LOUISIANA HITS THE ROAD FOR IMPORTANT SBC WEST BATTLE

- The Ragin' Cajuns travel to take on the Arkansas State Red Wolves on Saturday at 2 p.m. on ESPN+ in a matchup featuring a pair of 2-2 teams in the hunt for the Sun Belt West championship.
- Louisiana holds a 29-21-2 record over the Red Wolves and have won the last five meetings.
- The Ragin' Cajuns won last year's meeting, 38-18, in Lafayette with the last game in Jonesboro being a tightly-contested matchup with Louisiana edging out the Red Wolves, 28-27.

A LOOK AT THE RAGIN' CAJUNS

- Louisiana's defensive has been a force on opposing quarterbacks, as the Cajuns have recorded 26 sacks. The Ragin' Cajuns are averaging 3.25 sacks per game, which ranks tied for 12th nationally and first in the Sun Belt.
- Louisiana's offense has been equally as impressive as the Ragin' Cajuns average 32.9 points per game.
- The Ragin' Cajuns rushing attack ranks 11th in the country and tops in the Sun Belt at 214.0 yards per game. Jacob Kibodi (73.1), Zeon Chriss (68.0) and Dre'lyn Washington (54.0) rank in the top 15 in the Sun Belt in rushing yards per game as Kibodi and Chriss rank 55th and 66th nationally, respectively.
- Jacob Kibodi was put on scholarship following the win at UAB and has rushed for 482 yards on 68 carries (7.1 YPC) with six touchdowns since the win against the Blazers.
- Zeon Chriss, who replaced Ben Wooldridge after four plays at UAB due to an injury, has stepped up to the challenge and has rushed for 476 yards and five touchdowns while also hurting defenses with his arm, throwing for 1,501 yards and 10 touchdowns while completing 66.2% (90-for-136) of his passes.
- Chriss ranks 25th nationally in completion percentage, 43rd in passing efficiency at 148.0 and fifth in the SBC in points responsible for per game (12.9).
- Kenneth Almendares has continued his stellar play from a year ago as he enters Saturday's contest 7-for-8 on his field goal attempts and tied the school record for most consecutive field goals made at 18.
- The Ragin' Cajuns coaching staff is one of seven schools nationally to return all 10 assistant coaches from 2022.

LOOKING BACK AT SOUTH ALABAMA

- Louisiana got back into the win column with a dominating defensive performance as the Ragin' Cajuns defeated South Alabama, 33-20, and forced five turnovers.
- Cameron Whitfield was a bull in a china shop as he tallied a career-high seven tackles and 3.5 sacks, three of which were strip sacks recovered by the Cajuns.
- Kendre' Gant recovered one of Whitfield's forced fumbles and returned it 55 yards to give Louisiana a 33-14 lead to go along with nine tackles.
- Jacob Kibodi rushed for 119 yards on 23 carries, including a 56-yard touchdown in the third quarter.
- Zeon Chriss completed 13 of his 17 passes for 145 and two touchdowns to Jacob Bernard and Neal Johnson while also rushing for 30 yards.
- Jalen Clark added a team-high 10 tackles and a pass breakup, and Caleb Kibodi registered seven tackles.

AGAINST THE RED WOLVES

- Saturday's game is the 52nd meeting all-time between the two schools with Louisiana holding an 29-21-1 advantage.
- The Ragin' Cajuns have won the last five meetings and eight of the last 10.
- Last season, Louisiana defeated Arkansas State, 38-18, in Lafayette with the last meeting in Jonesboro being a tightly contested game with the Ragin' Cajuns edging out the Red Wolves, 28-27.

KIBODI ON SCHOLARSHIP AND MAKING THE MOST OF THE OPPORTUNITY

- Jacob Kibodi, who has started for Louisiana in five games, was put on scholarship by head coach Michael Desormeaux following the UAB game.
- Kibodi has been stellar in the last five weeks as he has rushed for 482 yards and six touchdowns on 68 carries for a 7.1 yards per carry average.
- In the win at South Alabama, he ran for 119 yards and a touchdown, including a 56-yard touchdown scamper.
- The Baton Rouge, Louisiana, native rushed for 65 yards and a touchdown on seven carries at Minnesota.
- Against Buffalo, Kibodi reeled off a career-long 69-yard TD run and accounted for 100 yards on the ground on seven carries.
- In the win at UAB, he ran for 108 yards and a touchdown and had a long rush of 59 yards.
- For the season, he is the team's leading rusher with 585 yards and is averaging 6.7 yards per carry.

