OPENING DRIVE

• The ULM football team (2-1) returns home to open Sun Belt play against Arkansas State (1-3) on Saturday (Sept. 27) at 2 p.m. CT in Malone Stadium. The Warhawks are looking to find success after a strong road win at UTEP.

• ULM returns home after its first road nonconference win since 2018, a strong 31-25 showing against the UTEP Miners. The Warhawks put up 24 points in the first half to pull away, scoring on four of their first five possessions. Two interceptions by the ULM defense in the final two minutes secured the 31-25 victory.

• Saturday's game marks the 48th-ever meeting in the series between the Red Wolves and the Warhawks. Arkansas State holds a 33-14 record, most recently claiming a 28-21 win in 2024 in Jonesboro. The first meeting between the two teams was 1959, with the Red Wolves posting a 15-0 shutout on their home field. ULM has not defeated Arkansas State since 2009, when the Warhawks won 16-10 in Malone Stadium.

• At Saturday's game, ULM will be unveiling a new grey uniform and new maroon helmet for the homecoming game. This is the first maroon helmet for the Warhawks since 2005. The Warhawks have also debuted a black helmet this season.

• The Warhawks open Sun Belt competition at Malone Stadium this season, last doing so in 2023 against App State. ULM is 8-15 in Sun Belt Conference openers since 2001, currently on a one-game streak after defeating Troy on the road to open SBC play last season.

• On the road against UTEP, the Warhawks defeated their first nonconference opponent on the road since 2018. The victory also marks the team's third road win since 2020, also finding victory in 2024 at Troy and in 2022 against Georgia State.

• In the season opener against Saint Francis, ULM claimed a 29-0 shutout win. This is the first shutout win in over a decade for the Warhawks, the last coming against Nicholls in 2015 (47-0). Nine other teams in FBS secured a shutout in Week 1, including local foe Louisiana Tech.

• The Warhawks lead the Sun Belt in numerous categories, including kickoff return defense (8.31, fifth nationally) and red zone offense (1.000). ULM is one of 19 teams to remain 100% in the red zone, and one of two Sun Belt teams to remain 1.000.

Running back **Braylon McReynolds** sits at third in the Sun Belt in yards per carry (6.78), ranking 23rd in FBS.

• ULM's 12-game football schedule features five home games, four being conference opponents. According to ESPN, the Warhawks have the second-toughest schedule in the Sun Belt and the eighth toughest in the Group of Five.

• ULM's 2025 opponents went a combined 69-81 (.460) in 2024, with five opponents going over .500. In addition, six foes also participated in postseason bowl games a year ago: Alabama (ReliaQuest

Bowl), Coastal Carolina (Myrtle Beach Bowl), South Alabama (IS4S Salute to Veterans Bowl), Arkansas State (68 Ventures Bowl), the Ragin' Cajuns (Isleta New Mexico Bowl) and Texas State (Servpro First Responder Bowl).

- ULM defensive back **D'Arco Perkins-McAllister** was voted Sun Belt Conference Defensive Player of the Week after a media member panel vote on August 31. Perkins-McAllister played lights out for the Warhawks in week one, leading the defense in the team's first shutout in a decade. His two sacks are second in the Sun Belt Conference. The Nashville, Tenn., native claimed five solo tackles on the evening and three assists in a game where the opponent only crossed the 50-yard line once.

- Offensive lineman **Elijah Fisher** was recognized on multiple preseason watch lists, including the All State Wuerffel Trophy Watchlist and the Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Trophy Watchlist. The Wuerffel Trophy recognizes college football players who exemplify community service, academic excellence and athletic achievement. The Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Trophy recognizes the top offensive player who exhibits the enduring characteristics that define Earl Campbell: integrity, performance, teamwork, sportsmanship, drive, community and tenacity.

- Seven Warhawks were named to the Phil Steele Preseason Sun Belt teams. On the Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Third Team were offensive lineman **Elijah Fisher**, defensive lineman **Kevontay Wells**, defensive back **D'Arco Perkins-McAllister** and placekicker **Max Larson**. On the fourth team were offensive lineman **Jay Mickle**, linebacker **Billy Pullen** and linebacker **Seidriion Langston**.

