## Noting the Golden Eagles

- Southern Miss plays in its 107th football season in 2023, having first fielded a team in 1912. The Golden Eagles are 615-460-27, which is 43rd best among FBS teams by winning percentage (.571).
- The Golden Eagles opened play in their fourth different conference of their football history in 2022, after holding a spot in the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Association from 1931-41, the Gulf States Conference from 1948-1951 and Conference USA from 1996-2021.
- Heading into 2023, the program has collected 24 winning seasons since the start of the 1994 season and appeared in 19 bowl games during that time.
- Overall, Southern Miss has enjoyed 74 winning seasons and five years of .500 football over its history. Since 2000, the Golden Eagles will have 18 of 24 winning seasons.
- Against the current membership of the Sun Belt Conference, the Golden Eagles are 78-37-1 versus league foes, having never met James Madison.
- The 2022 LendingTree Bowl was the 27th bowl appearance for the Golden Eagles as they hold an 12-15 record overall in postseason games.
- Southern Miss plays six opponents with "State" in its name this season. It will be the most games in a season for the Golden Eagles against "State" schools.

## Against ULM

- The Golden Eagles and Warhawks play for the eighth time in the two school's football histories and the second time as members of the Sun Belt Conference with the Golden Eagles leading 5-2 in the series.
- Southern Miss got 199 yards on the ground from Frank Gore, Jr., in the inaugural Sun Belt Conference meeting between the two schools as the Golden Eagles pulled out a 20-10 decision in a rain-soaked Monroe last season (see page 3 of the notes for the recap).
- USM dropped a 21-20 decision the last time these two teams met in 2018 at The Rock.
- As a youngster, Golden Eagle coach Will Hall attended the Florida State QB camp, where Terry Bowden was one of the coaches.
- The two men battled against each other as head coaches twice during the same season in 2011 before meeting again last season. Coach Hall won during the regular season leading West Alabama over North Alabama, 31-26, but dropped a 43-27 decision in the NCAA Division II playoffs. Both games were played in Livingston, Ala.
- Three ULM assistant coaches worked at Southern Miss, including OC/QB coach Matt Kubik, who held the same post for Southern Miss in 2020, and WR coach John Carr, who was the school's Director of Football Operations from 2013-14, while Broderick Fobbs was an assistant coach on the 2012 coaching staff overseeing the WRs. ULM's Director of Football Relations, Patrick McGee, worked as a recruiting coordinator under former Coach Larry Fedora.
- The Golden Eagles have nine players on the roster from the state of Louisiana, while the Warhawks have 10 on their roster from the state of Mississippi.

## 200-Yard Rushing Games

Frank Gore, Jr., recorded the 14th 200-yard rushing game in school history last Saturday by producing 247 yards on 24 carries at App State. Nine different Golden Eagle backs have produced this feat for the school, including Damion Fletcher who did it three times during his career. Gore, Jr., Derrick Nix and quarterback Vic Purvis, have all done it twice. The 247 yards from Gore, Jr., last week is the fourth-best rushing game in school history. Gore, Jr., also has the school's top rushing game with 329 versus Rice in the LendingTree Bowl last season.

## November Games

The Golden Eagles hold a 212-153-11 record (.593) in games played in the month of November in their long, storied history. The Golden Eagles posted undefeated and untied records this calendar month 16 times. Southern Miss has gone 5-0 in this month twice in history, including the 1980 and 1988 seasons.

## Will Hall

### Head Football Coach | Third Season - 11-22 (.333) / Overall - Ninth Season 67-42 (.615)

At his introductory press conference in December of 2020 as the 22nd head coach of Southern Miss football, Will Hall spoke about how 'attitude is everything' in his initial comments to those in attendance at Reed Green Coliseum.

That attitude has provided a relentlessly positive approach in how he has communicated and prepared his players, elevated the growth of every facet of this football program, while also energizing a fan base since first taking the stage as the Golden Eagles top football coach. In his opening season for the Golden Eagles, adversity struck hard for the program as the Golden Eagles saw most of their quarterback corps go down due to injury during the early portion of the season. Despite that fact, the Golden Eagles remained upbeat each week and transitioned its offense that many fans dubbed the "Superback" featuring a running back overseeing the offense from a shotgun position toward the latter part of the campaign.

That transition allowed the Golden Eagles to win two of their final three games of the campaign, while also almost knocking off the league champion, UTSA.

Hall also oversaw a Nasty Bunch defense that provided many highlights, including holding its opponents to the second fewest first downs in the country (197), while collecting the fourth most fumble recoveries (13). The defense gave up just 358.5 yards per game, which ranked No. 3 in Conference USA and No. 42 in the country. Southern Miss bettered their national ranking in total defense by 18 spots from the previous year.

In year two, the Golden Eagles made great strides in the school's first year in the Sun Belt, bettering their win total by four from the previous season and reaching a bowl game for the first time since the 2019 season. The Golden Eagles defeated Rice, 38-24, in the LendingTree Bowl in Mobile, Ala., behind a school-record 329 rushing yards from Frank Gore, Jr., to give the school its first bowl win since 2016.