CHRIS STEPPING UP

- Redshirt freshman Zeon Chriss has stepped up in a major way since being thrust into the starting quarterback role following Ben Wooldridge's injury at UAB.
- Chriss has completed 66.2% (90-of-136) of his passes for 1,051 yards and 10 touchdowns while rushing for 476 yards and five touchdowns.
- Chriss was named the Manning Award Week Star of the Week following his performance against Texas State in which he led the Ragin' Cajuns to a come-from-behind 34-30 victory, throwing for 205 yards and three touchdowns while adding 67 rushing yards and a touchdown.
- At Minnesota, Chriss threw for 172 yards and a pair of touchdowns while adding 74 yards on the ground.
- In the win versus Buffalo, the redshirt freshman threw for 249 yards and a score while adding two touchdowns and 70 yards on the ground.
- In the victory at UAB, he ran for 103 yards and two touchdowns on six carries while throwing for 174 yards and a touchdown.

THE NIGERIAN NIGHTMARE

- K.C. Ossai, the team's leading returner tackler, has picked up where he left off as he has recorded a team-high 50 tackles to go along with a pair of forced fumbles, a blocked kick and a sack.
- Against Minnesota and Texas State, Ossai registered 17 tackles, including a forced fumble

on Texas State's final possession that secured the win for the Ragin' Cajuns.

- Last season, he ranked fifth on the team with 63 tackles while playing in all 13 games.
- Ossai had 2.0 tackles for loss to go along with a forced fumble and a pass breakup as a sophomore.
- The Conroe, Texas, native registered a career-high 11 tackles at Rice and helped lead the Ragin' Cajuns to a victory over Eastern Michigan with nine tackles and a forced fumble.
- A representative at Sun Belt Media Days, Ossai was named to the Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Second Team.
- K.C.'s brother, Joseph, played collegiately at Texas and is currently playing in the NFL for the Cincinnati Bengals.

ANCHORING THE LINE

- AJ Gillie, one of the Sun Belt's best offensive linemen, registered a pair of knockdowns in the season-opener against Northwestern State and graded out at 89-percent.
- In the conference opener, Gillie registered a team-high four knockdowns and graded out at 87-percent.
- In the win at UAB, Gillie had a team-high four knockdowns and graded out at 88-percent.
- Against the Bulls, was the highest-rated offensive lineman and registered three knockdowns.
- At Minnesota, he was Louisiana's highest-graded offensive lineman at 94-percent with four knockdowns.
- Gillie has been a key cog for an offensive line that was named a "Unit to Watch" by the Joe Moore Award and was named to the Lombardi Award Midseason Watch List.
- The Natchitoches, Louisiana, native started all 13 games last season and registered a team-high 53 knockdowns.
- Gillie graded at 80-percent-or-better in 11 games, including a 93-percent grade in three contests. Against eventual Sun Belt Champion Troy, he had six knockdowns and graded at 87-percent.
- During his redshirt freshman year, he started 12 games at left guard and helped the offensive line earn Joe Moore Award semifinalist honors for their impactful play.

GANT GOING OFF

- Linebacker Kendre' Gant has been stellar for the Ragin' Cajuns defense as he ranks second on the team in tackles for loss (7), sacks (5.0) and is tied for second in tackles with 48.
- At South Alabama, Gant recovered a fumble and returned it 55 yards for a touchdown while also registering nine tackles.
- Gant had a pair of sacks, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery for 29 yards against Georgia State.
- Against Buffalo, Gant tallied a career-high eight tackles and a sack to go along with a pass breakup and a QB hurry.
- He was a catalyst defensively at UAB as all three of his tackles were for loss including 2.0 sacks.
- At Minnesota, Gant registered seven tackles, one shy of the team lead.
- Gant has played in 19 games in his Louisiana career and has registered 54 tackles, 9.5 tackles for loss, 6.0 sacks, and two forced fumbles and fumble recoveries.