- **Kevontay Wells** was also named to the Preseason All-Sun Belt First Team Defense, as voted on by the conference's coaches. In his first season with the Warhawks, Wells led the team with 11.0 tackles for loss, which ranked tied for sixth in the Sun Belt. He added 50 total tackles and three sacks in a breakout junior season. Wells is the first Warhawk to be named to a Preseason All-Sun Belt team since 2020, when ULM placed a trio of players (Josh Johnson, Josh Pederson and Corey Straughter) on the preseason first team.

- ULM added 40 new players to its 2025 roster in the offseason. Head coach **Bryant Vincent** and his staff signed 13 new Warhawks on the first day of the early signing period in December, featuring eight defensive players and five on offense. In total, ULM signed nine junior college transfers, 23 transfers from four-year colleges and six high school recruits. The Warhawks lost six starters on offense and six on defense from the 2024 squad.

- **Aidan Armenta** remains the starting quarterback for the Warhawks, completing 28 of 51 passes for 259 yards and three touchdowns. Monroe native **Landon Graves** has also seen action at quarterback this season, throwing four-for-seven across three games and collecting a touchdown in his first career drive. **Hunter Herring** also saw action in a unique position, appearing in multiple positions on the field to push the Warhawks ahead. Herring scored the first touchdown of the season for the Warhawks and posted another against UTEP.

- The running back room in Monroe has proven to be deep, as five RBs have seen action so far this season. **Braylon McReynolds** has claimed three starts thus far, leading the team with 244 yards from 36 attempts and two touchdowns. McReynolds notched his first touchdown as a Warhawk against Saint Francis, a 13-yard reception into the end zone.

Four other running backs contributed to the 654 rushing yards this season, the team averaging 5.6 yards per rush. **Tyrell Reed Jr.** has collected 53 yards, averaging 4.1 yards per carry. **Dorian Lewis** posted 131 yards on 14 carries, including a 72-yard rush to get to the red zone at UTEP. Freshman **D'Shaun Ford** has seen nine carries and 42 yards and **Zach Palmer-Smith** has recorded 41 yards off 16 carries. Quarterback Herring leads with two rushing touchdowns.

- **Tyler Griffin** continues to lead ULM receivers, claiming 63 yards from six receptions, including a touchdown reception from quarterback Graves in the season opener. Veteran **Jake Godfrey** has notched 70 yards off five receptions, getting a touchdown reception from Armenta into the end zone at UTEP. **JP Coulter** follows Godfrey this season, posting 42 yards off five receptions.

- **Noah Flemmings** leads the team defense with 17 tackles, logging two tackles for loss, a pass breakup and a quarterback hurry through three games. Former Sun Belt Defensive Player of the Week **D'Arco Perkins-McAllister** follows closely behind with 15, notching two tackles for loss, two sacks and four pass breakups. **Kamrin Canterbury** also has 15 tackles with a sack, **Carl Fauntroy** and **Seidriion Langston** each have registered 13 and to round out the double-digit tackles, Korian Wilson has 11.

David Godsey Jr. and **Lynard Harris** are credited with two of the three interceptions on the season, both coming in the final two minutes against UTEP to prevent a last-minute comeback from the Miners.

The ULM defense prevented the Red Flash from crossing the 50 all but one time. Perkins-McAllister registered eight tackles in the season opener and two sacks. Wilson and Flemmings each posted a tackle for loss as well. Flemmings' TFL shut down a fourth down conversion for Saint Francis, forcing a turnover on downs.

- **Cliff Mosley** also contributed to the defensive effort, catching his first career interception against the Red Flash to force another turnover. Mosley arrives at ULM from Henderson State, where the defensive lineman made eight tackles and recovered a fumble in 2024.

• Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Third Team member **Kevontay Wells** returns to ULM after a stellar 2024 campaign, tallying 50 tackles, 11 tackles for loss and three sacks while earning All-Sun Belt Second Team Defense honors. **Dylan Howell** returns for his third Warhawk season, after totaling 23 tackles and two quarterback hurries in 2024. **Billy Pullen** returns for his second season, named to the Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Fourth Team, after starting in all 12 games and awarded All-Sun Belt Third Team last season.

