SECOND HALF DOMINANCE

South Alabama has dominated the fourth quarter the last two games on the ground, however, they dominated the second half against Georgia Southern with 204 yards rushing and held Georgia Southern to minus-10 yards on the ground for the final 30 minutes.

WEBB CONTINUES TO IMPRESS

After missing much of the game against ULM and not being 100 percent against Troy, La'Damian Webb has come back the last two games and earned Offensive POW honors. Against Georgia Southern, he ran the ball 22 times for 179 yards in the second half alone.

#SWARMD TOUGH AGAINST THE RUN

After holding Arkansas State to minus-19 yards two weeks ago on the ground, the Jags returned to form on Saturday against Georgia Southern as they held the Eagle to under 100 yards - at 88 for the game. It was the sixth time this season they have held an opponent under 100 yards.

Last Time vs. Texas State

SAN MARCOS, Texas | Brady McBride scored in the fourth overtime to help cap a Texas State rally from a 14-point deficit and lift the Bobcats to a 33-31, quadruple-overtime Sun Belt Conference football victory over the University of South Alabama at Bobcat Stadium on Saturday.

McBride finished 18-of-28 passing for 187 yards and two touchdowns, and he added 57 yards on 15 carries as well for the Bobcats (2-3, 1-0 Sun Belt). Javen Banks led all players with 104 yards on four receptions, while Calvin Hill gained 70 yards on the ground and Jahmyl Jeter supplied 66.

Jake Bentley threw for 189 yards and a pair of scores on 19-of-26 passing, with Jalen Tolbert pacing the Jaguars (3-2, 0-2 SBC) after posting five catches for 84 yards. AJ Phillips rushed for 74 yards and two touchdowns as well.

Texas State's Sione Tupou was credited with a game-high 14 tackles, while the Jags were led defensively by Shawn Jennings and Keith Gallmon Jr. with nine stops apiece. A.J. DeShazor Jr. and Wy'Kevious Thomas also posted eight tackles each.

GAME FACTS

The Bobcats took the lead in the opening minute of play on a 57-yard touchdown pass from McBride to Banks, gaining over 100 yards in the first quarter.

South turned three interceptions into 17 points in the second period to go up by 10 at the break.

Seth Keller supplied the only points of the third quarter for the Bobcats with a 43-yard field goal that cut the Jaguar lead to 17-10.

Phillips' second touchdown in the opening minute of the final quarter extended USA's advantage to 14 points, but McBride found Marcell Barbee for a 13-yard touchdown midway through the period before Jeter's scored on fourth-and-goal from the one with 17 seconds left in regulation.

Bentley and Tolbert connected for a 12-yard touchdown pass to open overtime, but the Bobcats answered with a four-yard Brock Sturges run to continue the contest.

The second overtime saw Texas State hit the upright on a 30-yard field goal attempt before forcing a fumble on third down to end USA's ensuing possession.

Each team failed on their attempt in the third overtime before McBride's score put the Bobcats in front.

The Bobcats outgained South 212-140 on the ground while finishing the night with a 399-329 advantage in total offense.

RECORD SETTING DAY NETS WEBB BACK-TO-BACK POW AWARDS FROM SUN BELT

La'Damian Webb was named the Sun Belt Conference Offensive Player of the Week for the second consecutive week after his performance against Georgia Southern.

He dominated the second half while setting school records and career highs in rushing attempts and yards in a 38-31 come from behind victory on the road. The junior finished the night with a school record 247 yards rushing and tied a single-season mark with four touchdowns - both career highs - on a school-record 35 carries. Of the 247 yards, 179 of those came in the final two quarters, averaging 7.1 yards per carry and sealed the win by carrying the ball on 14 of South's final 16 plays before running out the clock. He helped lead a rushing attack that finished with 321 total yards on the ground - tying the seventh-best output in program history - and is the most on the ground since a 351-yard performance against Louisiana (11/16/19).

The four touchdowns by Webb give him 14 total touchdowns this season, including 13 on the ground, moving into first on the single-season list at South Alabama. Over the last two games, Webb has recorded 410 rushing yards and seven touchdowns in road wins for the Jags and has 896 for the season. He earned national recognition for his performance against Georgia Southern by earning a Helmet Sticker on ESPN's College Football Final.

WEBB NAMED OFFENSIVE POW AFTER PERFORMANCE AT ARK STATE

South Alabama running back La'Damian Webb was named the Sun Belt Conference Offensive Player of the Week following his performance in a 31-3 victory over Arkansas State on the road.