KENNY THE KICKER

- One of the nation's most reliable kickers, Kenneth Almendares has picked up where he left off a year ago as he has made nine of his 10 field goal attempts and is 31-for-32 on extra point attempts.
- Prior to his miss against Georgia State, Almendares had made his last 18 attempts, tying Brett Baer's school record of 18 consecutive made field goals in 2011-12.
- In the win against UAB, the Clute, Texas, native connected from 46 and 37 yards while making all five extra points.
- At Old Dominion, Almendares made a 28-yard field goal and four extra points and connected on a 33-yard field goal and made all four of his extra point attempts in the season-opener against Northwestern State.
- Almendares was 18-of-23 on field goal attempts and 23-of-24 extra points a year ago.
- The Lou Groza Award watch list member tied the school record with five goals against Georgia Southern and was perfect from beyond 50 yards going 3-for-3. He was one of eight FBS kickers in 2022 to make at least three field goals of 50-plus yards.
- Almendares was named to the Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Second Team and PFF All-Sun Belt Third Team.

WHITFIELD'S MONSTER GAME

- Redshirt sophomore linebacker Cameron Whitfield had a stellar game at South Alabama as the Houston native registered 3.5 sacks, three forced fumbles and a career-high seven tackles.
- A pair of his strip sacks were recovered by Nijel McGriff and the third was returned to the house by Kendre' Gant to give Louisiana a 33-14 lead.
- The team's leader in sacks with seven had a breakout game at UAB in which he had 2.5 sacks to go along with five tackles and also had a sack at Minnesota.
- For his efforts against the Jaguars, Whitfield was named the Sun Belt Conference, Louisiana Sports Writers Association and the Frisco Bowl Defensive Player of the Week.

ROB RISING UP

- Redshirt sophomore wide receiver Robert Williams has stepped up this season, leading the Ragin' Cajuns in receptions (23), receiving yards (294) and is tied for the team lead in touchdowns with three.
- Williams had his most productive game in the win over Texas State as he hauled in five catches for 90 yards and a touchdown.
- The Humble, Texas, native caught a touchdown right before halftime at Minnesota to give the Ragin' Cajuns a 17-10 lead.
- At Old Dominion, he had a season-high six receptions for 52 yards and in the season-opener, he caught a pair of passes for 37 yards and a touchdown.

NEAL IS A BIG DEAL

- Louisiana's leading returning receiver from a year ago, Neal Johnson, garnered preseason praise from the league's head coaches and media outlets as he was named to the PFF, Phil Steele and Preseason All-Sun Belt First Team as well as the Mackey Award watch list.
- This season, Johnson has hauled in 17 passes for 180 yards and two touchdowns.
- Johnson led Louisiana in its season-opener as he hauled in three passes for 38 yards.
- At Old Dominion, Johnson caught four passes for 22 yards, and hauled in three passes for 36 yards at UAB.
- Johnson registered his first touchdown of the season against Buffalo as he hauled in an 8-yard pass for the game's first score.
- The Mesquite, Texas, native hauled in 25 receptions for 296 and a pair of touchdowns a year ago and was named an All-Sun Belt honorable mention.
- The senior caught a pass in all 13 games and had touchdown receptions against Eastern Michigan and Arkansas State.
- For his career, Johnson has caught 84 passes for 937 yards and seven touchdowns in 52 games played.

CONSISTENCY IS KEY

- Louisiana is in rare company for the 2023 season as all 10 assistant coaches returned from last season.
- The Ragin' Cajuns are the only school in the Sun Belt and just one of three Group of Five schools to have all 10 assistants return.
- In total, seven schools nationally return its entire coaching staff including Colorado State, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, New Mexico State, Pitt and USC.