• Newcomers in the defense include **Zy Jackson**, a two-time all-conference defensive back at Copiah-Lincoln CC, totaling 10 tackles, a fumble recovery and 586 return yards in 2024. Defensive back **Kamrin Canterbury** led West Florida with 49 tackles and 4.5 tackles for loss last season before transferring to ULM for the 2025 season.

• The Warhawks return both starting guards from last season. **Elijah Fisher** is set for his sixth season in Monroe and has earned All-SBC Honorable Mention in back-to-back seasons. Fisher was voted Phil Steele All-Sun Belt Preseason Third Team. **Jay Mickle** started all 12 games for ULM last season and is back for his final season. The graduate student from Picayune, Miss., was voted Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Fourth Team. Also returning for the Warhawks' offensive line is **Que McBroom** and **Reese Steele**, both of whom made starts last season.

• Special teams players **Max Larson**, **Makenzie Ryan**, **Andrew Wells** and **Nolan Wilson** are all back on ULM's 2025 roster. Larson went 14-for-17 on field goal attempts and 27-for-28 on PATs in his first season with the Warhawks and was named Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Third Team. Ryan booted 58 punts with an average of 39.2 yards per punt, downing 18 inside the 20-yard line. Wells served as the team's holder and Wilson was the long snapper for all games last season. ULM signed West Monroe native **Peyton Todd** to the roster. Todd appeared in all 13 games last season at LSU and averaged 41.3 yards per punt on 19 punts for the Tigers.

• ULM's coaching staff features four new faces in 2025, including running backs coach and run game coordinator **Hindley Brigham**, wide receivers coach **Kishawn McClain**, defensive ends coach **Jontavius Morris** and offensive assistant coach **Cody Wells**. Brigham arrives after nine seasons at UAB, McClain joins the staff after stops at ETSU and Gardner-Webb and Morris was added after being on staff at Louisville and Purdue. Former ULM quarterback Wells returns to Monroe after a few seasons at Evangel University.

• Family connections on the ULM football coaching staff include **Bryant Vincent's** son, **Brady Vincent**, as the team's Tight Ends Coach. **Bret Vincent** makes it three Vincents featured in the ULM football program, with Bret playing wide receiver for the Warhawks. The Vincent family is not the only family tie for ULM. Defensive Coordinator **Earnest Hill** enters his second season on the staff, with his son **Bryan Hill** working as a defensive assistant coach.

LAST TIME OUT –

ULM 31, UTEP 25 (Sept. 20, 2025 in El Paso, Texas) – The ULM football team (2-1) pulled out a win over the UTEP Miners (1-3) on Saturday night to even the series, 31-25. An early offensive start for the Warhawks got things going in the first half, while the defense secured the win with two interceptions in the final two minutes.

Aidan Armenta went 8-for-14 for 136 yards, recording two touchdowns on the evening with a 57% completion percentage. **Hunter Herring** and **Landon Graves** also saw action at quarterback.

With the Miners receiving to open the game, a **Dylan Howell** sack set UTEP back, allowing for momentum to swing the Warhawk way. While UTEP was able to reach the 4-yard line, an incomplete pass gave ULM the ball with nine minutes remaining in the quarter. The ULM offense got to quick work, with **Dorian Lewis** going on a career-high 72-yard rush to reach the UTEP 26. Armenta then connected with **Jake Godfrey** for the first score of the evening, **Luke Stagg** securing the extra point.

Godfrey led the team with two receptions for 49 yards, **Jonathan Bibbs** not far behind with two catches and 38 yards, each posting a touchdown.

UTEP did not let up, however, with a 73-yard pass landing **Trevon Tate** in the end zone immediately after. Tied up at seven, the Warhawks tried to forge ahead, but caught a quick three-and-out. After the ULM defense shut down the Miners, **Carlos Arreola** missed a 40-yard field goal to keep the score at 7-7. With time running out in the first quarter, a 37-pass to Godfrey followed by a 40-yard run by **Braylon McReynolds** got ULM back in the end zone to end the first quarter ahead, 14-7.

McReynolds led ULM in total yards and rushing, with 18 carries and 107 yards. Lewis followed closely with five attempts for 79 yards.