The Golden Eagles were also one of 16 FBS programs to play 10-win teams during the year and Hall registered arguably his biggest win of his early tenure in Hattiesburg against his old program, Tulane, 27-24, in New Orleans.

At one point during the 2022 campaign, Southern Miss captured three-straight victories and won five of six games over that stretch.

His total offense national ranking jumped 28 spots from the previous season as USM ranked No. 8 in passing yards per completion (14.13), while Gore, Jr., became the school's first 1,000-yard rusher since Ito Smith in 2017.

On defense, the unit ranked No.2 in tackles for loss (8.3 per game), No. 3 nationally in fourth down conversions (.231), No. 4 in sacks (3.38 per game) and defensive touchdowns (4), No. 7 in interceptions (17). On special teams, the Golden Eagles ranked fifth in blocked kicks (5), No. 14 in blocked punts (2) and No. 19 in punt returns (11.92).

Over his first two seasons, Hall has put together his roster of mostly Mississippi players and the 2022 roster had 67 percent represented by the Magnolia State.

Hall, a native of Amory, Miss., came to Southern Miss after serving the previous two years as offensive coordinator at Tulane.

Hall made an immediate impact on the Tulane offense and helped the Green Wave rewrite their offensive record books. He helped Tulane post one of the most successful offensive seasons in program history in 2019. The Green Wave finished the season ranked 11th in the nation in rushing offense (243.2), 22nd in total offense (449.3) and 30th in scoring offense (33.1). Hall helped the Green Wave rush for over 200 yards in nine games in 2019 and over 300 times four times.

The Tulane offense set the program record in rushing yards at 3,162 yards in 2019. The offense ranked second in program history in rushing yards per game (243.2), rushing touchdowns (33) and rushing first downs (166).

Tulane's offense also eclipsed 500 yards five times, including a season-high 634 total yards against UConn. The Green Wave also set a season-high in passing yards against the Huskies with 323.

In 2020, the Green Wave enjoyed more success offensively as they finished No. 17 nationally in rushing offense (217.1), No. 19 in first downs (258) and No. 22 in scoring offense (34.7), while adding two more 500-yard total offensive games to his resume.

Hall joined the Green Wave coaching staff after he spent the 2018 campaign as the Associate Head Coach/Tight Ends Coach at Memphis where he helped guide the Tigers to the American Athletic Conference Championship game for the second straight season and helped the Tigers to their fifth straight bowl appearance.

During his lone season at Memphis, Hall helped guide the Tigers to a school record with 42 rushing touchdowns during the regular season. In addition, Memphis finished

the regular season with 3,311 rushing yards, setting a new school record.

Memphis' offense ranked in the nation's top 10 in rushing (No. 5, 275.9), scoring offense (No. 6, 43.8) and total offense (No. 6, 530.3). In addition, Hall helped four Memphis offensive players earn All-AAC honors.

Hall joined the Memphis staff in January 2018 after spending the 2017 season as the offensive coordinator for the Louisiana-Lafayette Ragin' Cajuns, where six offensive players received all-conference honors. The Cajuns ranked among the best in the nation in red zone offense and turnovers lost with just 16.

In his one season as offensive coordinator at Louisiana, the Ragin' Cajuns compiled the Sun Belt's third-best rushing offense with 2,204 yards and 27 rushing touchdowns. The Louisiana offense tied for the second-fewest turnovers in the SBC during the 2017 season. The Cajuns were also efficient in the red zone, leading the Sun Belt by scoring on 92.9-percent of their red zone chances.

In his three-year head coaching stint at West Georgia (UWG), Hall led the Wolves to a 31-9 record, the first Gulf South Conference (GSC) title since 2000 and a pair of NCAA Division II semifinal appearances. His first two seasons at UWG produced a pair of 12-win seasons before he finished 7-4 in 2016.

Success was immediate for Hall as the Wolves set multiple school records, won their first GSC title in 14 years and reached the NCAA Division II playoffs.

Under his direction, a program that had not made an impact in the conference, much less nationally, in over a decade transformed into the talk of the nation in NCAA Division II. Under Hall's direction, the Wolves were nationally ranked for 17 weeks consecutively and earned the program's first No. 1 national ranking on Oct. 26, 2015.

Hall's first UWG squad in 2014 caught more than a few people by surprise. The Wolves finished the regular season strong with a 9-2 record and earned the program's first NCAA playoffs bid since 2000. Road wins at Tuskegee, Delta State, and Valdosta State were the first postseason victories in the school's Division II history and gave UWG the NCAA Super Region 2 title.

Though UWG caught no one by surprise in 2015, it didn't matter. Hall's juggernaut roared through the first nine games of the regular season, all wins, and none were closer than a 17-point margin. A three-touchdown, Week 8 win over nationally ranked North Alabama pushed the Wolves into the top spot in the nation in Division II for the first time in school history.

