Post-game interview quotes

GEORGIA STATE COACH ANGIE NICHOLSON (team finishes 21-33)

"Losing never feels good, and when it's the last one, it's the end of the road, it's tough because you're never going to have that team again. It makes things not fun."

On early 3-0 deficit – "I'm okay with falling behind. I'm not okay with the way it happened, on both sides. It just seemed kind of like a nightmare, a dream nightmare. Because it wasn't fun, for either team. I don't like seeing their pitcher being called (for illegal pitches), I don't like our pitcher being called, it just changes everything. I don't like how that just changed everything on both sides. It's no excuse, it just does, it changes everything."

On Hallie Adams relief pitching effort – "She spins the ball very well. She'll get her strikeouts, she gets a lot of mis-hits and a lot of foul balls and a lot of popups. She did do a good job of coming in there and doing what she needed to do. I'm very proud of her."

On Troy reliever Libby Baker – "She did do a good job. She kept us down. She definitely kept us down, and it was good that both pitchers came in and weren't called for the illegal pitches that the two starting pitchers were called for."