The second quarter began with the Warhawks finding the end zone yet again, this time a 35-yard reception for Bibbs for the 21-7 lead. The ULM defense continued to hold UTEP without points, giving the offense a chance to shine. A few first downs from Herring and McReynolds placed the Warhawks in field goal position, Stagg notching a 44-yarder. Another turnover on downs sent the ball back to the ULM offense in the final 30 seconds of the half, concluding the second quarter with a 24-7 score.

Neither team was able to get momentum going early in the third, the Miners turning the ball over on downs for the third time in the contest. Armenta and Herring split duties in the fourth touchdown drive, Herring ultimately rushing up the middle for the 31-7 score, Stagg securing the extra point. The Miners finally got back on the board with 5:39 in the third quarter, pushing ahead before settling for a 27-yard field goal. Both teams traded drives to close the third, neither able to find another score.

UTEP came out swinging in the final quarter, **Malachi Nelson** sending a 44-yard shot to **Wondame Davis Jr.** for the team's first touchdown since the first quarter to shave the Warhawk lead down. Nelson then completed a two-point conversion to **Hahsaun Wilson** for a 31-18 score with 13:31 remaining in the contest. The Warhawks punted again to give the ball back to the Miners, who responded with a three-minute touchdown drive, Davis Jr. with another touchdown reception to cut things down to six.

Noah Flemmings and **Carl Fauntroy** both registered seven tackles, with Flemmings captured a tackle for loss and a quarterback hurry. Fauntroy notched 0.5 TFLs and a pass breakup. Canterbury, Loa and Howell each claimed a sack, with Godsey and Harris each snagging interceptions.

In a crucial drive for ULM, McReynolds continued to claim first downs. But a loss of yardage and a delay of game sent **Makenzie Ryan** out to punt with 2:32 remaining in the contest. After holding the Miners incomplete, **Lynard Harris** intercepted Nelson's pass at the UTEP 30 with two minutes remaining. The Warhawks were unable to convert the fourth down, however, turning the ball over on downs. A crucial drive, this time for ULM's defense, saw a fourth-down conversion for the Miners. Another interception for the Warhawks, this time by **David Godsey Jr.**, secured the 31-25 victory for the Warhawks.

BRYANT VINCENT

SECOND SEASON AT ULM (7-8) THIRD SEASON OVERALL (14-14)

Bryant Vincent, known for his strong leadership and expertise in creating powerful offensive schemes in college football, was named the 17th head football coach in University of Louisiana Monroe history on Wednesday, December 6, 2023. Vincent was also named Interim Athletic Director for ULM on August 5, 2025.

In his first season as head coach of ULM football, Coach Vincent began establishing a culture of grit and resilience that propelled the Warhawks to one of their most successful starts in nearly four decades. ULM opened the 2024 season 5-1, the program's best start in 37 years, and Vincent was the only Sun Belt Conference Coach named to the 2024 Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year Award Watch List.

Vincent secured his first victory as head coach with a 30-14 win over Jackson State on August 29, 2024. In week two, the Warhawks stunned UAB with a dominating 32-6 win after shutting out the Blazers in the second half inside Malone Stadium. After defeating Troy on the road 13-9 in the Sun Belt Conference opener, Vincent led the Warhawks to a signature victory over JMU by a score of 21-19 to give ULM its first 4-1 start in the FBS era. ULM completed the 5-1 start with a 38-21 win over Southern Miss in week six.

Under Vincent's direction, the Warhawks led the SBC in several statistical categories, including passing yards allowed (183.9), blocked kicks (3) and few-

est penalty yards per game (43.25).

He developed 2024 Sun Belt Conference Freshman of the Year Ahmad Hardy, who led the league with 1,351 rushing yards and 13 rushing touchdowns as a true freshman. Hardy was named ULM's first FWAA Freshman All-American in program history and was also voted Louisiana Freshman of the Year by the Louisiana Sports Writers Association.