Hall was twice named GSC Coach of the Year and was the Super Region 2 Coach of the Year.

In his first season at West Georgia, more than 30 team and individual records fell. In addition to setting records, the Wolves hauled in individual accolades.

Sixteen players earned All-Gulf South Conference recognition and seven received All-American distinction, which included the program's first Academic All-American in Alex Macaulay.

From 2011-13 as the head coach at West Alabama, his teams won two league titles and twice earned spots in the NCAA Division II Playoffs.

Hall's players also have had success at the next level, and among that group of honored athletes is 2015 Super Bowl hero and current Tennessee Titan Malcolm Butler, who was a two-time All-GSC performer for Hall at West Alabama. In the spring of 2016, offensive tackle Dominique Robertson became the first UWG player in school history to earn an invite to the NFL Draft Combine.

Prior to his six seasons at West Alabama, Hall enjoyed successful stints on the coaching staff at Arkansas-Monticello, Southwest Baptist, Henderson State, and Presbyterian. Hall's achievements in the coaching profession are a carryover from his illustrious career on the playing field at North Alabama.

Hall played for his father, Bobby Hall, at Amory High School leading the Panthers to the 1998 Class 3A state title. From 1999-2000, he attended Northwest Mississippi Community College, where he was a two-time National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) All-American.

In 2000, Hall set a NJCAA record for total offense in a season (4,075 yards) and added an NJCAA single-game record with nine touchdown passes.

Hall then moved to North Alabama, where he was a quarterback for the Lions from 2002-03. He won the Harlan Hill Trophy in 2003, emblematic of being America's top player in NCAA Division II. In 2003, Hall, who threw for 3,531 yards and 30 touchdowns, led the Lions to a 13-1 record and an NCAA Division II semifinals appearance.

In 2004, Hall signed a contract to play for the Tupelo FireAnts of the National Indoor Football League. Playing once again for his father, who was the head coach for the team, Hall passed for 2,046 yards and 44 touchdowns while rushing for 13 scores in the 14-game season.

A 2003 graduate of North Alabama, Hall, and wife Rebecca, have two sons - Tripp and Pete.

## Last Time Versus ULM

### Southern Miss 20, ULM 10

Nov. 26, 2022

**MONROE, La.** -- Frank Gore, Jr. ran for 199 yards and a key touchdown and Southern Miss became bowl eligible by defeating ULM 20-10 at Malone Stadium in the 2022 regular-season finale.

The Golden Eagles (6-6, 4-4 Sun Belt) qualified for a bowl for the 19th time since 1997 and returned to the postseason for the first time since 2019.

Gore, Jr. finished the regular season with 1,053 yards and reached 1,000 yards for the first time in his three years with the Golden Eagles. He marks the first 1,000 rusher for Southern Miss since Ito Smith did it in 2017.

His rushing performance was the best at the school since Smith collected 219 at ULM in 2017.

Trey Lowe's 29-yard short shovel touchdown pass to Jakarius Caston got the Golden Eagles on the board and Briggs Bourgeois added two short field goals.

Between Briggs Bourgeois's field goals, the Warhawks (4-8, 3-5) scored on a 23-yard pass from Chandler Rogers to Andrew Henry and a 37-yard field goal by Calum Sutherland. UL Monroe trailed 13-10 before Gore sealed the win for Southern Miss with a 33-yard touchdown run midway through the fourth quarter.

Rogers completed 17 of 27 passes for 122 yards and Lowe was 10-of-16 for 170 yards.

## #MississippiMade

Of the 107 players listed on the Southern Miss 2023 football roster, 71 Golden Eagles come from Mississippi (66.4%), representing 49 different Magnolia State communities. The city of Hattiesburg leads the way with six Golden Eagles, followed by five from Brandon and four from Madison. The cities of Fayette, Greenwood, Gulfport, Lake Cormorant, Lucedale, Magee, Oxford, Purvis, Starkville and Tylertown are next with two players each.

### Notes from the App State Game

- Southern Miss recorded a season-high 588 total yards as well as a season-best 301 rushing yards.
- The Golden Eagles opened the game with a touchdown, which was culminated on a 16-yard pass from Billy Wiles to Latreal Jones. It snapped an eight-quarter streak without an offensive touchdown.
- It was the third time this season the Golden Eagles has scored on their opening drive - all coming against ASU schools - Alcorn State, Arkansas State and App State.
- Freshman QB Ethan Crawford made his first Golden Eagle appearance on the second drive of the game. He later scored on a 10-yard run in the second quarter for his first career Southern Miss rushing touchdown.
- Ti Mims registered a career-high for both catches (10) and yards (141) as it was his first career 100-yard receiving game. He is the first Golden Eagle to collect 10 catches in a game since Jason Brownlee had 10 versus Troy last season.
- Jakarius Caston collected his first career rushing score on 11-yard run early in the fourth quarter.
- Jay Stanley notched his third interception of the season and 10th of his career late in the second.
- Jalil Clemons forced his second fumble of the year and Averie Habas recovered it. Clemons finished with a team-high nine tackles to go along with 2.5 sacks and 3.5 tackles for loss.
- Andrew Stein had a string of three consecutive makes snapped when his second-quarter, 31-yarder hit the right upright. He started a new streak with a 42-yard make with 2:05 before halftime and now has hit at least one field goal in all eight games this season. Stein is now 1-for-2 for his career from 50-plus yard field goal attempts as he missed a 50-yarder at the end of the first half.

