with 1:50 left in the fourth quarter broke a 10-10 tie and propelled Western Illinois to a 17-10 win. Coastal out-gained WIU 4-62-to-385, but CCU committed five turnovers,

including three interceptions. Coastal Carolina had one final opportunity to send the game into overtime and ultimately put together what appeared to be the game-tying drive. Quarterback Zach MacDowall drove the Chanticleers down the field in nine plays, highlighted by a 17-yard run to the WIU four-yard line. On the ensuing play, however, Kieron James intercepted MacDowall on the goal line to preserve the win for the Leathernecks.

• The last time they met, current Denver Bronco De'Angelo Henderson rushed for 167 yards and two TDs, and #1 Coastal Carolina overcame four deficits to hold off Western Illinois 34-27 before a then record crowd of 10,311 at Brooks Stadium. WIU threatened on the final drive of the game, heaving one final pass into the end zone, but Kerron Johnson was there to knock it away and secure the win for Coastal.

• Georgia Southern and Indiana have never met before in football. In fact, this will be Georgia Southern's first football game ever played in the state of Indiana, against a team from Indiana or against a team from the Big Ten Conference.

• It'll be a reunion of sorts Saturday as two high school teammates will be going toe to toe. Georgia Southern redshirt senior running back L.A. Ramsby and Indiana senior linebacker Tegray Scales both attended Colerain High School in Cincinnati, graduating a year apart. Ramsby scored at least one touchdown in the final 10 games of the 2014 season, and

scored a touchdown in the final nine games of 2015. He has rushed for 1,916 career yards and scored 34 touchdowns thus far, including a team-high eight last year. Scales was a SI.com Second-Team All-American after recording 126 stops last year and was the Foster Farms Bowl Defensive Most Valuable Player. Scales entered 2017 ninth on Indiana's career list with 33.5 tackles for loss.

• Indiana's roster includes 10 players from the state of Georgia. GS junior linebacker Tomarcio Reese and Indiana redshirt freshman Shaun Bonner both played at Colquitt County High.

• Freshman quarterback Shai Werts has 54 rushing attempts through two games, including 31 against New Hampshire. No Georgia Southern player has had more rushing attempts in a game since Jerick McKinnon carried the rock 32 times in a 2013 game against The Citadel. Werts's two-game total is the most since McKinnon rushed a combined 63 times in back-to-back games during the 2013 season (31 vs. Samford on 10/5/13; 32 vs. The Citadel on 10/12/13).

• The Jaguars earned their first victory of the season with a 45-0 defeat of Alabama A&M at home on Saturday.

• The shutout was the first recorded by USA since earning a 26-0 win at Lamar on Oct. 16, 2010, while the margin of victory was the largest ever posted by the Jags against an NCAA Division I opponent, surpassing the previous standard of 32 set in a Nov. 3, 2011, defeat of Mississippi Valley State at Ladd-Peebles Stadium.

• The Jags scored a touchdown on offense, defense and special teams in the same game — with all three

coming in the opening period — for the first time since a Nov. 7, 2015, home victory over Idaho.

• After recording 10 first-half points all season, the Jaguars held a 24-0 advantage at the end of the opening period, as they would go on to finish the contest with a 413-172 edge in total offense. It marked the seventh time in school history that South's defense has surrendered 200 or fewer total yards, and the first time the unit has accomplished the feat since allowing 118 in a win over Nicholls on Sept. 8, 2012.

• Dallas Davis completed 9-of-12 attempts for 255 yards and two scores, to become the third individual

in school history to surpass 3,000 yards passing in a career.

• Xavier Johnson became the program's all-time leader in all-purpose yards after running back the opening kickoff 45 yards, finishing the night with 3,585 in his career, and he added two touchdowns on the ground marking the sixth time in the senior's career that he has rushed for multiple scores.

• Freshman Gus Nave returned a blocked field goal 83 yards for the Jags' first touchdown of the night, sparking a stretch in the first quarter in which South scored 21 points in less than three minutes.

- The Bobcats enter the H-E-B I-35 Showdown game against UTSA looking to improve their record to 2-2 this season after dropping a 20-13 decision against Appalachian State in their Sun Belt Conference game on Sept. 16. Before the Appalachian State contests, Texas State opened the season with a 20-11 victory over Houston Baptist before falling 37-3 at Colorado on Sept. 9.
- Texas State enters the H-E-B I-35 Showdown game against UTSA leading the Sun Belt Conference and ranked 12th nationally in rushing defense after surrendering an average of 88.7 yards in its first three games. The Bobcats held Appalachian State to

- 116 yards rushing after surrendering just 91 yards at Colorado and Houston Baptist to 59 yards.
- Texas State also ranks 14th nationally and leads the Sun Belt in blocked kicks after Easy Anyama blocked an extra-point try against Houston Baptist.

- Neal Brown has never been shutout as a head coach or as an offensive coordinator -- a span of 116 games.
- Troy is now 9-5 in Sun Belt Conference openers; the Trojans won seven straight league openers from 2005-2011 and then dropped four straight from 2012-15.
- Troy improved to 14-1 when leading at the half and 15-0 when leading after three quarters under Neal Brown. Troy led 13-3 at halftime and 27-16 at the end of three quarters.
- Troy scored a touchdown on its opening posses-

- sion of the game for the second straight game; Troy also opened with a touchdown in its 34-7 win over Alabama State last week.