GRADUATES

- Twelve Ragin' Cajuns proudly don the Sun Belt graduate patch on their jersey after graduating with their Bachelor's degree.
- The list includes Kenneth Almendares, Jacob Bernard, Glenn Brown, Kaleb Carter, Alan Guerrieri, Jacob Kibodi, Thomas Leo, Patrick Mensah, Pearse Migl, James Ohonba, Nathan Thomas and Ben Wooldridge.

125TH ANNIVERSARY

- Throughout the 2023-24 athletics season, all Louisiana sports teams will celebrate the University's 125th anniversary.
- The 125 logo will be displayed on Louisiana's helmets and throughout Cajun Field.
- On July 14, 1898, Louisiana Governor Murphy J. Foster signed Act 162 to establish Southwestern Louisiana Industrial Institute, now the University Louisiana at Lafayette.
- The University has been a staple in the Lafayette community and was designated as a Carnegie R1 university in 2022.



MICHAEL DESORMEAUX

HEAD COACH | 2ND SEASON

Former University of Louisiana record-setting quarterback Michael Desormeaux enters his second season as head coach after being named the program's 27th head coach on Dec. 5, 2021.

In his first year at the helm, Desormeaux led Louisiana to its fifth consecutive bowl game, a school record, while 11 Ragin' Cajuns earned All-Sun Belt honors and Eric Garror was named a PFF Second Team All-American.

Prior to being appointed head coach, Desormeaux joined the coaching staff at Louisiana in 2016, and helped the program reach new heights as the Ragin' Cajuns won four consecutive Sun Belt West Division titles (2018-21) and won its first outright Sun Belt Championship in program history with Desormeaux serving as Co-Offensive Coordinator during the 2021 season.

Desormeaux, who was the only member of the coaching staff retained by Billy Napier, spent four years developing as a signal caller under Napier. Desormeaux's offense ranked third in the Sun Belt in both scoring offense (31.2) and total offense (397.6) during the historic 2021 campaign and helped the team secure a program record 13 wins.

In 2020, Desormeaux saw the Ragin' Cajuns rank 29th in the nation in scoring offense (33.6 ppg) and played a key role in the team's rushing attack ranking 21st nationally with 213.0 yards per game.

His offensive prowess was also on display during the 2019 campaign as he helped Louisiana's offense flourish in record-breaking fashion, ranking eighth nationally in total offense (494.1) and 10th nationally in scoring offense (37.9).

The New Iberia native has also done a masterful job coaching Louisiana's tight ends, aiding in the development of Neal Johnson and Johnny Lumpkin, both of whom earned All-Sun Belt honors in 2022. Johnson has led the tight end corps over the last four seasons, while Lumpkin caught 36 passes for 408 yards and six scores under Desormeaux's watch and was signed as an undrafted free agent by the New England Patriots.

He was on staff at Louisiana in 2016 and 2017, working with the wide receivers and running backs, respectively. Over those two seasons, he developed and helped recruit some of the top talent in Ragin' Cajuns history, including former running back Trey Ragas and former wideouts Ja'Marcus Bradley and Al Riles.

Desormeaux is also a relentless recruiter, playing an instrumental role in the team securing the top recruiting class in the Sun Belt in 2019, 2020 and 2021. With his influence, the Ragin' Cajuns signed the top class of 2023 recruiting class in the conference.

He also has strong ties with local high school coaches and has continued to build strong ties with prep coaches around the state.

Prior to joining the Ragin' Cajuns staff, he spent three seasons at Lafayette's Ascension Episcopal School, where he led the Blue Gators to an 11-2 record and the Division IV state semifinals in 2015. He took over an AES program in 2013 that finished 0-9 the year before and led them to five wins in his first season and eight victories in 2014.

A standout player for Louisiana, Desormeaux passed for 3,893 yards and 23 touchdowns while rushing for 2,843 yards and 16 scores. He was named All-Sun Belt Conference three times as an all-purpose specialist before being named the league's Offensive Player of the Year after throwing for 1,876 yards while rushing for 1,035 yards.