### Overtime Anyone?

Southern Miss has been involved in 13 overtime games since the rule went into effect prior to the 1996 season and the Golden Eagles are 5-8 overall, after falling to Liberty 29-27 in the school's longest game in their history. Eleven of the 13 games that have taken OT were Conference USA contests when they were members of that league. Here is a look of all the overtime games Southern Miss has played:

### Golden Eagles Enjoying Second Season in Sun Belt Conference

- After spending 26 seasons in Conference USA, the Golden Eagles played in their inaugural Sun Belt Conference season last fall.
- The Golden Eagles are part of a 14-team Sun Belt that are separated in the East (App State, Coastal Carolina, Georgia Southern, Georgia State, James Madison, Marshall and Old Dominion) and West (Arkansas State, Louisiana, South Alabama, Southern Miss, Texas State, Troy and ULM) division. JMU, ODU and Marshall joined the Golden Eagles as first-year members during the 2022 season.
- Southern Miss played at Troy for its first Sun Belt contest on Oct. 8, 2022, dropping a 27-10 decision.
- Southern Miss won five Conference USA titles during its tenure, including one since divisional play started in 2005. They captured their only league title contest and the school's fifth overall C-USA league crown when they beat Houston, 49-28, in 2011.
- The school's other C-USA titles came in the inaugural season of 1996 as well as the 1997, 1999 and 2003 campaigns. The Golden Eagles also won two East Division crowns in C-USA (2006, 2011), and captured their first West title in 2015 after moving to that division during the 2014 campaign. Southern Miss won its third division title in 2015, but lost in the C-USA championship game at WKU, 45-28. Southern Miss were 1-2 in C-USA title games.
- Along with the five C-USA titles, the Golden Eagles also won three additional league titles - 1948, 1950, 1951 - when they were members of the Gulf States Conference.

## Pro Traditions

Southern Miss, which has a reputation in training and producing professional talent over the years, has a long list of former players that have reached the NFL including the likes of Ray Guy, Brett Favre, Sammy Winder, Michael Boley and Jamie Collins. Southern Miss has had at least one player drafted in 16 of the last 24 NFL drafts. Since 1942, 127 players have been drafted by the NFL, AFL or AAFC, which including a school-best four on nine different occasions.

## Southern Miss Preseason All-Conference Selections

Southern Miss junior running back/all-purpose back Frank Gore, Jr. and senior defensive back Jay Stanley were named Preseason First Team All-Sun Belt, while senior defensive lineman Jalen Williams was tabbed Preseason Second Team All-Sun Belt. The Golden Eagles were picked to finish fourth in the West Division in a vote released by the league's 14 head coaches.

Gore, Jr. put on a record-breaking performance in Southern Miss' 38-24 LendingTree Bowl win over Rice, rushing for an FBS and school-record 329 yards on 21 carries -- averaged 17.5 yards per carry. He had touchdown runs of 64 and 55 yards that helped him land on the Associated Press and PFF All-Bowl Teams. Gore, Jr. rushed for 1,382 yards on the season and averaged 106.3 per game, a career best. He scored nine touchdowns on the ground and added four more in the air. He was named First Team All-Sun Belt (AP), Second Team All-Sun Belt (RB), Phil Steele's Second Team All-Sun Belt and PFF First Team All-Sun Belt.

Stanley played in all 13 games last season and recorded seven interceptions. The Greenwood, Miss. native posted a career-best 64 total tackles and had 4.5 tackles for loss. Stanley added 1.5 sacks and 12 pass deflections. He was named Third Team All-Sun Belt, Phil Steele's Second Team All-Sun Belt, PFF First Team All-Sun Belt and an Action Network Second Team All-Sun Belt.

Williams was named All-Sun Belt Honorable Mention last season after starting the final 11 games of the season at nose tackle. He finished fifth on the team in tackles (50.0) and fifth in tackles for loss (7.5). The Tylertown, Miss., product blocked an extra point against Louisiana and had a season-high nine tackles against Georgia State.