Webb rushed for a career-high 163 yards on 28 carries in the wind and rain in Jonesboro (Ark.), starting the game with a 69-yard run from scrimmage to set up his first touchdown of the day to give the Jags an early lead. He ended the contest with 11 straight carries and scoring the last of his three touchdowns, capping off an 11-play, 52-yard drive that ate up 7:16 in the final quarter.

He scored three touchdowns on the day, a new career high,

including a pair of one yard runs and a three-yard run. He now has 10 touchdowns on the season, nine rushing and one receiving.

GUAJARDO PERFECT IN FIELD GOALS SO FAR THIS SEASON

South Alabama kicker Diego Guajardo is perfect so far this season for the Jags from field goal range, converting on all 11 of his attempts, including a pair of field goals against Troy on Thursday night.

He has also converted on 12-of-13 of his extra points with his only miss hitting off of both posts at Central Michigan in a non-conference win for the Jags just two weeks ago.

NEW NAME IN 2022

DJ Thomas-Jones will look familiar to those in the Mobile area when he takes the field for the Jags this season, but he will also look a little different when looking at the roster. The Ole Miss transfer and former Saraland High School star has hyphenated his name heading into the 2022 season to honor his stepfather - Stevie.

Thomas-Jones played six games last season for the Rebels before transferring and the former three-star returned to his hometown area where he starred for Saraland and was ranked as the 13th-best tight end in the nation.

BRADLEY NAME SYNONOMOUS WITH THE GAME OF FOOTBALL

Carter Bradley, a transfer from Toledo, has a name that is no stranger to football. He has done his part to make a name for himself, including playing in eight games last season and helping the team earn a bid to the Bahamas Bowl. He finished 18-of-28 passing for 221 yards and a score as the Rockets dropped a three-point decision at No. 7 Notre Dame, before

posting a season-best 254 yards after connecting on 22-of-36 attempts the next week against Colorado State.

But it's the last name that commands respect from the NFL as his father, Gus Bradley, is one of the most well-known and respected coaches in the game. He currently serves as the defensive coordinator for the Indianapolis Colts. He came to prominence as the defensive coordinator for the Seattle Seahawks from 2009 to 2012, where he was the original play caller of the team's Legion of Boom secondary. Bradley later served as the head coach of the Jacksonville Jaguars from 2013 to 2016. Following his dismissal from Jacksonville, he returned to assistant coaching and became the Colts' defensive coordinator in 2022.

It was during the time in Seattle where Carter decided to play quarterback and not on both sides of the ball, getting to spend time with then-Seahawks quarterback Russell Wilson.

SEEING DOUBLE THIS SEASON

Opponents will be seeing double this year when they line up against the Jags as South Alabama will have a set of twins - one on each side of the ball. Devin Voisin is starting at receiver, and brother Jaden has been starting at defensive back for the Jags this season.

JAGS IN THE NFL DRAFT

With the 88th pick of the third round, Jalen Tolbert became the third University of South of Alabama football player to be selected by the National Football League by the Dallas Cowboys in the 2022 Draft held at Allegiant Stadium in Paradise, Nevada, home of the Las Vegas Raiders.

JAGS PLACE THREE ON ALL-SUN BELT TEAM, PICKED SECOND IN WEST

South Alabama had three players selected to the Preseason All-Sun Belt and were picked to finish in the West Division, announced by the conference office.

The Jags placed two players on the First Team in Darrell Luter Jr. and Keith Gallmon Jr., both starters in the defensive backfield. Luter, who was recently named to the Athlon All-American fourth team and to the Jim Thorpe Award Watch List, returns after a stellar junior season that earned first team all-conference honors while also three All-America honors. He led South Alabama with four interceptions and 10 other passes defended, finishing second in the conference in interceptions and leading the Sun Belt in passes defended per game. He ended the year third in the nation in passes defended per game and was seventh in interceptions per game, while recording the second-highest interception total in school history and the most recorded by a Jaguar since the program moved to FBS in 2012.

He was joined on the first team by Gallmon who returns for his

senior season after being named Second Team all-conference last season. He started all 12 games at safety last season and posted 59 tackles including 2.5 behind the line of scrimmage. He also finished with a pair of pass breakups and an interception, while finishing second on the team in tackles. He posted a season-high nine tackles against Texas State and finished the season with six or more tackles in a game seven times in 2021.

The pair was joined by Second Team selection, receiver Jalen Wayne who returns as the team's leading receiver from 2021. He earned honorable mention honors from the conference last season and was named second team by Pro Football Network and fourth team by Phil Steele. He finished the season with 53 catches for 630 yards, finishing second on the team in both categories with totals that surpassed his three-year career figures entering the season. Wayne finished the year among the top 10 in the Sun Belt in total catches and yards receiving as well as receptions and receiving yards per game.