Including Hardy, nine Warhawks garnered SBC post-season honors for the first time in over five seasons including All-Sun Belt Second Team defensive lineman Kevontay Wells and All-Sun Belt Third Team defensive stars Billy Pullen, Carl Glass Jr., and Wydett Williams Jr. Additionally, two of Vincent's players went on to compete at the professional level after senior cornerback Car'lin Vigers signed an undrafted free agent contract with the NFL's Washington Commanders and senior offensive lineman Sam Carson was drafted by the CFL's Ottawa Redblacks.

Off the field, Vincent's leadership produced unprecedented academic results. ULM football recorded the highest term GPA in program history in Fall 2024, and the team's 84% graduation success rate (GSR) led all Sun Belt programs. Additionally, major facility upgrades were completed at Malone Stadium, including renovations to the team room, locker room and main athletics lobby.

Before arriving in Monroe, Vincent served as the Offensive Coordinator at the University of New

Mexico during the 2023 season. Under Vincent's offensive schemes, the Lobos earned national top-20 rankings in red zone offense (14th) and rushing offense (19th). Additionally, Vincent coached running back Jacory Croskey-Merritt to a record-breaking season. The New Mexico running back was the first Lobo to ever have back-to-back 200-yard rushing games and finished with 17 rushing touchdowns, which is third all-time in New Mexico football history.

Prior to New Mexico, Vincent served as the Interim Head Coach at UAB following the retirement of Bill Clark and led the Blazers to a 7-6 season and a win in the 2022 Bahamas Bowl. UAB's offense generated 30.1 points per game and 438.2 yards per game, which was the 33rd highest mark in the country. Vincent spent four seasons as UAB's offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach and was a key figure in elevating the program since its reinstatement in 2017. In all, Vincent helped lead UAB to a pair of Conference USA Championships and bowl game victories.

UAB has been the winningest team in Conference USA since returning to the playing field and collected 42 wins since Vincent returned as OC. The Blazers won the 2018 CUSA title game 27-25 over Middle Tennessee State, winning on the road, and the 2020 CUSA title game, that one 22-13 over Marshall, again on the road.

UAB also made it to the 2019 championship game as champions of their division. Since the reinstatement of the program in 2017, Vincent coached in five bowls games, qualifying for six. UAB won the 2018 Boca Raton Bowl 37-13 over Northern Illinois, the 2021 Independence Bowl 31-28 over BYU and the 2022 Bahamas Bowl. UAB also played in the 2017 Bahamas Bowl against Ohio and the 2019 New Orleans Bowl against App State, and the team qualified for the 2020 Gasparilla Bowl against South Carolina, before being canceled due to COVID-19.

With Vincent at offensive coordinator, the Blazers set FBS-program records for wins in 2018, going 11-3. Vincent never had a losing season with Blazers, going 7-6 as head coach and going 48-27 overall in his six years with UAB. The 2018 Blazers had the best offensive season in program history which resulted in 21 school records, including the aforementioned 11-3 overall record and winning the program's first Conference USA title and

bowl game.

Among the school records that fell in 2018 included total points (418), total touchdowns (53), rushing touchdowns (32), total yards (5,680) and rushing yards (2,818). Additionally, UAB set the single game school record for total yards (668) and rushing yards (419) in a 52-3 victory over UTSA on Nov. 3, 2018.

Vincent is no stranger to the Sun Belt Conference and spent six years in two separate stints with South Alabama. He served as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach from 2015-17 and was an assistant coach from 2011-13 for the Jaguars' football program. Vincent helped guide the Jaguars to the 2016 Nova Home Loans Arizona Bowl led by record setting quarterback Dallas Davis. In Vincent's offense, Davis threw for the most yards in school history (2,706) and his 2,951 total yards of offense are second most in program history.

Before entering the collegiate ranks, Vincent was a successful high school football coach in Alabama and tallied a record of 49-16 in five seasons at two different schools. In his first season as a head coach, Vincent led Greenville High School to a 10-3 record and was selected as the Class 5A Coach of the Year in 2006. Vincent was at the helm of Spanish Fort High School football for four seasons and produced a record of 39-13. His team captured the Alabama 5A State Championship in 2010.

Vincent is a native of Glasgow, Kentucky. He and his wife Holli have two sons, Brady, a member of the ULM football coaching staff and Bret, a wide receiver for the Warhawks.