## The Offensive Line

The offensive line starters stayed the same for the first five games of 2023 which had included Briason Mays (LT), Gerquan Scott (LG), Bryce Ramsey (C), John Bolding (RG) and Kyron Barnes (RT), before changing over the next two games. In the ODU and South Alabama games, Mays moved from left tackle to right tackle, while Scott moved from left guard to center. Both Gabe Cavazos (LT) and Matt Ryals (LG) made their first starts of 2023. Bolding stayed at right guard. Game nine's starters at App State mostly resembled the first group to start the season, except for Mays staying at RT and Gabe Cavazos starting at LT. The composite starting line over the first seven games has now combined for 116 career starts. Senior Gerquan Scott has the most starts with 37 in a row for the Golden Eagles. The line helped Southern Miss finish No. 8 nationally a year ago in passing yards per completion (14.13).

## Billy Wiles Has Been the Signal Caller in 2023

Redshirt sophomore transfer Billy Wiles was named the opening day starter at quarterback for the Golden Eagles and responded with a 21-for-28 performance for 267 yards and three touchdowns with one interception versus Alcorn State. Wiles became the fourth-straight different starting quarterback to open the season for Southern Miss and eighth since the start of the 2012 campaign. It was the first three touchdown pass performance since Ty Keyes threw for that many off the bench against Northwestern State (9/17) last season. Wiles has started all eight games for the Golden Eagles and threw for a season-high 287 yards and a touchdowns at App State. In his first eight starts, he has thrown for 1,546 yards on 132-of-246 passes with eight touchdown passes and five interceptions. He is the first Golden Eagle quarterback to start in each of the first eight games in a season since Jack Abraham did it in 2019.

## Gore Leads the Running Backs

Frank Gore, Jr., put himself in the ranks of the all-time Golden Eagle running back greats by finishing last year with 1,382 rushing yards, after ending the campaign with a 199-yard performance at ULM to cap the regular season before posting a school-record and FBS bowl record 329 yards in the LendingTree Bowl against Rice.

Last season's rushing total ranks as the sixth best single-season rushing effort in school history. After collecting a team-best total of 681 yards in the first eight games in 2023 following a 247-yard performance at App State, Gore now sits at 3,572 career yards, placing him in fifth place at the school. He trails Derrick Nix for fourth by 12 yards and Ben Garry for third by 23 yards.

Gore, Jr., has led the team in rushing in each of the last three seasons and was the school's first 1,000-yard rusher since Ito Smith did it in 2017. He was a second-team All-Conference USA running back in 2020, an honorable mention pick by the league in 2021 and was a first-team selection last fall at all-purpose back and second team running back in the school's first year of the Sun Belt Conference.

His 11, 100-yard rushing games puts him tied for 5th place on Golden Eagle charts for that category with Sam DeJarnette (1982-84).

## Cole Cavallo Excelling at Tight End

Cole Cavallo was expected to start in the season opener, but was hurt in pregame warm ups and ended up missing the first four games. Since his return over the last four games, Cavallo has five catches for 44 yards. He started 11 times in 2022, 19 for his career, and now played in 51 career games. He enjoyed his best night as a Golden Eagle versus Coastal Carolina last season with career highs for catches (4) and receiving yards (46). This came a week after catching his first career TD pass versus Georgia State. His season totals for catches (19) and receiving yards (163) are season-bests as he has 41 career catches for 388 yards.

## Ti Mims Enjoys Best Receiving Game at App State

Ti Mims enjoyed his best day at receiver last weekend at App State with 10 catches for 141 yards. It was third 100-yard receiving game for the Golden Eagles this season and both the catches and yardage were season bests for the team. Mims entered that weekend with 20 catches for 213 yards, ranking third on the team in both of those categories.

## The Other Two Receivers

Jakarius Caston and Latreal Jones have led the Golden Eagle receivers this season as each posted a 100-yard receiving game in 2023. Caston collected his first 100-yard receiving game in the opener as he caught five passes for 104 yards against Alcorn State. Latreal Jones added his first against Texas State, making six grabs for 124 yards. Jones notched a career-best seven catches against Tulane this season, while Caston collected a career-best of eight grabs last season at Tulane. Jones leads the way with 30 catches for 412 yards, while Caston has 24 receptions for 368 yards. Caston now also has 71 career catches for 1,053 yards.

## Nasty Bunch Continuing with Solid Performances Under Hall

The Southern Miss defense, dubbed the Nasty Bunch, opened the 2023 campaign by allowing just 226 yards in the opener against Alcorn State, before giving up 554 at Florida State, 314 versus Tulane, 425 in their Sun Belt opener to Arkansas State, 516 yards to Texas State, 337 to ODU and 571 to App State.

In 2022, the Golden Eagles allowed an average of 372.2 yards per game (No. 58). They limited Liberty to just 194 yards over the first three quarters, while holding Miami to 10 points in the opening half and gave up only 198 yards to Tulane in the second half.

They held Arkansas State to 50 yards rushing, forced negative six yards rushing at Texas State, before restricting Louisiana to 69 yards rushing. At Coastal Carolina, after giving up 176 yards in the opening quarter, the defense held the Chanticleers to just 185 yards the remainder of the contest and forced three turnovers versus South Alabama before keeping ULM to only 232 total yards. Southern Miss held Rice to 55 total yards in the final period, including minus-six yards rushing to capture the LendingTree Bowl. They produced 22 turnovers, including a season-high four versus Louisiana, three versus Liberty and two at Troy and CCU.