Meanwhile, the Jags were picked to finish second in the West Division behind defending champion Louisiana who received 95 total points and 12 first place votes. Meanwhile, South Alabama received 79 total points and two first place votes, finishing ahead of Troy (76), Texas State (41), Southern Miss (70), Arkansas State (37), and ULM (24).

WAYNE CONTINUES TO CLIMB RECEPTION CHART FOR THE JAGS

Jalen Wayne entered the season with 94 total receptions, needing just six to reach 100 for his career. The senior hauled in reception #100 against Central Michigan with a touchdown catch and is now third all-time at the school after his nine-catch performance against Troy.

NEED A LEFT-FOOTED KICKER

Heading into Fall Camp, South Alabama had three kickers who were left-footed including a pair from the Mobile-area. The Jags had two in kicker Diego Guajardo and punter Jack Martin, before the arrival of transfer kicker Jacob Meeks. Both Meeks and Guajardo share the kicking duties, including kickoff duties while Martin backs up Jack Brooks as the punter.

THE MAN FROM DOWN UNDER HANDLES THE PUNTING DUTIES

Jack Brooks, from Wagga Wagga, New South Wales, Australia handles the punting duties again this year for the Jags. He earned honorable mention all-Sun Belt Conference recognition after averaging a career-high 43.2 yards per punt, the third-highest mark on South's season record list, last fall. He was also named first-team all-conference by Pro Football Focus, while receiving fourth-team all-league accolades from Phil Steele Publications. The Wagga Wagga, New South Wales,

Australia, native had 13 kicks end inside the opposition's 20-yard line and 14 efforts of 50 or more yards. Brooks finished fourth in the league and was 39th in the nation in average yards per punt and set a school game record with an average of 63 yards per kick in the season finale against Coastal Carolina.

BRADLEY NAMED TO MANNING STAR OF THE WEEK LIST AFTER CENTRAL MICHIGAN PERFORMANCE

Carter Bradley was one of eight quarterbacks named to the Manning Award "Stars of the Week" Monday. Along with Bradley, Malik Cunningham (Louisville), Jalon Daniels (Kansas), Frank Harris (UTSA), Sam Hartman (Wake Forest), Will Rogers (Mississippi State), Kyle Vantrease (Georgia Southern) and Caleb Williams (USC) were also named to the list.

Of South's 502 yards of total offense, 354 came through the air. The 354 passing yards recorded by Bradley tied for fourth most (Jake Bentley, vs. Georgia Southern, 10/14/21) in a single game. Bradley threw for 249 yards during the first 30-minutes of action, which were 11 yards shy of his total (260) in the season opener against Nicholls, to send the Jags into the locker room with a 31-10 halftime advantage.

OFFENSIVE LINE NAMED TO JOE MOORE MIDSEASON HONOR ROLL

One of the key reasons for the success of the South Alabama offense this season has been the play of the offensive line.

The unit was recognized for its performance as the group was named to the Joe Moore Award Midseason Honor Roll and announced by The Foundation for Teamwork.

The award, which has been presented since 2015, recognizes the most outstanding offensive line unit in college football.

The offensive line for the Jags (5-1, 2-0 SBC) has paved the way for the offense to be in the top 30 in the nation (third in the Sun Belt) in total offense at 462.3 yards per game, and in the top 60 nationally in rushing offense (fifth in the Sun Belt) averaging 164.8 yards per game. The unit has yielded just 1.67 sacks per game and which has allowed quarterback Carter Bradley to lead the passing offense into the top 25 in the nation (fourth in the conference) at 297.5 yards per game.

Joining the Jags on the midseason list were 21 other teams: No. 6 Alabama, Air Force, Appalachian State, Arkansas, Coastal Carolina, No. 1 Georgia, No. 18 Illinois, No. 17 Kansas State, No. 4 Michigan, Minnesota, No. 7 Mississippi, Notre Dame, No. 2 Ohio State, No. 10 Oregon, No. 16 Penn State, No. 14. Syracuse, No. 3 Tennessee, No. 8 TCU, No. 9 UCLA, No. 12 USC, and UAB.

Semifinalists selections will be announced on Nov. 15 with finalists announced on Dec. 6. Selection of the 2022 Joe Moore Award winner will be made public after a surprise visit to the winning university's campus in late December.

WOMMACK NAMED TO PAUL “BEAR” BRYANT COACH OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

The South Alabama football program received national attention as a member was named to another watch list. Second-year Jaguar head coach Kane Wommack was one

of 25 active college football coaches to be selected to the American Heart Association's 2022 Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year Award watch list as announced by the AMH.