He became the eighth quarterback in NCAA history to post back-to-back 1,000-yard rushing seasons after rushing for 1,141 yards as a junior in 2007. Under his guidance, the Cajuns offense led the SBC in total yards, rushing yards, yards per game, rushing yards per game, yards per play, third down conversion percentage and touchdowns.

Desormeaux led the Sun Belt in passing efficiency in SBC only games and broke Jake Delhomme's single-season school record for passing efficiency. After concluding his career with the Ragin' Cajuns, Desormeaux signed a free agent contract as a defensive back with the NFL's Jacksonville Jaguars.

He was inducted into the National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame (NFF) Hampshire Honor Society after graduating in December 2008 with a cumulative grade-point-average of 3.91.

Desormeaux was a star athlete at Catholic-New Iberia, where he later got his coaching start as an assistant coach. He lettered four years in both football and basketball, as well as five years in track and three in baseball. He led Catholic HS to three straight Class 3A playoff appearances and three straight district championships in football. Desormeaux earned first-team Class 3A All-State honors in 2003 and was named the All-District offensive MVP.

He began his coaching career at his alma mater, serving as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach from 2010-13.

Desormeaux and his wife, Lindsey, are the parents of two children, Thomas and Elle.

2023 LOUISIANA FOOTBALL CAJUN FIELD RECORDS



Cajun Field has served as the home of Ragin' Cajuns football since September 1971. Louisiana holds a 151-113-2 all-time record on its home field with winning records in 34 of the 50 seasons.

The Cajuns set the school single-season records for total attendance (145,854) and average attendance (29,171) in 2011. Included in those totals were five of the top 15 crowds all-time, including a Sun Belt Conference record 32,823 vs. North Texas on Oct. 15, 2011. Louisiana was the Sun Belt attendance champion in 2004, 2008, 2011, 2013 and 2014.

Cajun Field hosted the 1,000th Cajuns game in school history on Nov. 1, 2008 before a then-Sun Belt record crowd of 29,031. The venue also hosted the 2021 Sun Belt Conference Championship Game as Louisiana earned a 24-16 win over App State before an SBC Championship Game record crowd of 31,014.

Louisiana has enjoyed plenty of memorable moments since the venue opened in 1971. The greatest of those moments came during the 1996 season when the Ragin' Cajuns opened their 26th season in the facility with the biggest upset in school history, a 29-22 victory over No. 25 Texas A&M in front of a then-record crowd of 38,783 fans. That mark surpassed the previous record crowd of 36,133 that saw the Cajuns face the Alabama Crimson Tide on Oct. 6, 1990.

On Nov. 30, 2019, Louisiana earned a thrilling 31-30 victory over in-state rival ULM to eclipse the double-digit win mark for the first time ever with its 10th victory, while also setting the school record for the most SBC wins with seven.

Cajun Field has been the site of much success with four consecutive 4-1 records from 1993-96. The school record for wins at Cajun Field in a season is seven, set during the 1976 season, one of three undefeated seasons (1976, 1980 and 1987) at Cajun Field.

Cajun Field boasts 2,577 chairback seats and additional seating to the capacity of another 38,849 giving the facility a total seating capacity of 41,426. In 2014, the south endzone was closed in to create more seating, adding 5,000 seats to the stadium capacity. In the summer of 2008, Cajun Field removed its long-standing natural grass and entered a new era with a synthetic playing surface.

For the first 17 years, Louisiana's football stadium was simply known as Cajun Field. In the summer of 1988, then-Strength & Conditioning Coach Mickey Faulkinberry suggested referring to Cajun Field as "The Swamp". The name stuck for various reasons. To start, the field surface is set two feet below sea level in a natural bowl.

In addition to providing a picturesque surrounding, the sunken facility allows most fans to walk down to their stadium seats. The Cajuns and their opponents must enter Cajun Field through a long tunnel from the Cox Communications Athletic Center.

LAFAYETTE – Ben Wooldridge, making his return to the lineup nearly 10 months after a season-ending injury, threw for three touchdowns and rushed for one and the Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns used a smothering defensive effort to claim a 38-13 win over in-state opponent Northwestern State on Saturday night at Cajun Field.