USM limited their opponents to 23.5 points per game, which ranked No. 44 in the FBS.

Southern Miss finished 2021 at No. 42 nationally in total defense, allowing 358.5 yards per contest. The group finished No. 73 in the country in rushing defense (156.5 ypg), holding opponents to under 100 yards on the ground three times, and 24th in passing yards allowed at 202.0 per game.

## Jalil Clemons Enjoys Solid Performance Versus App State

After missing two games, Jalil Clemons came back in force against App State with a team-high nine tackles. He forced a fumble late in the opening half which accounted for a turnover and also added 2.5 sacks and 3.5 tackles for loss, both career highs.

### Jay Stanley Returns as Top Defender

The returning second team All-America selection by Action Network at safety, earned third-team all-Sun Belt by the coaches, first team by PFF and second team by Phil Steele. Stanley started in all 13 games as free safety and tallied 60 tackles (27 solo) with 4.5 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks. He led the team with five interceptions for 17 yards and added seven breakups. His starts also included forcing three fumbles and recovered one.

In 2022, Stanley registered a season-high nine tackles (four solo) against Troy (10/8). He forced fumbles against Texas State (10/22), Louisiana (10/27) and Georgia State (11/5) and picked off passes against Northwestern State (9/17), Troy (10/8), Coastal Carolina (11/12), South Alabama (11/19) and Rice (12/17) in the LendingTree Bowl. His accolades also include earning preseason All-Sun Belt honors by Phil Steele Magazine by being named third team all-league.

In his first game of his senior season, Stanley picked off two, first-quarter passes, had a pair of pass breakups and tallied three tackles (two solo). He now has nine career interceptions. Stanley also collected a team-high seven tackles with a forced fumble and a pass breakup against Florida State. Versus Tulane, Stanley recorded a career-best 10 tackles. He got four tackles at Arkansas State and ran down a Texas State player on an 89-yard pass play forcing him to fumble at the one into the end zone for a touchback. He also added four tackles. He collected five tackles versus ODU and missed the South Alabama game due to injury. Versus App State, he collected five tackles - one for a TFL - and one interception.

### The D-Line Keeps Things Stuffed Up Front

The defensive line racked up last year for the Golden Eagles as they made plays each week. In fact, four defensive linemen each tallied 32 or more tackles last season are back in 2023. Those players include Jalen Williams, who tallied 50 stops (18 solo) last fall, as well as 38 from Josh Ratcliff, who also blocked an extra point at Coastal Carolina, 36 for Kristin Booth and 32 from Quentin Bivens. Those four also combined for the 22 of the Golden Eagles 108 tackles for loss for the year. Williams led the defensive linemen in tackles for loss with 7.5, while Bivens paced the group in sacks with 5.5.

In 2023, Williams and Bivens leads the Golden Eagle defensive linemen in tackles with 23 each, while Demeco Roland and Ratcliff are next at 22.

### Veteran Linebacking Corps Returns

With the return of Hayes Maples and Swayze Bozeman at linebacker this fall, the Golden Eagles return two players that missed much, if not all, of last season due to injury. The duo now has 47 and 33 games played, respectively, for the Golden Eagles. Maples missed all last season with an injury while Bozeman collected 16 tackles (5 solo) in four games played before missing the remainder of the campaign due to injury.

Maples has played in all eight games this season and has totalled 33 tackles including a season-high seven stops against Old Dominion. Bozeman has missed a pair of games, but also has 34 tackles including a career-high 12 versus South Alabama.

One other senior linebacker, Averie Habas, returned to practice the week of the Texas State and made his first appearance against the Bobcats after suffering a non-football medical issue that had kept him off the field through fall camp and the first four weeks of practice. In his first start back versus ODU, he collected a career-best two sacks.

### New Specialists Set to Take Over in 2023

Freshman Connor Gibbs (Metairie, La.) holds the kickoff duties, while redshirt junior Andrew Stein (Slidell, La.) handles field goals and extra points, and redshirt sophomore Bryce Lofton (Sand Hill, Miss.) takes over the punting duties after the loss of PK Briggs Bourgeois and P Mason Hunt from 2022.

Gibbs started the year with 35 kickoffs for a 61.1 yard average, while Lofton has punted 37 times for a 39.7 yard average. Stein has converted 15-of-19 field goals and 18 of 19 extra points in 2023.

Stein is the only Golden Eagle specialist who had seen playing time prior to this year, having now appeared in 26 career games (13 in 2019) and is now 33-of-40 on field goals and 54-of-58 on PATs.

# Game Recaps

## Game 1: at Southern Miss 40, Alcorn State 14 (Sept. 2, 2023)

**HATTIESBURG, Miss. (AP)** – Billy Wiles threw for 267 yards and three touchdowns and Southern Miss was never threatened in a 40-14 season-opening win over Alcorn State on Saturday night at Carlisle-Faulkner Field at M.M. Roberts Stadium.