The award is given each January to a college football coach for contributions that make the sport better for athletes and fans alike by demonstrating grit, integrity and a winning approach to coaching and life- both on and off the field.

Now in its 37th year, the Coach of the Year award winner will be announced live from Houston's Post Oak Hotel on Wednesday, January 11, 2023, during an awards ceremony presented by Marathon Oil. The Watch List, Finalists and Coach of the Year recipient are voted on by the National Sports Media Association, the Bryant Awards' Executive Leadership Team and the Bryant Family. The Coach of the Year Finalist List will be announced on December 13.

In addition to the Coach of the Year, the Paul "Bear" Bryant Awards will also present Conference Coach of the Year Awards from each of the Power Five collegiate athletic conferences (Atlantic Coast Conference, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12 and Southeastern Conference) and one from the Group of Five conferences (American Athletic Conference, Conference USA, Mid-American Conference, Mountain West Conference and Sun Belt Conference). The 2022 award cycle marks just the third year that the individual conference coach recognitions will be granted.

SOUTH ALABAMA RECORDS HUGE DAY DEFENSIVELY AGAINST ARK STATE

South Alabama turned in one of the best defensive performances in school history against Arkansas State on Saturday.

The 11 tackles for loss recorded by the Jaguar defense were a new season high (9, vs. Louisiana Tech), and the four sacks tied for a season high in the category and are tied for seventh-most in a game.

The 11 tackles for loss tied for the fourth-highest total in a single game and were the most by the Jag defense since being credited with 11 at Texas State last fall.

The 1½ sacks by Sherriff tied a career high.

The 158 yards of offense allowed by South were the fifth fewest given up by the defense, and marks the second time this season that the Jaguars have held the opponent below 200 yards of total offense (165, vs. Nicholls).

The -19 rushing yards allowed were three shy of matching the single-game record of -22 recorded by Fork Union [Va.] Academy (10/31/09).

The -19 rushing yards were the fewest allowed to a Division I opponent, besting the previous mark of 9 rushing yards allowed at Bowling Green last season.

**HEAD COACH KANE WOMMACK**

Kane Wommack enters his second year as the head coach of the University of South Alabama football program after being named the leader of the program on December 12, 2020. He was a finalist for the award given to the top NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision assistant coach prior to being named the head coach of the Jags.

Wommack (pronounced WAH-mick), 35, became the third head coach since the inception of South's program and was the youngest at the NCAA FBS level. The Jaguars' defensive coordinator in 2016 and '17, he returned to the program after working three years as linebackers' coach at Indiana including serving as the Hoosiers' defensive coordinator his final two seasons.

Last season, South Alabama finished 5-7 in Wommack's first season and had eight players picked up honors from the Sun Belt Conference including Sun Belt Offensive Player of the Year Jalen Tolbert who became the first draftee in the NFL during the Wommack era. The Jags' Tolbert and Darrell Luter, Jr. were named First Team All-Conference, while Keith Gallmon, Jr. and Lincoln Sefcik earned second- and third-team honors respectively. Meanwhile, Jake Bentley, Jack Brooks, Wy'Kevious Thomas and Jalen Wayne earned honorable mention honors.

Prior to his return to South Alabama, Wommack was one of five finalists for the Broyles Award in the fall after his efforts helped IU post a 6-2 mark overall on the way to finishing 12th in the final Associated Press poll after earning an invitation to the Outback Bowl. His unit led the Big Ten Conference with both 17 interceptions and a 64 percent red zone defensive rate – ranking first in the country in the latter category and second in the former – while also pacing the league with 20 takeaways and 3.12 sacks per contest. The Hoosiers also finished 10th nationally in turnover margin (1.00) and were among the top 25 in scoring (20.2 points per game) and passing efficiency (120.96 rating) as well in 2020.

Following the season, seven members of the IU defense earned all-Big Ten honors including a school-record four – Jamar Johnson, Jerome Johnson, Micah McFadden and Tiawan Mullen – first-team selections. Mullen also became the first cornerback in program history to earn first-team All-America honors after being recognized by the Football Writers Association of America (FWAA) while McFadden was a third-team Associated Press All-American.

In his first year as the youngest Power 5 defensive coordinator, Wommack led IU to top-50 rankings nationally in scoring, total, rush and pass defense for the first time since 1993. His efforts helped the Hoosiers hold four opponents to three points or less, the most in one season since limiting five to three or fewer in 1945.

Wommack was the Jaguars' defensive coordinator and linebackers coach during the 2016 and '17 campaigns, leading a unit that was among the top 10 in the country in passing defense (174.6 ypg) while allowing over 10 points fewer than the previous season – the fifth-best improvement in the NCAA FBS that fall – his first year on the staff. In 2017, South was in the top