Dre'lyn Washington, who rushed for career-high 88 yards on eight carries, scored on Louisiana's second play from scrimmage with a 62-yard race down the left sideline while Robert Williams and Tavion Smith each caught their touchdown passes in a Ragin' Cajuns uniform.

All five touchdowns scored for Louisiana (1-0) were 20 yards or greater with Wooldridge connecting with Peter LeBlanc on a 50-yard strike in the third quarter before finding Smith for a 21-yard scoring pass with 4:59 remaining.

Wooldridge completed 14 of 32 passes for 223 yards while adding 29 yards more on the ground in his first game back after missing Louisiana's final three games in 2022. The redshirt senior connected with nine players in the game with Neal Johnson grabbing a team-high three passes for the Ragin' Cajuns.

LeBlanc, Williams and Terrance Carter each caught a pair of passes for Louisiana, which finished with 429 yards of total offense including 206 on the ground. Jacob Kibodi added 49 yards on the ground for the Ragin' Cajuns with redshirt freshman Kendrell Williams gaining 23 yards on three carries late in the contest.

Tyree Skipper, Kendré Gant, Jordan Lawson and K.C. Ossai had six stops each for the Ragin' Cajuns, which limited Northwestern State (0-1) to 187 yards of total offense including 77 yards on the ground in 40 attempts. Lawson collected two of Louisiana's five sacks in the game with Ossai, Antoine Baylis and Tyler Guidry each recording one.

NORFOLK, Va. – Louisiana football battled in its Sun Belt Conference opener Saturday but fell at Old Dominion, 38-31, at S.B. Ballard Stadium.

The Ragin' Cajuns came out firing on the opening drive of the game. Ben Wooldridge converted a 3rd-and-2 from midfield for an 18-yard gain to Robert Williams, setting the Cajuns up in Monarch territory. Four plays later, Wooldridge found Harvey Broussard in the corner of the end zone on a three-yard touchdown pass for the early 7-0 lead.

ODU responded with a quick score to tie the game 33 seconds later. On the ensuing Cajun possession, Wooldridge threw for 30 yards and picked up another 12 with his feet to set up a 28-yard field goal by Kenneth Almendares to give Louisiana a 10-7 lead.

The Monarchs scored 10 straight points in the second quarter and led 17-10 with 4:08 left in the half. Jacob Kibodi got the Cajun offense going again with three carries to open the drive to total 18 yards. Wooldridge then found Charles Robertson over the top to move the ball to the 1-yard-line. On the very next play, Wooldridge kept it himself for the 1-yard scamper to tie things at 17 heading into the locker room.

A pair of ODU touchdowns put them ahead 31-17 heading into the final frame. The offense found themselves again late in the quarter thanks to the running game. Terrence Williams gained 20 yards on three carries to jump-start the drive, before capping it off with a 1-yard touchdown run to pull the Cajuns to within a score.

Wooldridge threw for 285 yards and a pair of touchdowns while also running for 49 yards and a score. Williams ended the night with a team-high six catches for 52 yards. Bernard was the team's leading receiver with 70 yards through the air on three receptions. Kibodi had 10 carries for 54 yards along with his 37-yard touchdown reception.

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. – Zeon Chriss, replacing injured starter Ben Wooldridge in the first quarter, recorded career highs in both rushing and passing and the Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns used a 24-point second quarter after a nearly 90-minute lightning delay to earn a 41-21 victory over UAB on Saturday at Protective Stadium.

Louisiana (2-1) harassed UAB quarterback Jacob Zeno all night as the Ragin' Cajuns defense picked off a pair of passes and recorded seven sacks.

The 20-point margin of victory for the Ragin' Cajuns was their largest in a non-conference road game since a season-opening, 42-14 win at Liberty in 2021. Louisiana claimed its third straight win over American Athletic Conference newcomer UAB (1-2) in the eight-game series and was the Cajuns' second road victory over the Blazers, who entered with a 30-4 home record since 2017.