It was the first time Golden Eagle coach Will Hall has captured his season opener in three seasons.

The Golden Eagles' Jay Stanley came up with the first of two interceptions against Alcorn State quarterback Tyler Macon on the second play from scrimmage. Southern Miss took advantage and went up 7-0 when Wiles threw a 16-yard score to Jakarius Caston. After forcing the Braves to three-and-out, Frank Gore Jr. ended a seven-play, 63-yard drive for a two-score lead on a 9-yard run. Gore later added a 9-yard scoring reception from Wiles later in the opening half.

After a field goal put the Eagles up 17-0, with 3:50 left in the first quarter, Macon raced 75 yards for a touchdown for Alcorn State's biggest highlight of the contest. The play accounted for a third of the Braves' yardage total (226).

Wiles, who was making his first start for the Golden Eagles, finished 21-of-28 passing and Caston finished with five receptions for 104 yards and a score. It was Caston's first 100-yard receiving game of his career.

Stanley registered the first multiple interception game for the Golden Eagles since Ky'el Hemby by collecting two picks versus UTEP on Nov. 24, 2018.

Golden Eagle kicker Andrew Stein went four-for-four in field goal attempts, hitting from 25, 23, 52 and 41 yards. It was the first time since the 2019 season, spanning 1,371 days, that he attempted a field goal for the Golden Eagles.

## Game 2: at No. 4 Florida State 66, Southern Miss 13 (Sept. 9, 2023)

**TALLAHASSEE, Fla. (AP)** – Trey Benson had three touchdown runs and No. 4 Florida State defeated Southern Miss 66-13 in its home opener Saturday night for the most points under coach Mike Norvell.

Jordan Travis threw for 175 yards and two touchdowns, and backup Tate Rodemaker added a pair of touchdown passes in the third quarter. Travis' first touchdown, a 10-yard pass to Darion Williamson, gave him 50 career TD passes.

The Seminoles (2-0) have scored 35 or more points in eight straight games, the longest active streak in the nation. On Saturday, they did it in the third quarter — and before Southern Miss (1-1) found the end zone.

Caziah Holmes added a 40-yard touchdown run as the Seminoles ran for 306 yards. Florida State was able to move the ball at will even without starting offensive linemen Maurice Smith and Robert Scott.

Dreke Clark had 67 yards on 12 carries, including a 12-yard touchdown in the third quarter for Southern Miss, while Billy Wiles completed just 11 of 34 passes for 154 yards in his second college start for the Golden Eagles.

Andrew Stein also converted field goals of 30 and 40 yards as he has now collected eight-straight made field goals.

## Game 4: at Arkansas State 44, Southern Miss 37 (Sept. 23, 2023)

**JONESBORO, Ark.** – Dominic Zvada belted a 21-yard field goal and quarterback Jaylen Raynor added a 62-yard scoring run just over a minute later deep in the fourth quarter to lift Arkansas State to a 44-37 Sun Belt Conference opener win over Southern Miss at Centennial Bank Stadium.

The late Red Wolves rally spoiled a 17-point, second-half comeback by the Golden Eagles as they dropped their third game in a row.

Frank Gore, Jr., rushed for a game-high 132 yards, putting him over 3,000 yards for his career as it also marked the ninth 100-yard rushing game of his career, tying him for sixth with Sammy Winder and Shelton Gandy.

After opening the game with a 12-play, 84-yard drive that was culminated on a two-yard Gore, Jr., run, the Red Wolves scored on their first four drives, taking advantage of a Southern Miss interception on their second drive and a blocked punt on their third drive which turned into 10 additional points for the home team.

Down just 20-17 at the half, A-State scored on their first two possessions of the second half, including a 60-yard pass from Raynor to Clayton Jackson on the first play of the third period. Raynor, who threw for 233 yards and three touchdowns on 11-of-22 passing with an interception, then added a eight-yard scoring rush some five minutes late to give the Red Wolves its biggest lead at 34-17.

The Golden Eagles rallied as Dreke Clark collected a 59-yard scoring run – the longest rushing play of the year for Southern Miss – and Andrew Stein converted the second of three field goals, from 42 yards out with 3:10 left in the third.

Southern Miss then tied the game at 34-34 on a 22-yard pass from Billy Wiles to Jakarius Caston early in the fourth quarter. Wiles finished with a season-high 215 on 20-of-36 passing with two interceptions and two TD passes.

Southern Miss fell to 7-1 under Will Hall when they scored 30 points in a game.

# Game Recaps

## Game 5: Texas State 50, at Southern Miss 36 (Sept. 30, 2023)

**HATTIESBURG, Miss. (AP)** — Ismail Mahdi returned the opening kickoff 100 yards for a touchdown and added three rushing touchdowns to highlight Texas State's 50-36 Sun Belt Conference victory over Southern Miss at M.M. Roberts Stadium.