Chriss, who overcame an 0-for-4 through the air, finished 14-for-20 overall for 174 yards with a touchdown while rushing for 103 yards on six carries – including a back-breaking 80-yard TD run one play after Tyler Guidry's interception in the end zone which helped Louisiana maintain a 7-0 lead.

The redshirt freshman came in after Wooldridge went down with a lower leg injury on the Cajuns' opening drive of the game.

After a scoreless first quarter, the game was halted for 1 hour, 51 minutes after heavy thunderstorms rolled through the Birmingham area.

Jacob Kibodi rushed for a career-high 108 yards – his second 100-yard game of his career and the first since rushing for a then 101 yards against Louisiana in 2017 when he played at Texas A&M. The senior opened the scoring for Louisiana when he scored untouched on a 30-yard run up the middle for a 7-0 lead.

LAFAYETTE – Zeon Chriss, in his first collegiate start at quarterback, rushed for a pair of touchdowns and passed for another and the Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns erupted for 35 points in the second half to earn a wild 45-38 win over Mid-American Conference member Buffalo on Saturday at Cajun Field.

Jacob Kibodi eclipsed the 100-yard rushing mark for the second consecutive game with 100 yards while Dre'lyn Washington recorded his first career 100-yard rushing game with 103 as Louisiana (3-1) gained a season-high 518 yards of total offense.

Patrick Mensah returned an interception 24 yards for a touchdown for Louisiana, which scored 40-plus points in consecutive games since 2019 against Texas Southern (77) and Ohio (45).

Chriss, who finished 22-for-29 through the air for a career-high 249 yards while rushing for 70 yards on 11 carries, was 16-for-22 for 159 yards in the first half and connected with Neal Johnson on an 8-yard scoring pass with 2:57 remaining in the first quarter to cap a seven-play, 49-yard drive.

Kenneth Almendares connected on a 22-yard field goal in the second quarter to extend his consecutive made streak to 17 – one shy of the school record – as Louisiana led 10-0 at the break.

Both teams picked up the pace in the second half with each team scoring three TDs in the third quarter as Louisiana maintained a 10-point lead (31-21). Buffalo (0-4) would score twice late in the fourth quarter with Jacqez Barksdale plunging in on a 1-yard run with 2:00 remaining and attempted to knot the game late before Tyree Skipper sealed the win for Louisiana with an interception off UB quarterback Cole Snyder.

MINNEAPOLIS – Big 10 Conference member Minnesota used a pair of second-half scoring drives and forced a pair of turnovers in the final 30 minutes to erase a halftime deficit and grind out a 35-24 victory before an announced crowd of 46,843 on Saturday at Huntington Bank Stadium.

Zach Evans, who rushed for a game-high 85 yards on 15 carries, scored on a go-ahead, 18-yard touchdown for Minnesota (3-2) on the opening drive of the third quarter while the Golden Gopher defense forced a pair of turnovers, controlled the football for over 21 minutes and held Louisiana (3-2) to 138 yards of total offense in the final 30 minutes.

Athan Kaliakmanis completed 12 of 14 passes for 146 yards for the Golden Gophers with scoring passes of 10 and 37 yards to Daniel Jackson.

Peter LeBlanc caught four passes to lead Louisiana, which outgained Minnesota, 349-347 overall, with Robert Williams recording three receptions.

LAFAYETTE – After struggling most of the afternoon to slow down Texas State's high-octane offense, Louisiana's defense forced two turnovers and had a blocked punt on the Bobcats' final four possessions at Cajun Field Saturday afternoon. Those stops helped set up Cajun quarterback Zeon Chriss, who accounted for two touchdowns in the final 5:54 to rally Louisiana from as much as a 13-point deficit and to a 34-30 Sun Belt Conference victory, their 10th in 10 tries against the Bobcats.

Chriss found Robert Williams over the middle for an 11-yard touchdown midway through the fourth quarter, his third touchdown pass of the game, to pull the Cajuns (4-2, 1-1 SBC) within 30-28.

Less than a minute later, the UL defense forced a punt from the Bobcats (4-2, 1-1 SBC) – their first of the game – and junior Dalen Cambre stormed in from the left side to block Seamus O'Kelly's punt. Ironically, Cambre had also blocked a punt against Texas State last year in the Cajuns' 41-13 win in San Marcos.

Patrick Mensah recovered the loose ball and returned it to the Bobcat 22, and four plays later Chriss sprinted eight yards around the right side for a touchdown that gave the Ragin' Cajuns their first lead of the game with 2:21 left.

Texas State, which finished with 530 offensive yards but had only one second-half touchdown, got as far as the Cajun 44 on its final possession when quarterback TJ Finley found Ashtyn Hawkins with a 14-yard screen pass. However, UL linebacker and team tackle leader K.C. Ossai knocked the ball loose from Hawkins, and Tyree Skipper returned the fumble to the Bobcat 15 with 1:19 left.

LAFAYETTE – Another potential epic Homecoming comeback came up just short for the Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns in its Sun Belt Conference contest against East Division rival Georgia State.

Gavin Pringle's interception in the end zone with 30 seconds remaining halted a potential game-winning drive and helped the Panthers stave off a furious rally and claim a 20-17 victory Saturday night at Cajun Field.

Louisiana (4-3, 1-2 SBC) trailed 20-0 in the second quarter before Jacob Kibodi scored on a 3-yard run to cut the GSU lead to 20-7 at intermission.

The Ragin' Cajuns added a 23-yard field goal midway through the third quarter by Kenneth Almendares before Zeon Chriss connected with Terrance Carter for a 2-yard scoring pass with 2:01 remaining in the third to cut the deficit to 20-17.

Louisiana, which rallied from homecoming deficits of 26 (1982, vs. then-Northeast Louisiana) and 21 points (2013, vs. New Mexico State), forced GSU to punt with 6:56 remaining and was ready for its third 20-point comeback. Chriss, who rushed for a game-high 119 yards, gained 34 yards on third-and-6 to the GSU 42 before later connecting with Robert Williams for a 10-yard pass to the Panther 23.

A pair of penalties forced Louisiana into a first-and-25 at the GSU 38, but after a 12-yard pass to Williams, Chriss would convert a third-and-13 with a 13-yard scramble to the Panther 13.

Kibodi's 7-yard run put the ball on the GSU 6 before the Panthers stopped Kibodi for a 1-yard loss on the following play and Pringle would pick off Chriss to seal the game.

MOBILE, Ala. – Zeon Chriss completed 13 of 17 passes for 145 yards and a pair of touchdowns while the Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns defense forced five turnovers and recorded five sacks in a 33-20 Sun Belt Conference victory over South Alabama on Saturday at Hancock Whitney Stadium.

Cameron Whitfield forced three fumbles and recorded 3.5 sacks while Tyrone Lewis intercepted a pair of fourth-quarter passes as Louisiana (5-3, 2-2 SBC) led 17-0 at halftime before scoring twice after USA (4-4, 2-2 SBC) cut the lead to 20-14 on La'Damian Webb's 25-yard run in the third quarter.

Louisiana responded on Webb's TD as the Cajuns drove 75 yards in five plays with Jacob Kibodi scoring a 56-yard run up the middle as part of a career-high 119 yards on the ground. The Ragin' Cajuns would force a Jaguar fumble as Whitfield stripped Carter Bradley of the ball and Kendre' Gant scooped it up and ran 55 yards for a touchdown and a 33-14 lead with 1:07 remaining in the third quarter.

After a scoreless first quarter, Louisiana stuffed the Jaguars for a 1-yard loss on fourth-and-1 at the UL 6 and proceeded to drive 93 yards in 12 plays to take a 7-0 lead.

Louisiana benefited from an offside penalty on fourth-and-3 at the UL 47 before Chriss connected with Jacob Bernard six plays later on a 33-yard scoring pass.

Whitfield and Nijel McGriff combined for the first of two strip-sacks and fumble recoveries as McGriff recovered Bradley's fumble at the UL 41. Seven plays later, Chriss found Neal Johnson in the end zone for a 3-yard scoring pass with Kenneth Almendares' kick giving Louisiana a 14-0 lead with 8:15 left.