Mahdi nearly had a fifth touchdown on a bizarre play in the third quarter. Bobcats quarterback TJ Finley was about to be sacked deep in Texas State territory but managed to flip the ball forward to Mahdi who took off down the sideline. As he approached the end zone, Southern Miss defensive back Jay Stanley knocked the ball loose and it bounced out of bounds in the end zone. The play was first ruled a touchdown, but the call was reversed and Mahdi was left with a 90-yard reception and a fumble for a touchback.

Texas State led 42-16 at the time but the Golden Eagles rallied, scoring touchdowns on their next three possessions for a 42-36 deficit. The Bobcats, who scored 42 points in the first half, finally got on the board again with a 14-yard run by Malik Hornsby with 1:39 left in the game. It was only a 3-play, 18-yard drive after the Bobcats stopped the Golden Eagles on downs.

Finley completed 19 of 24 passes for 339 yards with two touchdowns for Texas State (4-1, 1-0 Sun Belt). Mahdi had 89 yards rushing, 90 yards receiving and 117 yards in kick returns. Joey Hobert had 126 yards on 10 receptions and Ashtyn Hawkins caught five for 101 yards.

Billy Wiles went 21-for-45 for 275 yards with two touchdowns and an interception for Southern Miss (1-4, 0-2). Frank Gore Jr. had two touchdowns and 123 rushing yards and Latreal Jones had six receptions for 124 yards.

For Gore, it was his 10th 100-yard rushing game, which puts him in sixth place by himself on the school charts, while Jones added his first 100-yard receiving game. Wiles' passing total also was a season-high for the first-year Golden Eagles quarterback.

## Game 6: Old Dominion 17, at Southern Miss 13 (Oct. 7, 2023)

**HATTIESBURG, Miss. (AP)** — Keyshawn Wicks scored the go-ahead touchdown early in the fourth quarter, Jason Henderson made a fourth-down stop on a goal line stand, and Old Dominion defeated Southern Miss 17-13 on Saturday night, ruining the school's homecoming contest.

After Wicks scored his second touchdown on a 16-yard run with 1:19 remaining, Southern Miss drove 74 yards in 13 plays and faced fourth-and-goal at the 1-yard line. Frank Gore Jr. took a direct snap and was stopped by Henderson. It was the 17th tackle of the game for ODU's career leader in that category, which was established earlier in the game.

Old Dominion then ran off the final 3-5-1. Southern Miss took a 10-lead on the first of two Andrew Stein field goals and an 82-yard punt return by Ti Mims. The Golden Eagles led 10-7 at halftime and 13-10 heading to the fourth quarter. Mims had another punt return for a touchdown called back, when officials determined that he gave a fair catch signal after an official review.

ODU's Grant Wilson completed 8 of 18 passes for 194 yards and his 39-yard completion to Ahmarian Granger helped set up Wicks' go-ahead touchdown. Kadarius Calloway had 93 yards rushing for the Monarchs (3-3, 2-1 Sun Belt Conference).

Southern Miss defender, Averie Habas, who was thought to miss the whole season with a non-football medical issue, returned last weekend against Texas State briefly before starting in this game for the Golden Eagles and registering a pair of sacks.

**BOONE, N.C.** — Joey Aguilar threw for 391 yards and four touchdowns, App State scored three fourth-quarter touchdowns, and the Mountaineers rallied for a 48-38 win over Southern Miss Saturday evening.

Jakarius Caston's 11-yard scoring run 59 seconds into the fourth quarter gave the Golden Eagles a 38-28 lead. App State (4-4, 2-2 Sun Belt) responded with a 78-yard scoring drive with Aguilar throwing a 49-yard scoring pass to Christian Horn. After forcing a punt, on the third play of the Mountaineers' drive, Kanye Roberts ran for a 61-yard score to make it 42-38 with 6:37 remaining. Southern Miss countered with a drive that took it to the Mountaineers' 30 but it ended with an incomplete pass on fourth-and-2.

Aguilar and Appalachian State closed it out with a six-play, 70-yard drive that ended with a 21-yard scoring pass to Horn for the final margin.

Horn finished with 165 yards receiving on eight catches and Roberts had 109 yards rushing with 13 catches.

Frank Gore, Jr. ran for 247 yards on 24 carries and scored twice, from 42 and 75 yards, for Southern Miss (1-7, 0-5) which had leads of 10 points three times.

Gore, Jr., posted his 11th, 100-yard rushing game in his career, tying for fifth in 100-yard rushing games at the school with Sam DeJarnette. Gore, Jr.'s 200-plus rushing yards was the 14th rushing game in school history with 200 or more yards. His 247 yards is the second most rushing yards for a Golden Eagle junior.

Ti Mims registered a career-high for both catches (10) and yards (141) as it was his first career 100-yard receiving game. He is the first Golden Eagle to collect 10 catches in a game since Jason Brownlee had 10 versus Troy last season.
